# DAILY ITINERARY

## DAY 1: U.S.A | ISRAEL

**(Tuesday, January 3rd)** Today, your pilgrimage begins by boarding your flight to Israel. You will be served food and beverages on board.

## DAY 2: TEL AVIV | NETANYA

**(Wednesday, January 4th)** Today we arrive at Ben Gurion Airport, where we will travel through customs and meet your guide, who will accompany you throughout your pilgrimage. From the airport, it's a quick bus trip to your hotel in Netanya. If time permits, we will stop in Jaffa city to celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Church. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be available at your hotel in Netanya.

## DAY 3: CANA | NAZARETH | MT. TABOR | TIBERIAS

**(Thursday, January 5th)** We start the day by celebrating Mass at Cana, the site of Jesus' first miracle. Here, couples may also renew their Wedding vows and request a

renewal certificate from the church. We then go to Nazareth, where you will visit The Basilica of the Annunciation, St. Joseph's Church, Mary's Well, and the old market. Next, we travel to Mount Tabor and view the sight of the Transfiguration before returning to Tiberias. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be available at your hotel in Tiberias.

## DAY 4: MT. OF BEATITUDES | TABGHA | CAPERNAUM | SEA OF GALILEE

**(Friday, January 6th)** Today we will visit the Mount of Beatitudes, the location of Jesus' famous Sermon on the Mount. Our next stop is Tabgha, where the miracle of the multiplication of fish and bread took place. Also close by is the Church of Peter's Primacy, where Jesus performed the Miraculous Fishing miracle with his Apostles. Next, we continue to Capernaum, where Jesus lived and started his ministry. This afternoon's Mass will be celebrated by Boat on the Sea of Galilee, as was done in the time of Jesus. Finally, we finish the day with a drive into Bethlehem, where dinner and overnight accommodations will be available at your hotel.

### **DAY 5: BETHLEHEM | CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY | SHEPHERD'S FIELD | EIN KAREM**

**(Saturday, January 7th)** Our first stop in Bethlehem is Shepherd's Fields, where we will celebrate Mass. You will also see the Church of the Nativity that stands upon Jesus's birth site. Then, this afternoon, we go to Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist. Next is the Church of the Visitation, where the Virgin Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth and proclaimed the "Magnificat." This evening, dinner and overnight accommodations will be available at your hotel in Bethlehem.

### **DAY 6: JERUSALEM**

**(Sunday, January 8th)** Today's portion of your pilgrimage starts with a visit to the Mt. of Olives and The Pater Noster, where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer to his disciples. Next, we will walk the Palm Sunday route stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. In the Garden of Gethsemane, we can see The Rock of Agony, where Jesus prayed his last prayer before his arrest. Mass will be held today at the Church of all Nations. Next on our tour is the Chapel of the Ascension, located on the site where Jesus ascended into Heaven after his resurrection. This afternoon, we will see Mount Zion, the highest point in ancient Jerusalem, dominated by the Church of the Dormition. In Christian tradition, it is known as the place where the Virgin Mary died or "fell asleep," as the name suggests. Finally, we will end our day at St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied our Lord three times. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be available again at your hotel in Bethlehem.

### **DAY 7: JERUSALEM: VIA DOLOROSA**

**(Monday, January 9th)** Today we will retrace the last steps of Jesus as we walk along the Via Dolorosa, or the "Way of Sorrow," through the markets of the Old City. We will be praying at the Stations of the Cross and reflecting on the greatness of his sacrifice. Finally, we arrive at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre to celebrate Mass. Next on your tour is St. Anne's Church, the home of the Virgin Mary and her parents, Saints Joachim and Anne. We'll also pass the Ecce Home where Pilate proclaimed "Behold the man," then on to the Wailing Wall, the holiest place for Jews. The rest of the day is open for visits to other Holy Sites, shopping, or resting at your hotel. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be available again at your hotel in Bethlehem

### **DAY 8: BETHANY | JORDAN RIVER | JERICHO | QUMRAN | DEAD SEA**

**(Tuesday, January 10th)** Today we will visit the Mount of Beatitudes, the location of Jesus' famous Sermon on the Mount. Our next stop is Tabgha, where the miracle of the multiplication of fish and bread took place. Also close by is the Church of Peter's Primacy, where Jesus performed the Miraculous Fishing miracle with his Apostles. Next, we continue to Capernaum, where Jesus lived and started his ministry. This afternoon's Mass will be celebrated by Boat on the Sea of Galilee, as was done in the time of Jesus. Finally, we finish the day with a drive into Bethlehem, where dinner and overnight accommodations will be available at your hotel.



## THE TOUR PRICE INCLUDES

**[Air Transportation]** Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, **ARE NON-REFUNDABLE, NON – TRANSFERABLE, AND CANNOT BE USED TOWARDS FUTURE TRAVEL.**

**[Land Transportation]** All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

**[Hotels]** Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

**[Single Room]** There is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

**[Meal Plan]** The meal plan offers two (2) meals per day and consists of both breakfast and dinner. You are responsible for your lunch.
