Get ready for an awe-inspiring day as we visit Meteora, home to the stunning "Hanging Monasteries" atop unique rock formations. Our journey continues through Kozani to Veria, with a stop at the tomb of Philip of Macedonia in Vergina. In Thessaloniki, we'll explore the Rotonda, the



Triumphal Arch of Galerius, and stroll along the beautiful seafront promenade with the iconic White Tower. Tonight, enjoy a delightful dinner at our hotel with fellow travelers.

### \*\*DAY 8: THESSALONIKI / PHILIPPI\*\*

Today, we'll visit Amphipolis to see the iconic Lion Statue and then head to Philippi, where Marc Anthony triumphed over Brutus and St. Paul preached the Gospel in Europe. We'll explore the archaeological site, including the Forum-Romanum, the theatre, the Basilicas, the Prison of St. Paul, and St. Lydia's Baptistry. Finally, we'll stop by the charming town of Kavala before returning to Thessaloniki for a delicious dinner and a cozy overnight stay.

### \*\*DAY 9: THESSALONIKI / ATHENS\*\*

As we journey back to Athens, we'll pass through the scenic Valley of Tempi and reflect on the historic events at Thermopylae. Tonight, a lovely dinner and overnight stay await us at our hotel in Athens - the perfect way to unwind after a day of exploration.
