Daily Itinerary

DAY 1: DEPARTURE / USA TO ROME

Your pilgrimage begins today, boarding your flight to Rome. Meals and drinks are served on board.

DAY 2: ROME

Upon arrival in Rome, we will meet our local guide, board our touring vehicle, and begin a panoramic tour of the “Eternal City.” We will continue to your hotel to settle in and unpack. There will be free time for personal activities, and dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 3: ROME / VATICAN CITY / PAPAL AUDIENCE

We begin by attending a public papal audience with Pope Francis. Afterward, we will visit the Vatican Museums to see centuries of incredible artwork and artifacts. We will explore the magnificent St. Peter’s Basilica and see Michelangelo’s “Pieta,” the Sistine Chapel, and the Tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian’s Chapel. Afterward, we’ll stop for a visit at Santa Cecilia Basilica in Trastevere. We will then drive through Rome and take in the sites on the way back to your hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 4: ROME

We begin our day by visiting the Basilica of St. Mary Major, Rome’s largest church dedicated to the Blessed Mother. From here, we will visit the Scala Sancta, the stairs Christ climbed to stand before Pontius Pilate, and the Basilica of St. John Lateran, where Pope Innocent III permitted St. Francis to begin the Franciscan Order. Next, we will visit Rome’s second-largest basilica, the Church of St. Paul Outside the Walls, where the body of St. Paul is buried. We will continue to the Church of Domine Quo Vadis and the catacombs of St. Callixtus, where many early martyrs and popes of the early church are buried. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations in Rome.

DAY 5: ROME / MONTE CASSINO / SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

We begin our day by visiting the Basilica of St. Mary Major, Rome’s largest church dedicated to the Blessed Mother. From here, we will visit the Scala Sancta, the stairs Christ climbed to stand before Pontius Pilate, and the Basilica of St. John Lateran, where Pope Innocent III permitted St. Francis to begin the Franciscan Order. Next, we will visit Rome’s second-largest basilica, the Church of St. Paul Outside the Walls, where the body of St. Paul is buried. We will continue to the Church of Domine Quo Vadis and the catacombs of St. Callixtus, where many early martyrs and popes of the early church are buried. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations in Rome.

DAY 6: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO / MONTE SANT’ ANGELO

This morning, we will celebrate Mass at the tomb of St. Padre Pio and take a sanctuary tour. We will see the old church and the crucifix St. Pio stood before as he received the stigmata in 1918. We will see the confessional, where he directed people on their path and pray before St. Padre Pio’s incorrupt body. Moving on, we will have a stunning view of the Gargano Peninsula as we travel to the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 7: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO / LANCIANO / LORETO / CASCIA / ASSISI

We make our way to Lanciano and visit the Church of St. Longinus, where we will see the Eucharistic Miracle and celebrate Mass. Next, we will continue toward the Adriatic coast to the great Marian Shrine of Loreto to visit the Holy House of Nazareth and the beautiful Madonna of Loreto. Enjoy lunch before we make a stop in Cascia, where we will visit the Monastery and the Shrine of St. Rita, one of the most popular Italian saints. She was a married woman, a mother, a widow, a nun, a stigmatist, and later, a mystic. The Basilica of St. Rita contains her incorrupt body, several relics from her life, and a Eucharistic

miracle from before her time. We will then continue to Assisi, the hometown of St. Francis, the patron saint of animals and the founder of the Franciscan Order. Once we arrive, we will check into your hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 8: ASSISI / SIENA

We will celebrate Mass at St. Mary of the Angels Basilica, home to the Porziuncola, the tiny church in the woods where St. Francis began his ministry and where St. Clare began her religious life. We will tour the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi and view the crucifix that said to him, “Rebuild my Church.” Afterward, we will visit the Church of St. Clare, where her relics are kept. This afternoon, we will drive to Siena, where we will see the incorrupt relics of St. Catherine at the Basilica of St. Dominic. Next, we will visit the city’s magnificent Romanesque-Gothic cathedral, which was completed in 1380. Our final stop will be the Sanctuary of St. Catherine of Siena, which houses the Miraculous Crucifix from which she received her stigmata. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 9: SIENA / FLORENCE

Your full day in Florence begins at the Church of the Holy Cross and the Santa Croce, where many nobles such as Michelangelo, Galileo, and Machiavelli are buried. Next, we will walk through the Piazza Signorina, Palazzo Vecchio, Uffizi, Ponte Vecchio, and Republic Square to reach the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, an iconic piece of Florence architecture. Afterward, we will visit the L’Accademia art gallery, which contains works from Botticelli, Ghirlandaio, Pontormo, and Michelangelo’s David sculpture. Afterward, we will return to Siena for dinner & overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 10: FLORENCE / VENICE

We travel to Venice, known as “The Queen of the Adriatic.” There is a total absence of wheeled transportation in Venice, which makes it one of the most charming and poetic cities in the world. Our visit begins at the Basilica of St. Mark, adorned with golden mosaics and religious icons. It was built to honor the body of St. Mark, brought from Alexandria in Egypt. After Mass, we see the Piazza di San Marco and the Palazzo Ducale (the palace of the Doge, the political leader of Venice). The rest of your day is free to explore on your own, preferably in a gondola! Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 11: VENICE / PADUA / MILAN

This morning, we will travel to Padua and visit the Basilica of St. Anthony of Padua. We will celebrate Mass before continuing to Milan. The rest of the day is free to browse the Forza boutiques or stroll through the luxury outlets of the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele arcade. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 12: MILAN

Today, we will travel to Milan! Upon arrival, we will visit the famous Duomo, known as the most magnificent Gothic building in Northern Italy. Next, we will tour the Basilica and tomb of St. Ambrose, followed by the Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie, where we will celebrate Mass (subject to availability and reconfirmation). Afterward, we will stop at Castel Sforzesco and the famous La Scala Opera House. This evening, enjoy a special dinner (on us) with your spiritual director and fellow pilgrims as you share the experience of your spiritual journey together in Italy. Overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 13: MILAN / USA

We will transfer to the airport this morning to catch our return flight home.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip fares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Single Room: There is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers two (2) meals per day: Breakfast & Dinner.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, portorage, fuel surcharges and security fees.

Medical Protection Plan is provided during the trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required. Passports must be valid 6 months after your return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing fees, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in your itinerary.

Lunch: You are responsible for lunch or any other meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips for your tour guide & driver: The recommended amounts of tips per person are \$7.00 – \$9.00 per day for guides, \$5.00 – \$7.00 per day for drivers, \$1.00 – \$2.00 per day for hotels, and \$1.00 – \$2.00 per day for restaurants.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different rate, ticketing method, or airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air. We do not. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request, as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request, as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 07/05/24 (100 days before departure). Registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

You may use any major credit card to pay your deposit online. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction. We also accept checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive late fees if they are not paid in full:

100 days - 61 days prior to departure.....\$150

60 days - 30 days prior to departure.....\$300

30 days - day before departure.....Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

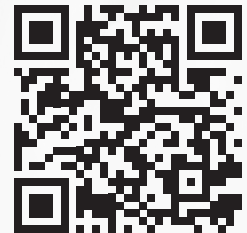
Cancellation/Refund Policy

49 Days	100% of trip cost
