



DAY 1: DEPARTURE FROM USA

(*Monday, Sept. 16*) We will depart our overnight flight to Santiago. Meals and beverages will be served in-flight.

DAY 2: SANTIAGO

(*Tuesday, Sept. 17*) Upon arrival at the Santiago-Rosalia de Castro Airport, we will meet our tour manager and enjoy a quick panoramic city tour. After stopping to eat, we will continue (1.5 hours) to Sarria to prepare for our Camino. Sarria is the last place to start your Camino walk and collect your Compostela (or certificate of completion) in Santiago. We will pick up our pilgrim's passport and a scallop shell and walk the quiet streets as we open our hearts to the Holy Spirit. This evening at dinner, we share our thoughts, goals, and logistics for the daily walks ahead. Overnight in Sarria.

DAY 3: PORTOMARIN

(Wednesday, Sept. 18) As we leave Sarria, we will pass Sarria Castle, with its one remaining tower. The rest were destroyed in the peasants' uprising against the aristocracy in the 15th Century. Today, we will be walking along shady tree-lined roads and pathways. This morning, we'll pass through small hamlets like Cortinas and A Brea before reaching the stone marker. We'll have a photo opportunity before taking the first step on the final 100km to Santiago. The Camino ascends to a high point at Pena dos Corvos. At 660m, we will enjoy fantastic panoramic views before descending into the lush Rio Mino Valley to Mercadoiro and Portomarin. Enjoy the Galician ambiance as we stroll up the cobbled main street and end our day by relaxing in one of the cafés surrounding the square. (Walk: 13.67 miles, 6 hrs.)

DAY 4: PALAS DE REI

(*Thursday, Sept. 19*) Today, the Camino crosses the Minho River and steadily climbs upwards, passing through the settlement of Gonzar and Castromaior, where we will find the tiny Romanesque Church of Santa Maria. Next, we will continue along country roads edged by bright yellow gorse, pine, and oak trees. Upon reaching the high point of today's Camino at Sierra de Ligonde (750m), we will descend to the ancient hamlet of Ligonde. After passing Eirexe, we will cross the Alto Rosario and descend into the village of Palace de Rei. (*Walk:* 15.53 miles, 6 hrs.)

DAY 5: ARZUA

(*Friday, Sept. 20*) Leaving Palace de Rei, we will soon reach San Xulian do Camino, a classic Camino village with a tiny 12th-century church dedicated to Saint Julian. After crossing the provincial border, we pass through the hamlet of O Coto and the village of Leboreiro. We might stop for lunch in Melide, known for its "Pulpo Galega," a famous octopus dish. The shaded forests of

oak and chestnut give way to eucalyptus and pine before we ascend to Arzua. (Walk: 18.33 miles, 7 hrs.)

DAY 6: RUA

(Saturday, Sept. 21) Leaving the old quarter of Arzua, the Camino leads past sturdy oak trees, which give way to lush meadows. We will visit the medieval shrine at Santa Irene, which is dedicated to a martyr saint from Portugal, and the Baroque fountain of healing waters. Throughout the day, we will walk through beautiful villages, including Brea, Calzada, Rua, and A Calle, which means Camino. (Walk: 11.18 miles, 4.5 hrs.)

DAY 7: SANTIAGO

(Sunday, Sept. 22) Today, we have a fabulous day walking to the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela. First, we will stop in San Paio and Lavacolla, where it was traditional for pilgrims to wash in the river before reaching Santiago. Tall eucalyptus trees sway in the wind as we reach the Monte del Gozo or 'Mount of Joy' (368m). From here, we can see the impressive spires of the Santiago de Compostela Cathedral. The final kilometers of our walk take us through the beautiful streets of Santiago, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Upon arrival, we will gather to celebrate and pray with time to walk the main square and then relax at our hotel. Following dinner, we will have time to explore the shops and tapas bars near the square. Each evening, local Tuna de Derecho de Santiago musicians perform a free concert of Galician music with fascinating costumes! (Walk: 13.98 miles, 5 hrs.)

DAY 8: SANTIAGO

(Monday, Sept. 23) This morning, we will receive our pilgrim certificate and celebrate the noon pilgrims Mass at the Basilica of St. James, followed by a guided basilica tour and time to embrace the statue of St. James. Be sure to arrive early as the Mass is a popular experience, often with standing room only. The rest of the day is YOURS to explore, wander, pray, and savor the flavors of Santiago. This evening, we will gather to share Camino insights and Godencounters.

DAY 9: SANTIAGO: DAY OF LEISURE, REST, AND REFLECTION

(*Tuesday, Sept. 24*) Rarely does a pilgrimage include an entire day for YOU! Here's a chance to explore Santiago in small groups or on your own. Our Camino pilgrimage comes to an end with Mass and a sumptuous farewell dinner.

DAY 10: RETURN TO THE USA

(*Wednesday, Sept. 25*) We will transfer to the Santiago-Rosalia de Castro Airport this morning for our return flight home.

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Single Room: There is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers two (2) meals per day: Breakfast & Dinner. **Baggage:** Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, porterage, fuel surcharges and security fees.

Medical Protection Plan is provided during the trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required. Passports must be valid 6 months after your return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing fees, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in your itinerary.

Lunch: You are responsible for lunch or any other meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips for your tour guide & driver: The recommended amounts of tips per person are \$7.00 - \$9.00 per day for guides, \$5.00 - \$7.00 per day for drivers, \$1.00 - \$2.00 per day for hotels, and \$1.00 - \$2.00 per day for restaurants.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different rate, ticketing method, or airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air. We do not. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request, as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request, as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 06/07/24 (100 days before departure). Registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

You may use any major credit card to pay your deposit online. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction. We also accept checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive late fees if they are not paid in full:

100 days - 61 days prior to departure.....\$150

60 days - 30 days prior to departure......\$300

30 days - day before departure.....Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage. However, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:
