Pay 1; Flight to Rome

Today: Your pilgrimage begins today by boarding your flight to Rome. Rest assured, all necessary preparations for your journey have been made. So, sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight. Your spiritual journey awaits in Rome!

Day 2; Rome

Today: Welcome to Rome, also known as "The Eternal City." Upon arrival at the airport, you will pass through customs, collect your luggage in the baggage claim area, and continue to the Arrivals Hall, where you will be greeted by your tour guide & driver. We will transfer to the hotel via motor coach, and following check-in, you will have free time to settle in, relax, or explore Rome on your own

Evening: Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel

Day 3; Papal Audience • Trevi Fountain • Basilica of St. John The Lateran • Holy Stairs • Basilica of St. Mary Major

Today: After breakfast, we begin our day with the Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square! The Audience is celebrated each Wednesday by His Holiness Pope Francis (pending the papal schedule). Following the Audience, we will visit Trevi Fountain, where you will have some free time on your own for lunch. This afternoon, you will visit the Basilica of St. John Lateran, the oldest of Rome's four major basilicas. This church holds Peter & Paul's relics, and it is also where Pope Francis was installed as Bishop of Rome. Next, you will cross the street to visit the Holy Stairs. They are the very steps leading up to the praetorium of Pontius Pilate in Jerusalem on which Jesus walked His way to trial during his Passion. The Stairs were brought to Rome by Saint Helena in the fourth century. You may ascend these stairs on your knees in memory of Christ's agonizing Passion, as is the custom. We will conclude our day with Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major, a church dedicated to Our Blessed Mother. St. Mary Major reigns as the only Basilica that has kept its original structure and is considered an authentic jewel in the crown of Roman Churches. It also contains a relic from the Manger of the Infant Jesus.

Evening: Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.





Pay 4; St. Peter's Basilica • Vatican Museum • Appian Way -Basilica of St. Paul Outside The Walls - Catacombs

Today: After an early breakfast, we begin at the world's largest Christendom Church, St. Peter's Basilica. St. Peter's was built where St. Peter, the first Pope and Bishop of Rome, was martyred. Inside this magnificent church, you will see Michelangelo's Pieta, a stunning marble sculpture depicting the Virgin Mary holding Christ after His crucifixion, death, and removal off the cross before being placed in the tomb. Next, we continue to the Vatican Museum, where you will see the most impressive monuments, sculptures, art, galleries, and awe-inspiring relics. Additionally, you will observe the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, the Sistine Chapel, and Michelangelo's Masterpiece, the restored mural of the Last Judgment. The final stop on your Vatican tour is the tomb of Saint John Paul II. After lunch, we will continue our short journey down the Appian Way, the earliest road of Ancient Rome. This road leads to the Domino Quo Vadis Chapel, the Baths of Caracalla, the Arch of Drusus, the Tomb of Cecilia Metella, and the catacombs of St. Callixtus, Afterward, our day concludes with a visit to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. Originally founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th Century, this Basilica is the burial place of Saint Paul the Apostle.

Evening: Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

Day 5. Pompeii

Today: Following breakfast at our hotel, we will drive to the ancient ruins of Pompeii. We will have a private guided tour of the volcanic ruins, as well as a visit to the Shrine of the Virgin of the Rosary of Pompeii.

Evening: Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Castellammare di Stabia.

Day 6: Sorrento • Amalfi Coast

Today: Following breakfast, we will take a drive along the Amalfi Coast, considered among the most beautiful routes in the world. We will make our way to Amalfi by driving along the Citrus Coast, a name given to this area for its abundance of lemon and orange trees. After lunch, we will explore the Cathedral of St. Andrew, view his relics and Crypt, and celebrate Mass. On our way back to the hotel, we will visit a Limoncello farm to try our hand at making this tasty liquor as well as enjoying a true Italian culinary experience. The group will be divided into two smaller groups, and each class lasts 40 minutes. While one group has the Limoncello tasting, the other will enjoy some time tasting the sweet treats at the pastry shop of Sal De Riso. Finally, we will stop at a Ceramic Factory where you can shop for beautiful local ceramics.

Evening: Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Castellammare di Stabia.

Day 7: The Island of Capri

Today: After breakfast at our hotel, we will take the ferry to the island of Capri (90-minute ride). Upon arrival in Capri, our local guide will give us a short visit to the town's center, where we will explore the Blue Grotto (weather permitting) and take a funicular to the mountain overlooking Capri.

Evening: Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Castellammare.

Day S. Pietrelcina • S. Giovanni Rotondo

Today: After breakfast, we leave for Pietrelcina, the birthplace of Saint Pio. Here, we will visit the house and museum of Padre Pio before continuing to San Giovanni Rotondo.

Evening: Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

Day 9; San Giovanni Rotondo • Monte Sant'ângelo

Today: After breakfast, we begin our day by visiting the Sanctuary in San Giovanni Rotondo, where the incorrupt body of Padre Pio is displayed in a crystal urn. We will then visit other places related to St. Padre Pio, and later this afternoon, we depart for Monte Sant'Angelo. Here, we will visit the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel, a place where many Popes have knelt in prayer to obtain St. Michael's protection. Afterward, we will return to San Giovanni Rotondo.

Evening: Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

Day 10; Lanciano • Rome

Today: This morning, we depart for Lanciano to visit the Shrine of the Eucharistic Miracle which occurred in the eighth century. According to tradition, a monk who had doubts about the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist found, when he said the words of consecration at Mass, that the bread and wine changed into flesh and blood. The Catholic Church validated this event calling it an authentic miracle. After our visit, we will continue our journey to Rome.

Evening: Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

Pay 11: Return Flight Home

Today: This morning, we will transfer to the airport to catch our return flight home.
