Enjoy the evening shopping at Forza boutiques or the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele Arcade. We'll finish the day with dinner and overnight accommodations in Milan.

DAY 3: PADOVA / VENICE

After a delightful breakfast, we'll set off toward Padova. Upon our arrival, we'll celebrate a heartfelt Mass at the Basilica of St. Anthony. Following this uplifting moment, we'll continue our adventure to the enchanting city of Venice, where we'll check into our hotel and rest up for a night filled with inspiration. Dinner and overnight accommodations await you in Venice.

DAY 4: VENICE / FLORENCE

Rise and shine! Today, we explore the enchanting city of Venice, known as "The Queen of the Adriatic." Our day begins at the stunning Basilica of St. Mark,

followed by a visit to the lively Piazza di San Marco and the impressive Palazzo Ducale, the Doge's former residence. After some free time to discover the city—perhaps a gondola ride—and conclude our adventures, we'll head to Florence for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 5: FLORENCE / ASSISI

DAY 6: ASSISI / ROME

Next, we'll visit the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi to admire the crucifix that spoke to him, urging him to "Rebuild my Church." We'll also explore the Church of St. Clare, who founded the Order of Poor Ladies. After our tour, we'll head to Rome for dinner and settle into our cozy overnight accommodations.

DAY 7: ROME

Rise and shine for an extraordinary day! After a tasty breakfast, we'll celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Basilica. Take some time to soak in the atmosphere before a

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Porterage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own variety transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 07/18/25 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Cancellation/Refund Policy
