DAY 1 USA / ISRAEL

Today: Your pilgrimage begins today, boarding your flight to Israel. Rest assured, all the necessary preparations for your trip have been made. So, sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight to Tel Aviv. Your spiritual journey awaits!

DAY 2 — ARRIVE IN TEL AVIV

Today: Once you arrive at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv, you will be met by your tour guide and driver. After collecting your bags and clearing customs, you will be escorted to our private deluxe motor coach and shuttled to your hotel to get settled in for the evening.

Tonight: Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 3 — CAESAREA • MT. CARMEL • MEGGIDO • GIDEON SPRING • MT. TABOR

Today: This morning, we will leave our hotel and drive north via the Sharon Valley (Song of Songs 2:1) along the Mediterranean Sea to Caesarea. Here we will visit the Roman Theater and Crusader ruins, followed by the aqueduct. Caesarea is mentioned in the Book of Acts; 10:1, when we learn of a Centurion guard named Cornelius, who became the first gentile to convert to Christianity. St. Paul was also imprisoned here for two years (Acts; 23:23) before sailing to Rome. After our visit to Caesarea, we will drive to Mount Carmel, where the Prophet Elijah challenged King Ehab (1 Kings: 18). Next, we will journey to Megiddo (Armageddon, Rev.16: 16), one of the three chariot cities of King Solomon (1 Kings 9:15). We then continue to Gideon Spring, also known as Harod Spring (Judges 7:1), read the scriptures and drink from the stream where the chosen "300" drank to be reminded that any minority with God is an overwhelming majority. Next, we will continue our journey to Mt. Tabor, also known as Mt. of Transfiguration, where the battle of Barak and Sisera took place (Jdgs 4:4-16). You can take a special taxi to ascend to the summit and back.

Tonight: Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 4 — CANA • NAZARETH • TZIPORI (SEPPHORIS) • KFAR KEDEM • TEL DAN • CAESAREA PHILIPPI

Today: We begin our day in Cana of Galilee, where the Lord performed His first miracle of turning water into wine (John 2). Next, we will continue to Nazareth





(Luke 1 & 2), walking through the market to the Synagogue (Luke 4: 16-30), and continuing to the spring of Nazareth. Afterward, we will drive to Tzipori (Sepphoris) to visit the ruins of this ancient city. We will continue to drive to the Upper Galilee and visit Tel Dan "Then all Israel from Dan to Beersheba and from the land of Gilead came together as one and assembled before the Lord in Mizpah." (Jdgs. 20:1) We then continue to Caesarea Philippi, one of the three sources of the Jordan River, where St. Peter officially recognizes Jesus as the Messiah (Mark 8: 27-30). We will finish our day riding a boat on the Sea of Galilee.

Tonight: Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 5 — CAPERNAUM \bullet BETHSAIDA \bullet MT. OF BEATITUDES \bullet TABGHA \bullet GADARENES

Today: After breakfast, we will drive to Bethsaida, the home of Philip, Peter, and Andrew (John 1:44). Our next few stops will be Chorazin (Mat. 11:21-23), the Mt. of Beatitudes (Sermon on the Mount), and Tabgha, where the Lord fed a crowd of 5,000 with only two fish and five loaves of bread (Mark 6:32-44). Afterward, we will visit Capernaum, Jesus's home for nearly two years, where he invited Peter, Andrew, James, and John to become His disciples (Mark 1:16-21). More recorded miracles took place here than anywhere else. This afternoon, we will drive to the site of the Gadarenes (known today as Kursi), where the Lord permits the Demons to enter the herd of swine (Luke 8: 26-40).

Tonight: Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 6 — BETH-SHE'AN • JERICHO • QASR EL YAHUD (JORDAN RIVER)

Today: This morning, we will leave Galilee and drive to Beit She'an, where the bodies of Saul and his 3 sons were hung on the city walls by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:8-12). Beit She'an was one of the 10 Gentiles Cities (The Decapolis), and today we will see the Roman Theatre, Palladius Street (main street), the Roman Temple, and bathhouses. Next, we will travel to Jericho, the world's oldest city. Traces of inhabitants of this ancient city go back over 9,000 years. We will see the great "Wall of Jericho" and the fountain of Elisha. Here, the spring's bitter waters were turned sweet by the prophet's handful of salt (2 Kings 11- 15). It was also near this city that Jesus gave a blind Bartimaeus his sight back (Mark 10:46-52). Finally, we will visit the Mt. of Temptation (Matt 4:1) before continuing to Qasr el Yahud (Jordan River baptismal site).

Tonight: Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 7 — JERUSALEM • THE DEAD SEA

Today: After breakfast, we will travel through the Judaean Desert to Qumran, where the Dead Sea scrolls were discovered in 1947. Next, we'll have the opportunity to swim (or float) in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea. Our next stop is Masada, where a determined band of Jewish Zealots, in the face of unimaginable hardship, held off the Romans for an incredible three years after Jerusalem fell to Titus in 70 AD. We will arrive

at the foot of the Mountain and ascend to the summit by cable car, then tour the ruins and hear the account of one of the most fascinating tragedies in recorded history.

Tonight: After our visit, we will return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 8 — OLD CITY OF JERUSALEM • BETHLEHEM

Today: After breakfast, we begin on Mt. of Olives, visiting the Chapel of the Ascension and the Pater Noster before descending to see the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations. Next, we will drive to Bethlehem, the starlit village where Mary and Joseph took shelter when there was no room in the Inn (Luke 1: 4-7) and gave birth to the Son of God. We will pass by Mother Rachel's Tomb, then visit the Church of Nativity and Shepherds' Field, where the Angel of God appeared to the Shepherds announcing the birth of the Messiah (Luke 2:8-20). Afterward, we will have time for shopping before returning to Jerusalem. Once we arrive, we will view the Model of Jerusalem at the time of the 2nd Temple before continuing our tour in Ein Karem, the birthplace of John the Baptist. We will end our day visiting Yad Vashem, Israel's official memorial to the victims of the Holocaust, followed by The Knesset Menorah, a bronze Menorah 4.30 meters high, 3.5 meters wide, weighing 4 tons!

Tonight: Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 9 — JERUSALEM

Today: After breakfast this morning, we will enter the Old City via the Dung Gate for a walking tour. We will visit the Wailing Wall and enter through the Southern Steps (the main entrance to the Temple in the time of Jesus). Once we leave the Old City, we will drive to the Lions Gate (St. Stephen Gate) and walk to the Pool of Bethesda (John 5). Next, we follow in the footsteps of Jesus along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre and through the Christian and Jewish Quarters to Mt. Zion for a visit to King David's Tomb and the Upper Room of the Last Supper (Luke 22: 7, 13). Next is St. Peter in Gallicantu (House of Caiaphas), where St. Peter denied Jesus three times before the rooster crowed (Mat. 26: 69-75). This afternoon, we will visit the Shrine of the Book at the Israeli Museum and continue to the Garden Tomb for a service.

Tonight: Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 10 — RETURN FLIGHT HOME

Today: After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport to catch our return flight home.

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Single Room: There is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers two (2) meals per day: Breakfast & Dinner. Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/ points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due Friday, December 29, 2023 (100 days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

You may use any major credit card to pay your deposit online. There is an additional 3% late fee for each credit card transaction. We also accept checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

100 days - 61 days prior to departure.....\$150

60 days - 30 days prior to departure......\$300

30 days - day before departure.....Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:


