DAY 1: UNITED STATES TO ISRAEL

Today: Your pilgrimage begins today by boarding your flight to Israel. Meals and drinks will be served on board.

DAY 2: TEL AVIV / NETANYA

Today: After arriving at Ben Gurion Airport and traveling through customs, you will meet your tour guide, who will accompany you throughout your pilgrimage. Next, you will board our coach bus for the trip to your hotel in Netanya. If time permits, we will stop in Jaffa city to celebrate Mass at St. Peters Church. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Netanya.

DAY 3: CAESAREA BY THE SEA / MUHRAQA / MT. CARMEL / HAIFA / TIBERIAS

Today: We start the day at Caesarea Maritima, viewing the ancient remains of King Herod's once great city. Next, we will visit Deir Al-Muhraqa Carmelite Monastery to celebrate Mass. Here, Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal and Asherah (I Kgs. 18). Afterward, we will continue to Stella Maris Monastery on Mt. Carmel, followed by Haifa City. Finally, we will drive towards Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee to our hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 4: CANA / NAZARETH / MT. TABOR / TIBERIAS

Today: We start by celebrating Mass at Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle of turning water into wine. At the Wedding Church, couples may renew their wedding vows and receive a renewal certificate. We then go to Nazareth, where we visit:

- The Basilica of the Annunciation
- St. Joseph's Church
- · Mary's Well
- The Old Market
- Mount Tabor, the scene of the Transfiguration

Return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 5: MT. OF BEATITUDES / TABGHA / CAPERNAUM / SEA OF GALILEE / BETHLEHEM

Today: We will begin our day on the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus gave His Sermon on the Mount. Afterward, we travel to Tabgha, where Jesus performed another miracle by feeding 5,000 with two fish and five loaves of bread. Close by is the Church of Peter's



Primacy, where Jesus performed another great miracle (The Miraculous Fishing). Next, we will continue to Capernaum, where Jesus lived and started his ministry. Later this afternoon, we will celebrate Mass on a Boat as we travel on the Sea of Galilee. Finally, we drive towards Bethlehem to our hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 6: BETHLEHEM / CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY / SHEPHERD'S FIELD / EIN KAREM

Today: We start our day in Bethlehem by celebrating Mass at Shepherds' Field. Next, we will see the Church of the Nativity, which stands upon Jesus's birth site. This afternoon, we will go to Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist. Next, we will visit the Church of the Visitation, where the Virgin Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth and proclaimed the 'Magnificat.' Finally, we will return to our hotel in Bethlehem for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 7: MT. OF OLIVES / GETHSEMANE / PATER NOSTER / DOMINUS FLEVIT / CHAPEL OF THE ASCENSION / UPPER ROOM / DORMITION CHURCH / CHURCH OF ST. PETER **GALLICANTU**

Today: We begin our day on the Mt. of Olives at The Pater Noster, where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer to his disciples. Next, we will walk the Palm Sunday route, stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Afterward, we will see the Rock of Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed his last prayer before his arrest. Next, we will celebrate Mass at the Church of all Nations, followed by the Chapel of the Ascension. This afternoon, we will drive to the hill of Mount Zion, the highest point in ancient Jerusalem, and visit the Church of the Dormition, identified in Christian tradition as the place where the Virgin Mary died or "fell asleep," as the name suggests. Finally, we will end our day at St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied our Lord three times. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 8: IERUSALEM: VIA DOLOROSA

Today: We start today's tour by retracing the last steps of Jesus, walking along the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow). We will walk through the Old City markets, praying at the Stations of the Cross and reflecting on the greatness of his sacrifice. Afterward, we will celebrate Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Next, we stop for a short prayer at St. Anne's Church, the home of the Virgin Mary, and Saints Joachim and Anne, her parents. We will then pass the Ecce Homo, where Pontius



Pilate proclaimed, "Behold the man!" Finally, we visit the Wailing Wall, the holiest site of the Jewish people. The rest of the day is open for you to visit other Holy Sites, shop, or rest at your hotel. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 9: BETHANY / JORDAN RIVER / JERICHO / **QUMRAN / DEAD SEA**

Today: We start our day in Bethany, where Lazarus lived with his sisters Martha and Maria. After visiting the Lazarus church, we will continue to the Jordan River to renew our baptismal vows. Next, we drive down the Jordan Valley, stopping at the oasis town of Jericho, the world's oldest city. After our tour of Jericho, we will visit the Mt. of Temptation, where Jesus fasted for 40 days and 40 nights and was tempted by Satan. We then travel to Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were uncovered in 1947. If there is time, on the way back, we will stop for a swim (or float!) in the mineralrich waters of the Dead Sea, renowned for its healing properties. Finally, we will return to Bethlehem for dinner and overnight accommodations at our hotel. *Note* Today's Mass will either be in Jericho or Bethany.

DAY 10: TEL AVIV / USA

Today: We will transfer to the airport this morning to catch our return flight home.
