Daily Itinerary

DAY 1: FLIGHT TO CAIRO, EGYPT

Your pilgrimage begins today, boarding your flight to Cairo, Egypt. Sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight. Your spiritual journey awaits!

Day 2: Arrive in Cairo

You will arrive in Cairo and meet your tour guide in the arrivals hall. After boarding the tour bus, we will escort you to your hotel for the evening. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Cairo.

DAY 3: CAIRO / EGYPTIAN MUSEUM / PYRAMIDS / THE SPHINX

We begin by visiting the Egyptian Museum, followed by the Great Pyramids - Chephren, Mykerions, & Cheops, the largest pyramid ever built. Next, we will take an up-close look at the Sphinx, the oldest known monumental sculpture in Egypt and one of the most recognizable statues in the world. Later, we travel to Khan Khalili, home of one of the most exciting bazaars in the Middle East. The Medieval atmosphere and the labyrinth layout give you a glimpse into what medieval markets were once like. Tonight, we gather for a Nile Cruise Dinner. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Cairo.

DAY 4: ST. CATHERINE'S

After breakfast, we leave for St. Catherine's in Sinai. Set beneath the mountain where Moses received the Ten Commandments, Saint Catherine Monastery has been one of the world's great centers of religious pilgrimage for over fifteen centuries. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in St. Catherine.

Optional At daybreak, we climb Mt. Sinai, where you will enjoy a time of praise and incredible views of the Sinai wilderness, where God revealed himself to Moses in the book of Genesis. You can rent a camel for assistance 2/3 of the way up to see the sunrise.

DAY 5: SINAI / DEAD SEA

After breakfast, we will visit St Catherine's Monastery. Afterward, we will cross the Egyptian-Israeli border in Eilat and drive to our hotel near the Dead Sea. On the way, we will stop to see a Replica of the Tabernacle (or will do so later). This evening you will have the opportunity to swim in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea, renowned for its healing properties. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 6: MASADA / EIN GEDI / QUMRAN / JERICHO

Today, we drive to Masada, where you will take a cable car up to the summit to view the ancient ruins. Afterward, we will visit Ein Gedi (time permitting), followed by Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were uncovered in 1947. Next, we will drive to Jericho, where we can see the sycamore tree and Mt. of Temptation. Finally, we will head to your hotel in Jericho for dinner and overnight accommodations.

Day 7: Beit Shean / Herod's Spring / Main / Nazareth Village

Today, we will drive up the Jordan Valley to Galilee. First, we will visit Beit Shean, also known as Scythapolis. We will view the Roman and Byzantine ruins, including the colonnaded streets, bathhouses, and ancient theater. Next, we will visit Herod's Springs in the Jezreel Valley, followed by Nain, where Jesus raised the widow's son. We then continue to the Nazareth Village, where we can view a 2000-year-old wine press and experience what an active first-century farm was like. Finally, we will continue to your hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight accommodations.

Day 8: Sea of Galilee / Mt. of Beatitudes / Tabgha / Capernaum / Mt. Arbel / Magdala

After breakfast, we will travel to Nof Ginosar, where we will take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. You will also see the remains of a fishing boat that dates back to the time of Jesus. Our next stop will be Capernaum, where you will see the remains of an ancient, 2nd-century synagogue. Our tour continues as we visit the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered his Sermon on the Mount. Afterward, we continue to Mt. Arbel, followed by Magdala, the birthplace of Mary Magdalene. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Tiberias.

Day 9: Chorazin / Bethsaida/ Tel Dan / Caesarea Philippi / Golan Heights

This morning we will visit the ruins of Chorazin, followed by Bethsaida, two of the three cities that Jesus cursed in the New Testament. Afterward, we will drive to Tel Dan and hike to the Temple of Jeroboam and "Abraham's Gate." Our next stop is Caesarea Philippi. We will continue to Druze and Mt. Bental for a breathtaking view of Syria. We'll have lunch and then drive through Golan Heights to Kursi, where Jesus cast evil spirits out of a man into pigs. We will end our day at Tel Hazor National Park. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 10: CANA / AFULA / MEGIDDO / MT. CARMEL / HAIFA

We start our day in Cana, the location of Jesus's first miracle. Next, we travel through Afula to meet Pastor Morales, have lunch, and hear about Jezreel and the Well of Sychar. From there, we will continue to Tel Megiddo, also known as the Valley of the Armageddon. In Tel Megiddo, we will view the archaeological excavations and the old water supply system. Our next stop is Mount Carmel, where the prophet, Elijah, confronted the prophets of Baal. Enjoy the fantastic view of the Jezreel Valley and lower Galilee as we break for lunch, followed by some free time to shop (time permitting) at one of the Druze Villages. Finally, we continue to your hotel in Haifa for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 11: ROSH HANIKRAH / CAESAREA / JAFFA / BETHLEHEM

This morning, we head to Rosh Hanikrah, the northernmost point along Israel's Mediterranean coast. We will descend by cable car into the network of limestone grottoes created by the constant bombardment of waves against the rocks. Afterward, we will visit Caesarea, the former Roman capital of Judea. Our tour will include the aqueduct, archeological excavations, and the Roman amphitheater. Afterward, if time permits, we will stop in Jaffa before continuing to your hotel in Bethlehem for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 12: MARESHA / VALLEY OF ELAH / BETHLEHEM / NATIVITY CHURCH / SHEPHERDS' FIELD

Today, we will have a half-day dig at Tel Maresha, an elevated mound with

views of the Judaean plains & the excavated remains of an ancient biblical city. Time permitting, we have a short stop in the Valley of Elah. The Old Testament describes it as the location of the Israelite's camp when David fought Goliath. Next, we travel to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity and the YMCA Shepherds' Field. We will also make our way through the city's alleys and markets (including a stop at an Olive Wood Shop). Afterward, we will visit Herodium, one of three palaces built by Herod the Great. Finally, we will return to Bethlehem for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 13: MT. OF OLIVES / DOMINUS FLEVIT / GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE / THE OLD CITY OF JERUSALEM

We begin the day on the Mt. of Olives, which has a spectacular view of the city. Next, we continue down "Palm Sunday Road" to the Garden of Gethsemane Garden across the street from the Church of All Nations. We will stop at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem, and continue to the Old City, as we enter via the Lion's Gate. We'll visit St. Anne's Church, which dates back to the times of the Crusaders, and the pool of Bethesda. We then continue our underground tour near the southwest corner of the city. Later, we will see the Model of Jerusalem in the Israeli Museum (and Shrine of the Book) dating back to the time of Christ, and Yad Vashem (time permitting). Finally, we will return to your hotel in Bethlehem for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 14: THE OLD CITY / THE UPPER ROOM / CITY OF DAVID / POOL OF SILOAM / THE GARDEN TOMB

After breakfast, we begin our day in the Jewish Quarter of the Old City, where we will visit the Western Wall – Judaism's holiest site. The Western Wall, also known as the Wailing Wall, is the last remaining wall of the Temple. We will view the area's excavation tunnels and learn about the construction of the Temple 2000 years ago by King Herod. Next, we visit the City of David, where we can see the southern excavation of the temple along with Davidson Center, and walk through Hezekiah's tunnel, resurfacing at the pool of Siloam, where Jesus cured a blind man. Next, we will visit the Upper Room, the House of Caiaphas, followed by the Garden Tomb. A farewell dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 15: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

We will transfer to the airport this morning and board our return flight home.



TERMSCONDITIONS

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Porterage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

General Travel Information

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 11/21/25 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

Late Payment Policy
