DAY 1: FLIGHT TO ROME

Today, you will board your international flight to Rome, Italy.

DAY 2: WELCOME TO ROME

Upon arrival at Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino Airport, you will meet your professional tour guide and board your luxury deluxe touring vehicle. As we exit the airport, we will begin a panoramic tour to get acquainted with "The Eternal City." We will stop by the famous Trevi Fountain, where there will be free time for lunch. Afterward, your tour continues at the Pantheon and the Spanish Steps. Afterward, we will proceed to your hotel for the evening. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 3: PAPAL AUDIENCE / THE VATICAN

After an early breakfast at your hotel, we will proceed to the Vatican for the Papal Audience with Pope Francis in St. Peter's Square! After the audience, we will walk through the Holy Doors of the grand St. Peter's Basilica! We will celebrate Mass, explore the basilica, and continue with a guided tour of the Vatican Museums and the world-famous Sistine Chapel! Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 4: ANCIENT ROME

After breakfast, our tour begins by walking through the Holy Doors of the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, one of Rome's four major basilicas, and the final resting place of St. Paul, the Apostle. Next, we will explore the city's Catacombs, followed by a tour of ancient Rome. We will visit the Colosseum, Capitol Hill, the Vittorio Emmanuel Monument, the Roman Forum, and Circus Maximus. This afternoon, we will visit Rome's other

major basilicas and walk through the Holy Doors of St. Mary Major and St. John Lateran. You'll also have free time to explore before returning to your hotel. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 5: MONTE CASSINO / SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

After breakfast, we will travel south, passing through the beautiful and rich Italian countryside of vineyards, orchards, and olive groves. Our first stop will be the town of Monte Cassino, founded by St. Benedict in 529 and where he began the Benedictine Order. We will tour the magnificent Monte Cassino Abbey, followed by the Church of St. Peter and Paul. We will then continue to San Giovanni Rotondo, the hometown of the great St. Padre Pio. Dinner and overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.

DAY 6: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO / MONTE SANT' ANGELO

After breakfast, we will celebrate Mass at the Old Church and tour the sanctuary, viewing the crucifix where St. Pio received the stigmata in 1918. Then, we'll travel to Monte Sant' Angelo and visit the Cave of St. Michael, where the Archangel is said to have appeared in 492. Nearly a million pilgrims visit the cave annually for St. Michael's intercession. We'll return to your hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 7: LANCIANO / LORETO / ASSISI

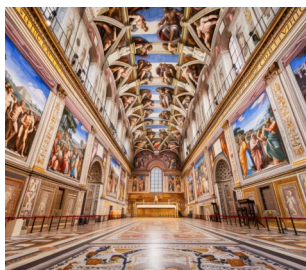
After breakfast and hotel check-out, we head to Lanciano to visit the Church of St. Longinus, site of the 8th-Century Eucharistic Miracle. We will celebrate Mass before traveling to the Marian Shrine of Loreto, home to

the Basilica of the Holy House where the Blessed Virgin Mary is believed to have lived. Enjoy free time for lunch before continuing to Assisi for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 8: ASSISI

After breakfast, we'll explore St. Francis' hometown, starting with Mass at St. Mary of the Angels Basilica, where you'll see the Porziuncola, where he began his ministry. Next, we'll tour the Basilica of St. Francis and view the crucifix that urged him to "Rebuild my Church." We'll also visit the Church of St. Clare, a follower of St. Francis. The rest of the day is free for independent exploration, shopping, or relaxing. Dinner and overnight in Assisi.

DAY 9: ASSISI / ORVIETO / FLORENCE

Following a delightful breakfast, we'll set off for the enchanting town of Orvieto! There, we'll explore the stunning Orvieto Cathedral, a beautiful 14th-century Roman Catholic gem dedicated to the Assumption of the Virgin Mary. Later, we'll head to the vibrant city of Florence, where your hotel awaits with dinner and cozy overnight accommodations.

DAY 10: FLORENCE

After a delightful hotel breakfast, we'll explore the beauty of Florence, known as "The Jewel of the Renaissance." Our journey starts at the Church of Santa Croce, the final resting place of legends like Michelangelo and Galileo. We'll wander through Piazza Signoria, admire Palazzo Vecchio, and enjoy the charm of Ponte Vecchio. Then, we'll visit the stunning Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and L'Accademia,

home to Michelangelo's iconic David. After some free time to explore, we'll gather for dinner and an overnight stay in the heart of Florence!

DAY 11: FLORENCE / VENICE

Today, we begin our journey to the enchanting city of Venice, known as "The Queen of the Adriatic." Our adventure starts at the beautiful Basilica of St. Mark, famous for its shimmering mosaics and the relics of St. Mark. After Mass, we'll explore Piazza di San Marco and the impressive Palazzo Ducale, the former Doge's residence. The rest of the day is yours to enjoy the charm of Venice, and don't miss the chance for a traditional gondola ride! Enjoy dinner and a restful overnight stay at your hotel.

DAY 12: VENICE / MILAN

After breakfast, we bid farewell to Venice and head to Milan. Upon arrival, we visit the Duomo, Northern Italy's stunning Gothic masterpiece. Next, we tour the Basilica and Tomb of St. Ambrose, followed by Mass at the Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie. We'll also see Castle Sforzesco and La Scala Opera House. For the remainder of the day, enjoy browsing the Forza boutiques and luxury shops in the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele Arcade. Conclude your day with a special dinner with your spiritual director and fellow pilgrims, sharing your experiences in Italy. Overnight at your hotel.

DAY 13: RETURN HOME

After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport this morning to catch our return flight home. We hope this spiritual journey has enlightened you and given you many beautiful memories to last a lifetime.

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip fares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Fares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativty Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativty Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativty Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativty Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativty Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativty Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 08/08/25 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy
