#### **DAY 1 DEPART FOR MEXICO CITY / HOLY FAMILY AND HISTORIC CENTER**

Today: Your pilgrimage begins as you depart on your flight to Mexico City. After arriving, you will have breakfast and celebrate Mass at the Church of the Sagrada Familia. Next, we will see the tomb of Father Miguel Agustín Pro, the Jesuit martyr, and the small museum that has been dedicated to him. After this visit, we will go to the historic center where you will visit the oldest and largest cathedral in all of Latin America, the Metropolitan Cathedral. Afterward, we will go to the National Palace, which has been a building of the ruling class of Mexico since the government of the Aztec Empire.

**Evening:** Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

#### **DAY 2 FULL DAY DEDICATED TO GUADALUPE**

Today: After breakfast, we will travel to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe (Patroness of the Americas). On the way, we will stop by the Plaza

of the Three Cultures. This plaza symbolizes the unique blend of pre-Hispanic and Hispanic cultures that make up Mexico. This Shrine was built in response to Our Lady's request to the visionary, St. Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin. Upon arrival at the Shrine, you will celebrate Mass as you marvel at the brilliantly colored Basilica. Following Mass, you will join the other pilgrims as you kneel in front of the "Tilma," where Our Lady's image was miraculously imprinted. Next will be a guided tour of the Basilica and a time for prayers and confessions (if wished). After lunch, we will meet with the experts on the Virgin of Guadalupe close to the Basilica, who will tell us more about the Guadalupana, Her history, Her miracles, and Her apparitions. Again, we will have time to ask questions and pray together.

Evening: Dinner at a nice restaurant with Mariachi entertainment.

#### **DAY 3 TULPETLAC / TEOTIHUACAN**

**Today:** We will celebrate Mass in Tulpetlac, headquarters of the 5th apparition. After Mass, we will visit the pyramids of Teotihuacán. Here, we will view the Sun and Moon Pyramids, the Temple of

**Evening:** Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

#### **DAY 4 EXCURSION TO PUEBLA**

**Today:** We will board our motor coach bound for the colonial town of Puebla. First, at St. Francis of Assisi Church, we can see the uncorrupted body of Blessed Sebastian de Aparicio. He is a famous local figure through whose intercessory prayers many miracles have been reported. Next, we will visit the Church of Santo Domingo, whose chapel of Our Lady of the Rosary is one of the most exquisite in all of Mexico. Finally, we will hold a private Mass followed by lunch at a traditional restaurant in Puebla, then return to Mexico City.

**Evening:** Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

#### DAY 5 MEXICO CITY / RETURN TO THE US

**Today:** This morning, we will visit the Plaza de Santo Domingo. This square contains two sacred places that are architecturally exquisite:

- The Church of Santo Domingo, which is the first church built by the Dominicans in 1576.
- The Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary, Mexico's first Shrine of the Rosary.

Next, we will visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Covadonga, headquarters of the Brotherhood of the Holy Rosary. If time permits, we will have a farewell Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, then transfer to the airport to catch our return flight home.
