Day 1 Flight To Lisbon, Portugal

(Wednesday, August 2)

Flight to Lisbon.

Day 2 World Youth Day 3

(Thursday, August 3)

Morning: Arrive in Lisbon and take a panoramic city tour before reaching our lodging accommodations

Afternoon: The arrival of The Holy Father and initial prayers

Evening: evening shows, music, prayers, and reconciliation opportunities

Day 3 World Youth Day 4

(Friday, August 4)

- **Morning: After breakfast, we will drive to Fatima.**
 - * Visit Our Lady of Fátima Shrine
 - * Tombs of the visionaries and the Chapel of the Apparitions, honoring the Virgin Mary's apparitions to three shepherd children- Francisco Marto, Jacinta Marto, and Sr. Lucia.
 - * Celebrate Mass, then drive to Lisbon
- **Afternoon:** Experience culture, music, prayer, and reconciliation opportunities.
- **Evening:** Stations of the Cross with the Holy Father / Return to your hotel

Day 4 World Youth Day 5

(Saturday, August 5)

- **Morning:** Pilgrimage walk to the place of Night Watch
- **Afternoon:** Music, prayer, and reconciliation opportunities
- **Evening:** Night watch with the Holy Father / Return to your hotel

Day 5 World Youth Day 6

(Sunday, August 6)

- **Morning:** Closing ceremonies, Mass celebrated by the Pope, and the announcement of next year's WYD location.



- **Afternoon:** Free
- **Evening:** Return to your hotel for the night

Day 6 Seville • Cordoba

(Monday, August 7) After breakfast, we will take a panoramic city tour of Seville. It is a unique city because the center has been preserved to human scale, with no high-rise buildings. During your visit, we will see:

- The Seville Cathedral
- La Giralda Tower
- The Archivo de Indias
- The real Alcazar
- Plaza de Espana
- E Palacio de Indesa de Sevilla

After our tour, we will travel to the city of Cordoba. We will have a half-day to see the sites, including the Mosque-Cathedral, with its red and white candy-striped arches, and Catholic Cathedral in the center. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

Day 7 Cordoba • Toledo • Avila • Madrid

(Tuesday, August 8) Today, we leave Cordoba for Toledo, Spain. Located on the banks of the Tagus, Toledo is known as the “City of the Three Cultures” for the cultural influences of Christians, Muslims, and Jews throughout its history. During our tour, we will see:

- The Cathedral of the medieval capital of Spain
- The Mozarabic Chapel
- San Juan de Los Reyes Monasterio
- The Church of San Roman
- The Santa Cruz Museum

Next, we continue our journey to Ávila, where St. Teresa reformed the Carmelite Order. First, we will visit the Convento de la Encarnacion de Santa Teresa and celebrate (if possible). Next, we will see the Basilica de San Vincente followed by the Real Monasterio de Santo Tomas. Afterward, we will continue to Madrid for dinner and overnight at your hotel.



Day 8 Madrid

(Wednesday, August 9) This morning our journey takes us to El Prado, Puerta del Sol, and El Escorial. We will break for lunch somewhere near El Prado. After our tour, we will return to your hotel to rest before dinner and overnight.

Day 9 Madrid

(Thursday, August 10) After breakfast, we will visit the Royal Palace.

This afternoon, we will take the train to Barcelona.

Day 10 Barcelona • Montserrat • Barcelona

(Friday, August 11)

- After breakfast, we will visit Sagrada Familia
- Visit Montserrat, where we will celebrate Mass at the Sanctuary
- Flamenco dinner and overnight in Barcelona.

Day 11 Barcelona

(Saturday, August 12) After breakfast, we will take a guided city tour which will include all of Barcelona’s most important sites like Park Gruel, Las Ramblas, the Gothic Quarter, and Barcelona Cathedral.

Day 12 Return Flight Home

(Sunday, August 13) After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport to board our return flight home.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

THE TOUR PRICE INCLUDES

- Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, **ARE NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE, AND CANNOT BE USED TOWARDS FUTURE TRAVEL.**
- All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.
- Hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.
- There is an additional cost per person for single rooms as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
- A meal plan offering two meals per day: breakfast & dinner.
- Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one piece of checked luggage and one carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.
- Portorage, airport taxes, fuel surcharges and security fees
- Medical protection plan for the duration of your trip

THE TOUR PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE

- Passports or any additional documents expenses that may be required. Passports must be valid after six months of return date.
- Personal items such as laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.
- Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.
- Travel insurance is not included but we highly recommend purchasing this upon registration.
- Your package includes dinner and breakfast. Lunch and any other meals not specified in program itinerary are not included.
- Tips for your guide & driver. Ask your tour guide for customary tip amounts.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit. Full payment is due 100 days before departure date. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable. You may use a major credit card to pay your deposit. There is an additional 3% fee for each payment made by credit card. For any remaining payments, we accept check, money order, Zelle, ACH, and wire transfers.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel, your cancellation request must be in writing, via email, or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:
