DAY 2: ROME • TREVI FOUNTAIN

Welcome to beautiful Rome! Our friendly guide will take you on a panoramic tour of the "Eternal City," including the iconic Trevi Fountain, with some free time for lunch. Afterward, we'll head to your cozy hotel to unwind before a delightful dinner and a restful night.

DAY 3: PAPAL AUDIENCE • ST. PETER'S BASILICA • VATICAN MUSEUM • ST. MARY MAJOR

Get ready for an unforgettable experience as we begin our journey with a Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square! Each Wednesday, Pope Francis welcomes faithful from around the world, making this a special occasion (subject to his schedule). After the audience, we'll walk through the Holy Doors and explore the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica! Our adventure continues at the Vatican Museums, where you'll marvel at the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, and the Sistine Chapel, home to Michelangelo's Last Judgment. We'll conclude our tour at the tomb of Saint John Paul II, followed by a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major. After a fulfilling day, enjoy a delightful dinner and relax at your hotel, ready for more beautiful memories.

DAY 4: ST. JOHN LATERAN • HOLY STAIRS / APPIAN WAY / ST. PAUL OUTSIDE THE WALLS / CATACOMBS

This morning begins with an energizing breakfast before setting off to explore the Basilica of St. John the Lateran, Rome's oldest major basilica and home to

the relics of Saints Peter and Paul. You'll be standing where Pope Francis began his journey as Bishop of Rome. Nearby, visit the Holy Stairs, the steps that Jesus ascended to trial, brought to Rome by Saint Helena. Then, journey down the ancient Appian Way, discovering sites like the Domino Quo Vadis Chapel, Baths of Caracalla, Arch of Drusus, the Tomb of Cecilia Metella, and the catacombs of St. Callixtus. End your day at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, before enjoying a delightful dinner and relaxing night at your hotel.

DAY 5: ROME / COLOSSEUM / ROMAN FORUM / BASILICA OF ST. GREGORY THE GREAT

Get ready for an exciting walking tour of Rome! We'll start at Piazza Venezia and explore iconic landmarks like Capitoline Hill, the Roman Forum, and the Pantheon. Our first stop is the Capitoline Museums, showcasing incredible classical sculptures. Then, we'll visit the Basilica of St. Mary of the Altar of Heaven and pass by the historic Mamertine Prison. Continuing to Via dei Fori Imperiali, we'll tour the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, and the Arch of Constantine. After lunch, we'll visit the Basilica di San Clemente and the beautiful Basilica of San Gregorio Magno al Celio. We'll wrap up with a heartfelt prayer at Mother Teresa's convent, followed by a cozy dinner and a restful stay at your hotel.

DAY 6: ROME / ASSISI

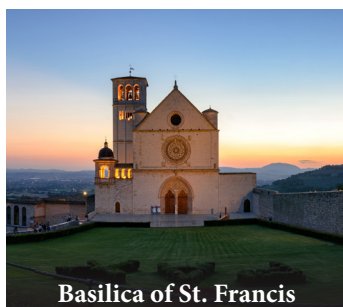

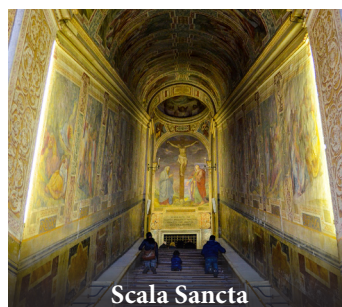

DAY 8: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO / MONTE SANT' ANGELO

This morning, after a delightful breakfast, you'll visit the Old Church for Mass and explore the sanctuary, home to a significant crucifix for St. Pio. Don't miss the confessional where he offered guidance. Next, enjoy a scenic bus ride along the Gargano Peninsula to the Grotto of St. Michael the

Archangel, a sacred shrine. After your visit, unwind during your free time before returning to San Giovanni Rotondo, where you'll take in breathtaking ocean and countryside views. End the day with a delicious dinner and a restful overnight stay at your hotel, filled with anticipation for tomorrow!

DAY 9: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO / MONTE CASSINO / ROME

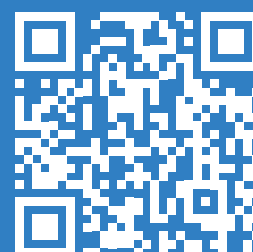

- U.S. passports must be current up to six months after the return date.
- We are not responsible for Visa procurement.
- Full payment is due 100 days before departure (06/20/25).



Terms & Conditions

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Medical coverage for the duration of the trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required. Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Tips: Tips/gratuities for tour guides, driver, and wait staff of included meals.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-Itinerary fees: Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Extra food/beverage: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only' option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 06/20/25 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

100 days - 61 days prior to departure.....\$150

60 days - 30 days prior to departure.....\$300

30 days - day before departure.....Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:
