



Your pilgrimage begins today when you board your flight to Venice. Rest assured, all necessary preparations for your journey have been taken care of. So, sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight. Your spiritual journey awaits in Venice!

DAY 2 VENICE

There is no wheeled transportation in Venice, which makes it one of the most charming and poetic cities in the world! Our visit begins at the Basilica of St. Mark, adorned with golden mosaics and religious icons. It was built to honor the body of St. Mark, brought from Alexandria in Egypt. After Mass, we will see the Piazza di San Marco and the Palazzo Ducale (the palace of the Doge, the political leader of Venice). The rest of your day is free to explore this exotic city, preferably on a gondola! Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 3 PADUA/ SAN MARINO

DAY 1 DEPARTURE: U.S. TO VENICE

Today, we will depart Venice and continue our pilgrimage to Padua, where we will celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Anthony of Padua. After Padua, we will continue to San Marino for the evening. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 4 SAN MARINO / LORETO / ASSISI

This morning, we will visit the city of Marino and explore the Historic Centre and Mount Titano, which became part of the UNESCO World Heritage List in 2008. Later, we will depart for Loreto, where we will celebrate mass at the Marian Shrine of Loreto and visit the Holy House of Nazareth and the beautiful Madonna of Loreto. After a basilica tour, we continue to Assisi. There will be free time to shop/explore depending on arrival time. Dinner & overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 5 ASSISI

This morning, we will celebrate Mass at St. Mary of the Angels Basilica, the home of the Porziuncola, the small church where the Franciscan movement began. Next, we will tour the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi and view many of his possessions, like the crucifix that said to him, "Rebuild my Church." We will also visit the chapel where St. Francis spent most of his time, followed by the Church of St. Clare. The rest of the day is free for you to shop or relax. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 6 SIENA / SAN GIMIGNANO

Our day begins by traveling to Siena. First, we will see the city's beautiful Romanesque-Gothic cathedral (built in 1380). Next, we will visit the Sanctuary of St. Catherine of Siena, which holds the Miraculous Crucifix from which she received her stigmata. We will then walk the Piazza del Campo and see the Palazzo Pubblico (Town Hall) and the Tower of Mangia. Finally, we will view the incorrupt relics of St. Catherine of Siena at the Basilica of St. Dominic. Afterward, depending on time, we will visit San Gimignano and return to your hotel in Siena. If time doesn't allow, we will visit San Gimignano on our way to Florence in the morning. Dinner & overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

Today, our pilgrimage continues to the city of Florence. We will spend the whole day visiting many sites, including the Church of the Holy Cross and the Santa Croce, where Michelangelo, Galileo, and Machiavelli are buried. Next, we will walk through the Piazza Signorina, Palazzo Vecchio, Uffizi, Ponte Vecchio, and Republic Square to the Santa Maria del Fiore Cathedral, an iconic piece of Florence architecture. Afterward, we will visit the famous L'Accademia art gallery and view the works of Botticelli, Ghirlandaio, Pontormo, and Michelangelo's sculpture of David. Afterward, you will have some free time to explore on your own before returning to your hotel this evening for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 8 PISA / ROME

We will depart Florence for Pisa. Upon arrival, we will visit the Piazza del Miracoli, one of the finest architectural complexes in the world dominated by Pisa Cathedral, the Pisa Baptistery, the Leaning Tower of Pisa, and the Camposanto Monumentale. Afterward, we will continue to Rome for the evening. Dinner & overnight accommodations will be at vour hotel.

DAY 9 VATICAN CITY / BASILICA OF ST. JOHN THE LATERAN / HOLY STAIRS / BASILICA OF ST. MARY MAJOR

This morning, we will attend the Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square with His Holiness Pope Francis! Following the audience, we will visit the Basilica of St. John the Lateran, Rome's oldest major basilica. You will then cross the street to visit the Holy Stairs, brought to Rome by Saint Helena in the fourth century. They are the same steps Jesus climbed to Pontius Pilate's praetorian during his Passion. Finally, we conclude our day with Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major, the only Basilica that has kept its original structure and remains an authentic jewel in the crown of Roman Churches. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel

DAY 10 ST. PETER'S BASILICA / VATICAN MUSEUM / APPIAN WAY / **BASILICA OF ST. PAUL OUTSIDE THE WALLS / CATACOMBS**

This morning, we will have an early breakfast before visiting the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica! It stands on the site where St. Peter, the first Pope and Bishop of Rome, was martyred. Here, you will view Michelangelo's Pieta, the stunning marble sculpture depicting the Virgin Mary holding Christ after His crucifixion. Next, we will continue to the Vatican Museums and see the most impressive buildings, art galleries, and awe-inspiring relics. Additionally, you will observe the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, and the world-famous Sistine Chapel. You will also see Michelangelo's Masterpiece, the restored mural of the Last Judgment. Your final stop will be the tomb of Saint John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. After lunch, we will continue our journey down the Appian Way, the earliest road of Ancient Rome. This afternoon, we will tour the Quo Vadis Chapel, the Baths of Caracalla, the Arch of Drusus, the Tomb of Cecilia Metella, the catacombs of St. Callixtus, and the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 11 DEPARTURE: ROME / U.S.

We will transfer to the airport this morning for your return flight home.

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Landonly travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.


