DAY 1: FLIGHT TO ROME, ITALY

Your Jubilee pilgrimage begins by boarding your international flight to Rome. Meals and drinks will be served on-board. Enjoy your flight. Your spiritual journey awaits in Italy!

DAY 2: ROME / TREVI FOUNTAIN / PANTHEON / SPANISH STEPS

Upon arrival at Leonardo da Vinci–Fiumicino Airport, you will meet your professional tour guide and board your luxury deluxe touring vehicle. As we exit the airport, we will begin a panoramic tour to get acquainted with "The Eternal City." We will stop by the famous Trevi Fountain, where there will be free time for lunch. Afterward, your tour continues at the Pantheon and the Spanish Steps. Afterward, we will proceed to your hotel for the evening. Dinner and overnight in Rome

DAY 3: PAPAL AUDIENCE / VATICAN / VATICAN MUSEUM / ST. MARY MAJOR

After an early breakfast at your hotel, we will proceed to the Vatican for the Papal Audience with Pope Francis in St. Peter's Square! After the audience, we will walk through the Holy Doors of the grand St. Peter's Basilica! We will celebrate Mass, explore the basilica, and continue with a guided tour of the Vatican Museums, the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, the world-famous Sistine Chapel, and the tomb of Saint John Paul II. We will leave the Vatican and continue to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of Rome's four major basilicas, where we will walk through the Holy Doors. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 4: ST. JOHN LATERAN / HOLY STAIRS / ST. PAUL OUTSIDE THE WALLS / CATACOMBS

This morning, you will enjoy an early breakfast before walking through the Holy Doors of St. John Lateran, Rome's oldest major basilica, which contains the relics of Peter and Paul. Next, we will visit the Holy Stairs, the steps Christ walked during his Passion leading up to Pontius Pilate's praetorian in Jerusalem. They were brought to Rome by St. Helena in the fourth century. Afterward, we will continue our journey down the Appian Way, the earliest road of Ancient Rome, which leads to the Domino Quo Vadis Chapel, the Baths of Caracalla, the Arch of Drusus, the Tomb of Cecilia Metella, and the Catacombs of St. Callixtus. Our day concludes by walking through the Holy Doors at the last of Rome's four major basilicas: The Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, the burial place of St. Paul the Apostle. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 5: ROME / COLOSSEUM / ROMAN FORUM / BASILICA OF ST. GREGORY THE GREAT

After breakfast, we will begin our tour of Rome, starting at the Piazza Venezia. Today's sightseeing includes some of Rome's most famous sights, like Capitoline Hill, the Roman Forum, and the Pantheon. We will visit the Capitoline Museums and view one of Italy's finest collections of classical sculptures. We will then continue to the Basilica of St. Mary of the Altar of Heaven, the designated Church of Rome's city council. We will walk past the Mamertine Prison, where St. Peter and Paul were held before their executions, and continue to the Via dei Fori

Imperiali to view the Colosseum and the Arch of Constantine. After lunch, we will visit The Basilicas of St. Clement, St. Gregory the Great, and the Mother Teresa convent. Later, we will return to the hotel for a nice, relaxing evening. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 6: ROME / ASSISI

This morning, we will depart Rome and journey to Assisi, the hometown of St. Francis, the patron saint of animals and founder of the Franciscan Order. Upon arrival, we will celebrate Mass at St. Mary of the Angels Basilica. Inside is the Porziuncola, the tiny church in the woods where St. Francis started his ministry and St. Clare began her religious life. Next, we will tour the St. Francis of Assisi Basilica and view the crucifix that spoke the words to him, "Rebuild my Church." Afterward, we will visit the Church of St. Clare, a follower of St. Francis and founder of the Order of Poor Ladies, known today as the Order of Saint Clare. The rest of the day can be spent exploring independently, shopping, or relaxing. Later, we will return to your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Assisi.

DAY 7: ASSISI / LORETO / LANCIANO / SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

After breakfast, we will leave our hotel and journey toward the Adriatic coast to the great Marian Shrine of Loreto, a famous Catholic Pilgrimage site since the 14th century. Here, we will visit the Basilica of the Holy House, which enshrines the Holy House of Nazareth, the home in which the Blessed Virgin Mary is believed to have lived. Next, we will continue to Lanciano, where we will celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Longinus, home of an 8th-century Eucharistic Miracle. If time allows, there will be free time to explore independently before returning to San Giovanni Rotondo. Dinner and overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.

DAY 8: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO / MONTE SANT' ANGELO / CAVE OF ST. MICHAEL

After breakfast, we will start our day at the Old Church, where we will celebrate Mass. After Mass, we will tour the sanctuary and view the crucifix St. Pio stood before as he received the stigmata in 1918. After your tour, we will travel along the beautiful Gargano Peninsula to Monte Sant' Angelo and the Cave of St. Michael, where in the year 492, it is believed that Michael the Archangel appeared to a Bishop whose diocese was threatened with annihilation by pagans. St. Michael assured the bishop they would be saved. Today, almost a million pilgrims per year travel to the cave to pray for the intercession of St. Michael. Afterward, we will return to your hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo. Dinner and overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.

DAY 9: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO / MONTE CASSINO / ROME

After breakfast, we will check out of our hotel and travel through the rich Italian countryside of vineyards, orchards, and olive groves to Monte Cassino, a town founded by St. Benedict in 529. We will tour the magnificent Monte Cassino Abbey, where St. Benedict started the Benedictine Order. Afterward, we will visit the Church of St. Peter and Paul before continuing to your hotel in Rome for the evening. Dinner and overnight accommodations in Rome

DAY 10: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

This morning, we will transfer to the airport to catch our return flight home, sharing beautiful memories of our spiritual journey together.

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Single Room: There is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers two (2) meals per day: Breakfast & Dinner.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, porterage, fuel surcharges and security fees.

Medical Protection Plan is provided during the trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required. Passports must be valid 6 months after your return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing fees, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in your itinerary.

Lunch: You are responsible for lunch or any other meals not specified in your itinerary. **Tips for your tour guide & driver:** The recommended amounts of tips per person are \$7.00 – \$9.00 per day for guides, \$5.00 – \$7.00 per day for drivers, \$1.00 – \$2.00 per day for hotels, and \$1.00 – \$2.00 per day for restaurants.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different rate, ticketing method, or airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air. We do not. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request, as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request, as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 04/18/25 (100 days before departure). Registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

You may use any major credit card to pay your deposit online. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction. We also accept checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive late fees if they are not paid in full:

100 days - 61 days prior to departure.....\$150

60 days - 30 days prior to departure......\$300

30 days - day before departure......Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy
