Today: Today we say 'au revoir' to Paris and drive to the small village of Giverny, home of the world-famous Impressionist painter, Claude Monet. We will visit his Japanese-inspired garden and see his 19th century home. We will take up our sketch pads and watercolor pencils to try our hand at sketching the beautiful gardens. Then, we will drive to Rouen, the capital of the region of Normandy and where St. Joan of Arc was imprisoned, tried, and burnt at the stake by the English at about nineteen years of age. We will visit the market square and the Gothic Cathedral of Notre Dame, often painted by Claude Monet. En route to Lisieux, we will hear about The Art of Being a Woman and the Life of St. Joan of Arc and Her Feminine Genius.

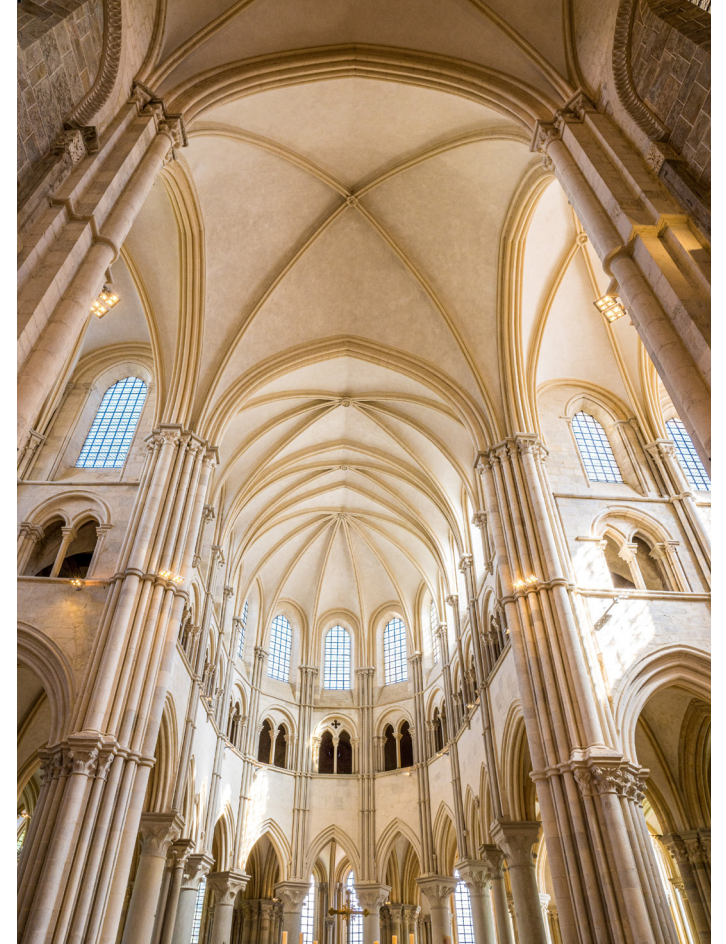
Evening: Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Alençon.
