DAY 1: FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV

(Sunday, July 14) Lively Faith

Your pilgrimage begins today by boarding your flight from Biloxi, MS, to Tel Aviv. Rest assured, all necessary preparations for your journey have been made. So sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight. Your spiritual journey awaits!

DAY 2: TEL AVIV / HAIFA (Monday, July 15) Blind Obedience

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport, travel through customs, and meet our Catholic guide, who will accompany us throughout our pilgrimage. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at our hotel in Haifa.

DAY 3: MT. CARMEL / NAZARETH / TIBERIAS (Tuesday, July 16) Constant Mental Prayer

Our journey with Mary begins at Mt. Carmel on the feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. Mass will be celebrated, and you have the opportunity to consecrate yourself to Mary. Then, we will drive to Nazareth, where we will visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, where the angel Gabriel told Mary at the age of 14 that she would be the mother of God. Verbum Caro Hic Factum Est "The Word was made flesh HERE". We will also visit the Basilica Museum, the first-century tomb where Mary was with Joseph when he passed away, and Saint Joseph's Church and Mary's Well. This afternoon, we will visit the International Center of Mary of Nazareth. We will drive to Tiberias, where we will stay for 3 nights. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 4: CANA / MT. TABOR / TIBERIAS

(Wednesday, July 17) Heroic Patience

Today we visit Cana, the site of Jesus' first miracle at the Wedding at Cana where Mary comes to Christ as the New Eve, asking the New Adam not to sin but to save the family from embarrassment at the wedding by providing more wine. Here, Jesus calls Mary the name given to Eve (woman) because, at this pivotal moment, He will fully start His public ministry and reverse the effects of what Adam and Eve did. Couples will have the opportunity to renew their wedding promises while in Cana. We will also visit Mt. Tabor, where Peter, James &

John witnessed the Transfiguration of Jesus, aimed at strengthening their faith in anticipation of his Passion. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner will be at a local restaurant. Overnight at our hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 5: MT. OF BEATITUDES / TABGHA / CAPERNAUM / SEA OF GALILEE / TIBERIAS

(Thursday, July 18) Profound Humility

The beginning of Jesus' mission also meant separation from his mother; although she made an attempt, she did not always follow her son in his travels. Today we will visit the places where Jesus' public ministry took place, starting with the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus gave his Sermon on the Mount. We will visit Capernaum, Jesus' hometown, where he started his ministry. Then, we will visit the Church of the Multiplication in Tabgha, where Jesus fed 5,000 with five loaves of bread and two fish. We will enjoy our St. Peter's fish lunch on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Next is the Church of Peter's Primacy, where Jesus appeared to His disciples after the resurrection. Then, we will visit Magdala, the birthplace of Mary Magdalene. Mass will be celebrated while on the 'Jesus boat' on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 6: JORDAN RIVER / JERICHO / MOUNT OF TEMPTATION / BETHLEHEM

(Friday, July 19) Angelic Sweetness

After breakfast, we will travel to the traditional site on the Jordan River where Jesus insisted that John the Baptist baptize Him as an example to all His followers because God chose baptism as the means of salvation and for Jesus' human soul to have the mark of baptism. Here, we will renew our baptismal promises. Afterward, we will visit the oasis town of Jericho, where Jesus healed two blind men and encountered Zacchaeus. Mass will be celebrated. We will see the Mt. of Temptation, where Jesus fasted and was tempted by Satan. We will travel to our hotel in Bethlehem and stay for 2 nights. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 7: BETHLEHEM / CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY / MILK GROTTO / SHEPHERD'S FIELD / EIN KAREM

(Saturday, July 20) Divine Wisdom

After breakfast, we will visit the Nativity Church, which stands upon the site where Mary gave birth to Jesus. Then we will visit the Milk Grotto, where the Holy Family took shelter during the Massacre of the Innocents and where Mary nursed baby Jesus. Then we will visit Shepherds' Field, where the shepherds saw the Nativity Star. In the afternoon, we will visit Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist and the Church of the Visitation, where Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth and proclaimed the 'Magnificat. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 8: JERUSALEM

(Sunday, July 21) Universal Mortification

We begin our 'Jerusalem Experience' at the Mount of Olives. We will start at the Pater Noster, where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer to his disciples. Next, we will walk the Palm Sunday route stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Afterward, we continue our descent to celebrate Mass at the Garden of Gethsemane. We will pray at the Rock of Agony, where Jesus prayed his last prayer before his arrest. We will conclude our day on Mt. Zion with a visit to the Upper Room and St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied our Lord three times (Psalm 88).

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 9: JERUSALEM: VIA DOLOROSA (Monday, July 22) Divine Purity

We begin our day retracing the last steps of Jesus, praying the Stations of the Cross through the eyes of Mary along the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow). We reflect on the greatness of his sacrifice as we make our way to Calvary and the Holy Tomb of Jesus to celebrate Mass at the Church of the Resurrection (Holy Sepulcher). Next, we will visit St. Anne's Church, the birthplace of the Virgin Mary. Here, we will sing joyfully and pray the rosary for Mary's intercession. Last, we will visit the Wailing Wall, the holiest place of the Jewish faith. The rest of the afternoon is open for visits to other holy sites, shopping, or resting at your hotel. Our Farewell Dinner (wine included) and overnight will be at our hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 10: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

(Tuesday, July 23) Ardent Charity

We will transfer to the airport this morning to board our return flight home.
