DAILY ITINERARY

DAY 1 USA → ISRAEL

Our tour begins today as you depart on your overnight flight to Israel. Meals and drinks are served during your flight.

DAY 2 TEL AVIV → NETANYA

Arrive at Tel Aviv Airport, meet our representative, and drive to Caesarea for a short visit. Afterward, we will check into our hotel in Netanya, north of Tel Aviv.

DAY 3 MT. CARMEL → JEZREEL VALLEY → NAZARETH VILLAGE → TIBERIUS

We will start the day with a trip to the Jezreel Valley and follow the story of the prophet Elijah. It was here that Elijah challenged the prophets of Baal and Asherah to determine who the true God was. Next, we will drive through the Jezreel Valley and visit the ancient city of Har Megiddo, one of three cities mentioned in the Bible built by King Solomon. Next, we will visit the Nazareth Village for a unique tour that will take us back to the First Century style of life that brings the Bible to life. In Nazareth, we will also visit the Synagogue, where Jesus proclaimed himself as the Messiah. Finally, we will travel to our hotel in Tiberius by the Sea of Galilee for three nights.

DAY 4 CAPERNAUM → TABGHA → MT OF BEATITUDES → MAGDALA → SEA OF GALILEE

We begin our day visiting the town of Capernaum, where Jesus spent 18 months of his ministry and performed nine miracles. You will also get to see Peter's home followed by the Primacy of Peter in Tabgha, where Jesus performed the feeding of the five thousand plus women and children. Next, we will visit the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus performed the Sermon on the Mount. Next, we continue to Magdala, the village most Christian scholars believe is the home of Mary Magdalene. Matthew mentions it in his Gospel (15: 39), which reads, "And he sent away the multitude, and took ship, and came into the coasts of Magdala." Finally, we will complete our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, sharing stories of

things Jesus did on these waters, and the crew will show us first-century fishing. Afterward, we travel back to our hotel in Tiberius for the night.

DAY 5 GOLAN HEIGHTS → TEL DAN → CAESAREA PHILIPPI → BETH SHAN

This morning we will drive to Golan Heights to visit Tel Dan and Caesarea Philippi, where Peter proclaimed Jesus the Messiah. It was also here that Jesus named Peter "The Rock," on which Jesus would build His church. From here onto Chorazin and then to Bethsaida, where Philip, Peter, and Andrew lived. Lastly, we will travel back to our hotel in Tiberius for the night.

DAY 6 MASADA → JORDAN RIVER BAPTISM → BETHLEHEM → SHEPHERD'S FIELD

We begin our day travelling to the mountain of Masada, where we will take a cable car to the fortress and learn the story of Israel's last stand against the Roman Army in the first Judean War. Next, we will stop at the River Jordan, where we will offer our members to be baptized. If you are already baptized, you are welcome to renew your commitment to Jesus. This is voluntary, but most of our groups enjoy this as one of the most popular stops on our trip. Next, we travel to Bethlehem to see The Church of the Nativity, the traditional site where Jesus was born. Then, we travel to Shepherd's Field, where the Angel of God appeared to the Shepherds. Our final stop will be the mountain of Herodium, one of three palaces built by Herod the Great and where he is buried. At the end of our day, we will journey to our hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 7 OLD CITY JERUSALEM → VIA DOLOROSA → POOL OF BETHESDA → WAILING WALL → THE RABBI TUNNEL → GARDEN TOMB

Today, we visit the Old City of Jerusalem. Our first stop will be at the Wailing Wall (also called the Western Wall), the only surviving part of the Second Temple after Roman Soldiers burned it down in 70 AD. You will have time to pray at the wall and learn how it survived destruction. Next, we will pass the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the

lame man, and then walk up the Via Dolorosa. The Via Dolorosa is the traditional path where Jesus carried his cross to Calvary. Then we will stop at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the traditional site of Jesus's crucifixion and tomb, followed by the Garden Tomb, also considered the place of Jesus' death and resurrection. We will worship and have Holy Communion in the garden, then travel back to our hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 8 SHILOH → JACOB'S WELL → SABASTIA → NEBI

We will begin our day visiting Shiloh, the military capital of Israel during the period of the Judges and also the site for 369 years for the Tabernacle that became their spiritual center. Next, we will travel to Nablus and visit Jacob's well, dug by Jacob, the grandson of Abraham, two millennia ago. We have just a few more stops today, including Sabastia and Samaria (the capital of the Northern Kingdom). We will also visit the tomb of the prophet Samuel, commonly known as Nebi Samuel or Nebi Samwil. Finally, we will return to our hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 9 JERUSALEM → MT OF OLIVES → DOMINIS FLEVIT → GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE → ST. PETER IN GALlicantu → EMMAUS → VALLEY OF ELAH

We begin our day at the Mount of Olives for a beautiful view of the city. It is the Mount of Olives where Jesus ascended into heaven and will one day return. Here, you can take a camel ride if you choose. Next, we will walk down the Palm Sunday path and stop at the Dominis Flevit chapel, where Jesus wept over the city. Afterward, we will proceed to the Garden of Gethsemane to see the "Rock of Agony," where Jesus prayed in agony before his arrest, knowing what he had to endure. Our next stop is St. Peter in Gallicantu (the home of Caiaphas), where Peter denied Jesus three times before the rooster crowed. You will also see where Jesus was kept until his trial before Pilate. Finally, we will travel to Emmaus, where the Resurrected Jesus was seen by two of his disciples, and then to the Valley of Elah, where David fought Goliath.

DAY 10 TEL AVIV → USA

Today: Following breakfast, we will transfer to the airport to catch our flight home filled with wonderful memories of The Holy Land.
