### **DAY 1: FLIGHT TO DUBLIN**

(Thursday, Oct. 8th) Today, your pilgrimage begins as you depart on your international overnight flight to Ireland. Now it's time to relax, enjoy your flight, and focus on the incredible spiritual journey ahead.

### **DAY 2: DUBLIN | GALWAY**

(Friday, Oct. 9th) Upon arrival in Dublin, your tour director and driver will greet you with a cead mile failte (a hundred thousand welcomes). You will travel west to Galway, a charming city with quaint, narrow streets, shops, lively pubs. and traditional music. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel in Galway.

### **DAY 3: KYLEMORE ABBEY | GALWAY**

(Sat. Oct. 10th) After breakfast, which will be included every morning, we will visit the Galway Cathedral before traveling to the famous Kylemore Abbey (a Benedictine Abbey) and Victorian Walled Gardens. A "must see" this 19th century romantic castle is exquisite and steeped in history. Mass will be celebrated. Enjoy lunch on your own at the on-site café or the teahouse and free time to explore the


gardens. We will return to Galway in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel in Galway.

### **DAY 4: KNOCK SHRINE | GALWAY**

(Sun. Oct. 11th) Today, we will travel to Co. Mayo to visit the Knock Shrine, one of the world's leading Marian and Eucharistic apparition sites. For two hours, our Lady appeared silently in 1879 to fifteen men, women, and children, along with several other visions. Mass will be celebrated in the Apparition Chapel. After lunch on your own, there will be time for Reconciliation, meditation, praying, the outdoor Stations of the Cross. and shopping. Return to Galway for a leisurely evening exploring the town and dinner on your own. Overnight at your hotel in Galway.

### **DAY 5: CLIFFS OF MOHER | KILLARNEY**

(Mon. Oct. 12th) This morning, we depart Galway for County Clare to visit the breathtaking Cliffs of Moher, Ireland's most visited attraction. In the afternoon we will arrive in the scenic town of Killarney. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel in Killarney.

## DAY 6: DINGLE PENINSULA | KILLARNEY

(Tuesday, Oct. 13th) Today, we will travel to the picturesque fishing town of Dingle. Mass will be celebrated. Enjoy time at leisure for lunch, shopping, and exploring. In the afternoon, we will take the Slea Head drive along the Atlantic Ocean. We will see the ruins of the Romanesque Kilmalkeader Church, which is associated with St. Brendan the Navigator and St. Maolcethair. Our day concludes at the Muckross Traditional Farm & School House with an evening of music and dinner. Overnight at your hotel in Killarney.

### DAY 7: ROCK OF CASHEL | DUBLIN

(Wed. Oct. 14th) On our way to Dublin, we will stop at the Rock of Cashel, one of Ireland's oldest religious sites, where St. Patrick converted hundreds through his preaching. We will visit the beautiful Holy Cross Abbey with its relic of the True Cross. Mass will be celebrated. We will continue to Dublin for dinner and overnight at your hotel.

### **DAY 8: DUBLIN**

(Thurs. Oct. 15th) Our day begins with a visit to the Trinity College to see the magnificent Books of Kells, a 9th-century manuscript of the four gospels, and St. Patrick's Cathedral, built in honor of Ireland's patron saint. We will also visit Dublin's Pro-Cathedral. Mass will be celebrated. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure and dinner on your own. Overnight at your hotel in Dublin.

### **DAY 9: DUBLIN**

(Fri. Oct. 16th) Today is yours to explore this beautiful city on your own! Consider a self-guided tour at the Guinness Storehouse and Gravity Bar overlooking Dublin, an Irish whiskey tour, shopping, or relaxing. Mass will be celebrated. Our Farewell Dinner with Irish dancing will be at a local restaurant. Overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Dublin.

### **DAY 10: RETURN HOME**

(Sat. Oct. 17th) Our pilgrimage ends today as we depart Dublin on our return flight home, taking incredible memories to last a lifetime.

# Terms & Conditions

### **Your Package Includes**

**Air Transportation:** Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

**Baggage:** Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Porterage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Tips/Gratuities: Tips for tour guides, drivers, and wait staff for included meals.

### Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

**Personal Items:** Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

**Non-itinerary fees:** Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Extra food/beverage: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

#### **General Travel Information**

**Group Air:** Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

**Departure Cities:** If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

### **Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies**

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

### **Booking Conditions**

**Deposit:** A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 06/30/26 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

**Payment Methods:** We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

### **Late Payment Policy**

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Days Prior to Departure	Fee
100 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

### Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:
