DAY 1: FLIGHT TO ROME

Your incredible Jubilee pilgrimage commences as you board your international flight to the enchanting city of Rome! Relax and enjoy your meals and drinks on board while you anticipate the spiritual experiences awaiting you in Italy.

DAY 2: WELCOME TO ROME

Upon arriving at Leonardo da Vinci– Fiumicino Airport, you'll meet our tour guide and board a luxurious vehicle. We'll begin with a panoramic tour of Rome, stopping at the Trevi Fountain for lunch and exploration, followed by visits to the Pantheon and Spanish Steps. The day concludes with a relaxing evening and dinner at your hotel in beautiful Rome..

DAY 3: PAPAL AUDIENCE | VATICAN

After breakfast at your hotel, we'll visit the Vatican for a Papal Audience with Pope Francis in St. Peter's Square. We'll then enter St. Peter's Basilica for Mass and explore its beauty. Our guided tour will include highlights from the Vatican Museums, like the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, and the Sistine Chapel, as well as a visit to Saint John Paul II's tomb. We'll also tour the Basilica of St. Mary Major before enjoying dinner and an overnight stay in Rome.

DAY 4: ROME'S BASILICAS

This morning, after breakfast, we'll visit the Holy Doors of St. John Lateran, the oldest basilica in Rome, home to relics of Peter and Paul. Next, we'll see the Holy Stairs, stroll the ancient Appian Way, and visit the Quo Vadis Chapel, Baths of Caracalla, Arch of Drusus, Tomb of Cecilia Metella, and Catacombs of St. Callixtus. We'll conclude with a walk through the Holy Doors of St. Paul Outside the Walls before dinner and an overnight stay in Rome.

DAY 5: ANCIENT ROME

After breakfast, we'll explore Rome, starting at Piazza Venezia and visiting landmarks like Capitoline Hill, the Roman Forum, and the Pantheon. At the Capitoline Museums, we'll admire classical sculptures, then see the Basilica of St. Mary of the Altar of Heaven and the Mamertine Prison, with views of the Colosseum and the Arch of Constantine along Via dei Fori Imperiali. After lunch, we'll visit the Basilicas of St. Clement, St. Gregory the Great, and the Mother Teresa convent, wrapping up the day with dinner and an overnight stay in Rome.

DAY 6: ROME | ASSISI

This morning, we left Rome for a scenic journey to Assisi, the hometown of St. Francis. After arriving, we'll celebrate Mass at the beautiful St. Mary of the Angels Basilica, home to the Porziuncola, where St. Francis began his ministry. We'll also visit the Basilica of St. Francis, featuring the crucifix that inspired him, and the Church of St. Clare. You'll have free time to explore, shop, or relax before we return to the hotel for a lovely dinner and overnight stay in Assisi.

DAY 7: ASSISI | LORETO | LANCIANO | SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

This morning, after breakfast, we'll depart from Assisi towards the Adriatic coast and the Marian Shrine of Loreto, a significant pilgrimage site since the 14th century. We'll visit the Basilica of the Holy House, believed to be the dwelling of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Our journey continues to Lanciano for Mass at the Church of St. Longinus, known for its 8th-century Eucharistic Miracle. Depending on our timing, you may have some free time before heading to San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 8: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO | MONTE SANT' ANGELO

After breakfast, our day begins with a meaningful Mass at the Old Church, followed by a tour of the sanctuary. Here, you'll see the crucifix that St. Pio revered while undergoing the stigmata in 1918. Soon after, we'll embark on a picturesque journey along the breathtaking Gargano Peninsula to Monte Sant' Angelo and the Cave of St. Michael. Afterward, we will continue to our hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 9: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO | MONTE CASSINO | ROME

Today, we're excited to check out of our hotel and journey through the beautiful Italian countryside, with vineyards and olive groves. Our first stop is Monte Cassino, a historic town founded by St. Benedict in 529. We'll explore the Monte Cassino Abbey before heading to our hotel in Rome for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 10: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

This morning, we'll head to the airport, filled with wonderful memories from our spiritual journey.

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Porterage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon store registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage. General Travel Information

Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit. Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 08/01/25 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.
