We will then proceed to Pope Francis' Stadium "Fatima City" for our first event. Our Mass could be in Fatima or Santarem.

THE TOUR PRICE INCLUDES

[Air Transportation] Economy class and round-trip fares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, **ARE NON-REFUNDABLE, NON – TRANSFERABLE, AND CANNOT BE USED TOWARDS FUTURE TRAVEL.**
