Welcome to an American city where history truly does come to life. Be sure to visit Bunker Hill Monument, Paul Revere's House, the Old North Church, Quincy Market, and the mansions of Beacon Hill. Then wander Boston Common, the oldest public park in the U.S.

Opulent clapboard villas lead the way towards Charlottetown's beautiful Victoria Park. Color is everywhere - from the Victorian architecture to the red sandstone cliffs. Sample homemade island jams, visit the Anne of Green Gables homestead, and stroll the boardwalk.

DAY 4: SYDNEY, CAPE BRETON ISLAND, NOVA SCOTIA

The coal industry brought immigration from many parts of the world, giving Sydney a multicultural mix of over 50 ethnic backgrounds and a global flavor to its history. Located on Cape Breton Island, Sydney is also an ideal jumping-off point for scenic adventures.

DAY 5: HALIFAX, NOVA SCOTIA

Admire the rugged coastline that surrounds Halifax, the world's second-largest natural harbor. This beautifully preserved city is Nova Scotia's capital and was founded in 1749. Take steps through history and climb to The Citadel to witness the Old Town Clock.

DAY 6: PORTLAND, MAINE

Portland offers all the amenities of a big city: art districts, a vibrant waterfront, museums, parks, and diverse shopping opportunities. But within minutes, you can be enjoying the view from a historic lighthouse or tasting a juicy, local lobster.

DAY 7: BAR HARBOR, MAINE

This coastal attraction has retained much of its charm since its glory days in the 1900s, when America's elite vacationed here in opulent summer cottages. Surrounding the rock-bound harbor is the world-famous Acadia National Park, where the opulence of nature is on display.

TERMS CONDITIONS

Your Package Includes

Cruise Transportation: Round-trip cruise from your assigned departure city.

Cruise Ship Accommodations: Rooms are based on double occupancy and inside cabin basis (\$1,990 per person). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate. Ocean view cabins are available for (\$2,290 per person). Balcony cabins are available for (\$3,190).

Meal Plan: All meals on board are included in your package. Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Medical Protection Plan is provided during the trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Airline Tickets: Your cruise departs from Boston. Flights are available from Myrtle Beach to Boston at an additional \$730 per person (not including luggage).

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, porterage, fuel surcharges and security fees.

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: (if applicable) Passports or any additional documents that may be required. Passports must be valid 6 months after your return date.

Personal Items/Expenses

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing fees, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in your itinerary.

Extra Meals: You are responsible for any meals/beverages not specified in your itinerary.

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 100 days before departure (06/25/24). Registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable. You may use any major credit card to pay your deposit online. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction. We also accept checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive late fees if they are not paid in full:

100 days - 61 days prior to departure.....\$150 60 days - 30 days prior to departure......\$300 30 days - day before departure.....Subject to cancellation Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage. However, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will
