DAY 2: ARRIVE IN ITALY - ORVIETO - ASSISI

Upon your arrival at Rome airport, you'll be warmly greeted and transported by coach through the beautiful Italian countryside. Our first stop is Orvieto, home to the stunning Cathedral dedicated to the Assumption of the Virgin, founded by Pope Nicholas IV in 1290. Explore this charming town, known as a Papal residence in the Middle Ages, and don't miss the vibrant Feast of Corpus Christi procession from the Duomo. The day concludes with check-in at your hotel in Assisi, followed by a delightful dinner and a restful night.

DAY 3: ASSISI

Our day in Assisi focuses on Saint Francis. After breakfast, we'll visit the Basilica of St. Francis to honor his tomb and see the crucifix that spoke to him. We'll also stop by St. Mary of the Angels Basilica and have free time to explore the medieval streets, shop, and enjoy lunch. In the afternoon, we'll visit the Santuario Della Spogliazione, home to Blessed Carlo Acutis' tomb. We'll end the day with a lovely dinner and a relaxing evening at our hotel.

DAY 4: ASSISI - LORETO - LANCIANO - SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

This morning, we'll visit the sacred Marian shrine of Loreto to see the Holy House of Nazareth and the Madonna of Loreto. Then, we'll travel to Lanciano for Mass at the historic Church of St. Longinus, reflecting on the eighth-century

Eucharistic Miracle. After Mass, enjoy free time in charming Lanciano before heading to San Giovanni Rotondo. Our day will end with dinner and an overnight stay at our hotel.

DAY 5: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO - SALERNO

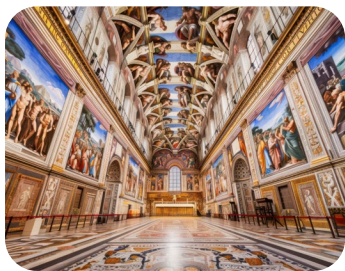

We'll visit his tomb and cell, the old church where he received the stigmata, and his confessional, culminating with a Mass at the beautiful new church of Santa Maria Delle Grazie. In the afternoon, we'll depart for Salerno, where you can look forward to another lovely dinner and an overnight stay in picturesque Sorrento.

DAY 6: AMALFI COAST

Get ready for an unforgettable adventure as we explore the breathtaking Amalfi Coast, famous for its stunning scenery! We'll journey along the winding 34-mile route, taking in the panoramic views of Positano and the charming town of Praiano. Our destination is Amalfi, where we'll marvel at the beautiful Amalfi Cathedral dedicated to Saint Andrew. After a wonderful day, we'll return by boat to Salerno, enjoy a lovely dinner, and share our stories before a restful night.

DAY 7: SORRENTO | ROME

This morning, we'll embark on an exciting journey to the coastal gem of Sorrento. Take this opportunity to wander through its enchanting streets filled with vibrant markets and enjoy spectacular views of the shimmering waters of Naples Bay. The delightful ambiance of Sorrento is sure to capture your heart! After savoring a delicious lunch, we'll head to the magnificent city of Rome, full of historical richness and cultural treasures.

DAY 8: ROME'S MAJOR BASILICAS

We'll start the day with breakfast before visiting the Basilica of St. John the Lateran, Rome's oldest basilica. We'll then explore the Holy Stairs, where we reflect on Jesus' Passion as we ascend on our knees. Our journey continues along the ancient Appian Way, uncovering sites like the Domino Quo Vadis Chapel, the Baths of Caracalla, and the Tomb of Cecilia Metella. We'll conclude at the Basilica of St. Paul, the resting place of Saint Paul the Apostle, before returning to our hotel for dinner and rest.

DAY 9: ANCIENT TREASURES OF ROME

Today, we'll embark on a walking tour of Rome, starting at Piazza Venezia. We'll visit iconic sites like Capitoline Hill, the Roman Forum, and the Pantheon, along with the Capitoline Museums. We'll see the Basilica of St. Mary of the Altar of Heaven and the historic Mamertine Prison. We'll stroll down Via dei Fori Imperiali to tour the Colosseum and admire the Arch of Constantine. After lunch, we'll visit the Trevi Fountain and the Spanish Steps, followed by a lovely evening at our hotel.

DAY 10: VATICAN CITY

We'll start our day at the Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square, a chance to hear from Pope Francis (subject to his schedule). Afterward, we'll explore St. Peter's Basilica, home to Michelangelo's Pietà. Next, we'll visit the Vatican Museums, including the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, and the Sistine Chapel with Michelangelo's Last Judgment. We'll also visit the tomb of Saint John Paul II for inspiration. Finally, we'll head to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, which holds a relic from the Manger of the Infant Jesus. Dinner and accommodations await us at our hotel.

DAY 11: RETURN HOME

As our unforgettable adventure comes to a close, we'll transfer to the airport this morning to board our flight home, cherishing the memories and experiences we have shared along the way.

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 06/30/25 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Days Prior to Departure	Fee
100 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

Days Prior to Departure	Penalty
