After enjoying Padua's artistic treasures, your adventure continues to the enchanting canals of Venice! Dinner and overnight at your Venetian hotel.

DAY 4: VENICE

Begin your day in Venice at the stunning Basilica di San Marco, known for its beautiful Byzantine architecture and vibrant mosaics. Explore the lively Piazza San Marco, home to historic landmarks like the Palazzo Ducale. Don't miss the chance to enjoy a romantic gondola ride through the enchanting canals. Dinner and overnight at your hotel complete the experience.

DAY 5: VENICE / FLORENCE

Leaving Venice, travel to Florence. Upon arrival, visit the famous Academia Gallery to see Michelangelo's David, a true Renaissance masterpiece. If time allows, explore the stunning Duomo di Santa Maria del Fiore, known for its beautiful dome by Filippo Brunelleschi, and don't miss the nearby Baptistery of San Giovanni with its remarkable golden 'Gates of Paradise.'

DAY 6: FLORENCE / ASSISI

Your journey now takes you to the serene city of Assisi! Start at the Basilica of St. Francis, where you can feel his presence and admire Giotto's frescoes. Next, visit the Basilica of St. Clare, honoring the founder of the Poor Clares, and conclude at the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels, where St. Francis received the Stigmata. Don't miss the shrine of Blessed Carlo Acutis, whose incorrupt body serves as a modern reminder of faith and devotion.

DAY 7: ASSISI / LANCIANO / SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

This morning, we're excited to journey to Lanciano, where we'll explore the beautiful sanctuary that holds the incredible 8th-century Eucharistic Miracle relics. We'll have the opportunity to see the preserved host and wine, displayed in a stunning golden and crystal monstrance, cherished by pilgrims from all corners of the globe. Later, we'll head to San Giovanni Rotondo for a delightful dinner and a restful overnight stay. Let's embrace this meaningful adventure together!



DAY 8: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO / ROME

Good morning, everyone! Today, we'll start our tour at the tomb of St. Padre Pio, a Capuchin priest known for his spiritual gifts. We'll visit the modern Sanctuary, the old church where he celebrated Mass, and the significant crucifix. Afterward, we'll enjoy a scenic bus ride to the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel. Finally, we'll head to Rome for dinner and an overnight stay at your hotel. Exciting adventures await!

DAY 9: PAPAL AUDIENCE / THE VATICAN

We will leave the hotel early to attend the Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square with His Holiness Pope Francis. Afterward, enjoy lunch (on your own) before touring the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 10: ROME / HOLY DOORS

After breakfast, we'll begin the day walking through the Holy Doors of the grand St. Peter's Basilica! We will celebrate Mass and then tour the sanctuary. Next, we will walk through the Holy Doors of the Basilica of St. Paul Outside

the Walls, one of Rome's four major basilicas, and the burial place of St. Paul, the Apostle. Afterward, we will continue to St. Lawrence Outside the Walls, stop for lunch, and later, we will have a walking tour of the Pantheon, Spanish Steps, Piazza Navona, and Trevi Fountain. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 11: ANCIENT ROME

Today, we will tour Ancient Rome! We will visit the Colosseum, Capitol Hill, the Vittorio Emmanuel Monument, the Roman Forum, and Circus Maximus. This afternoon, we visit the Church of Santa Croce in Jerusalem, The Basilica of St. John Lateran, the Holy Stairs, and the Basilica of St. Mary Major, where Mass will be Celebrated. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 12: RETURN HOME

Today, your pilgrimage ends as we transfer to the airport for our return flight home.

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Tips/Gratuities: Tips for tour guides, drivers, and wait staff for included meals.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Porterage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT NATIVITY PILGRIMAGE POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 06/16/25 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY
