DAY 1: DEPART FOR LISBON

(Sunday, Oct. 12) Today, you will board your international flight to Lisbon, Portugal. Rest assured, all necessary preparations for your journey have been made. Just sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight.

DAY 2: ARRIVE IN LISBON

(Monday, Oct. 13) Upon arrival at Humberto Delgado Airport in Lisbon, you will meet your Nativity Pilgrimage tour guide. We will have a nice panoramic tour from the tour bus on our way to the hotel as we get familiar with some of the city's famous sites. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Lisbon.

DAY 3: LISBON

(Tuesday, Oct. 14) We start the day at St. Anthony's Church, dedicated to St. Anthony of Lisbon and built on the site where the saint was born in 1195. Afterward, we will see the Monument of Discoveries on the northern bank of the Tagus River, which celebrates the Portuguese Age of Discovery. Finally, we will visit the Baroque-style Church of St. Stephen before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations in Lisbon.

DAY 4: LISBON – FATIMA

(Wednesday, Oct. 15) After breakfast, we will continue our pilgrimage to Santarem and visit the Church of St. Stephen, home of the Eucharistic miracle of Santarém, also called the Most Holy Miracle, which occurred in the 13th century. It is one of the most famous and recognized eucharistic miracles in the world. After our visit, we will continue to Fatima. Upon arrival, we will visit Aljustrel, a hamlet on Fatima's outskirts. This is the birthplace of Lúcia dos Santos and Francisco and Jacinta Marto, the three shepherd children. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Fatima. After dinner, feel free to join the evening candlelight procession.

DAY 5: FATIMA

(Thursday, Oct. 16) Today, we will explore the Sanctuary of Fatima, including the Chapel of Apparitions, where the three children received the Blessed Mother's Apparitions, and the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary. Later, we will participate in the Stations of the Cross. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Fatima.

DAY 6: FATIMA – SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

(Friday, Oct. 17) After breakfast, we will drive to Porto, Portugal's second city. While here, we will have a Porto wine tasting. Afterward, we will continue our pilgrimage to Santiago de Compostela, Spain. Upon arrival, we will visit the Cathedral and Tomb of St. James and the famous Bell Tower. Finally, we will proceed to your hotel for the evening. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Santiago de Compostela.

DAY 7: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

(Saturday, Oct. 18) After breakfast, we will take a short walk and discover the Camino Finisterre, a unique pilgrimage route diverging from Santiago de Compostela. This afternoon, we will explore more of the city and have evening Mass at the Cathedral. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Santiago de Compostela.

DAY 8: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA – AVILA

(Sunday, Oct. 19) After breakfast, we will continue our pilgrimage through the city of Salamanca, home to the University of Salamanca, the oldest active university in Spain, founded in 1218. We will be exploring sites important to St. Teresa of Avila. Afterward, we will continue to Avila, the home of St. Teresa. This afternoon, we will explore both the Convent of St. Teresa and the Monastery of the Incarnation. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Avila.

DAY 9: AVILA – SAN SEBASTIAN

(Monday, Oct. 20) This morning, we will visit the Avila Cathedral, a beautiful cathedral built in the late Romanesque and Gothic architectural traditions. After exploring more of the city, we will drive to San Sebastian via Burgos, home to a magnificent cathedral whose construction began in 1221 in the style of French Gothic architecture. Afterward, we will continue to San Sebastian for the evening. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in San Sebastian.

DAY 10: SAN SEBASTIAN – LOYOLA – LOURDES

(Tuesday, Oct. 21) After breakfast this morning, we will continue our pilgrimage to Loyola to learn the story of St. Ignatius. After our visit, we will continue to Lourdes for the evening. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Lourdes. After dinner, you are free to join the candlelight procession.

DAY 11: LOURDES

(Wednesday, Oct. 22) After breakfast, we will take a walking tour of Lourdes and explore Boly Mill, where St. Bernadette was born, and Le Cachot. This museum was once a dungeon where St. Bernadette and her poverty-stricken family were forced to live in 1857. Dinner & overnight accommodations at your hotel in Lourdes.

DAY 12: LOURDES – MANRESA – MONTSERRAT – BARCELONA

(Thursday, Oct. 23) This morning, after breakfast, we will drive to Barcelona via Manresa & Montserrat, where we will visit the famous Montserrat Abbey, an abbey of the Benedictine Order that enshrines the image of the Virgin of Montserrat. After our visit, we will continue to Barcelona. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 13: BARCELONA

(Friday, Oct. 24) Today, we will explore the city of Barcelona! Today's sites include the world-famous La Sagrada Familia, Las Ramblas, and Parc de Montjuic. Enjoy your last day of pilgrimage exploring this incredible city! Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 14: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

(Saturday, Oct. 25) As our pilgrimage ends, we will transfer to the airport this morning to catch our return flight home.



Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Protection Plan During the Trip

Spiritual Director: Fr. Mark will be the tour Spiritual Director but any change at the request of the Archbishop or personal emergency could affect his participation on the pilgrimage. If so, local Masses will be substituted.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required. Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Extra food/beverage: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips for your tour guide & driver: The recommended amounts of tips per person are \$7.00 – \$9.00 per day for guides, \$5.00 – \$7.00 per day for drivers, \$1.00 – \$2.00 per day for hotels, and \$1.00 – \$2.00 per day for restaurants.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room Supplement: Tour price based on double-occupancy. If you wish to stay in a single room, there is an additional single room supplement of \$1,200. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 100 Days before departure on **07/01/25**. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

You may use any major credit card to pay your deposit online. There is an additional 3% charge for each credit card transaction. We also accept checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

100 days - 61 days prior to departure.....\$150

60 days - 30 days prior to departure.....\$300

30 days - day before departure.....Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.
