Daily *itinerary*



DAY 1 – FLIGHT / U.S. / ROME

Depart for Rome, Italy.

DAY 2 – ARRIVE IN ROME

We arrive in the beautiful ancient city of Rome and meet our tour guide and driver. We will then board your Nativity Touring vehicle to get acquainted with the “Eternal City” and take a quick panoramic tour. We will visit Trevi Fountain, where you’ll have free time for lunch before continuing to your hotel to settle in and unpack. We will also visit the Basilica of Santa Maria sopra Minerva, the memorial to Maria Raggi by Bernini, and the Aldobrandini chapel where the first confraternity to the Blessed Sacrament was approved by the Holy See. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Rome.

DAY 3 – ROME: VATICAN CITY / ST. PETER’S BASILICA / VATICAN MUSEUM / BASILICA OF ST. MARY MAJOR

We begin our day with the Papal Audience in St. Peter’s Square with His Holiness, Pope Francis! Following the audience, we will explore the magnificent St. Peter’s Basilica, where St. Peter, the first Pope and Bishop of Rome, was martyred. Inside, you will see Michelangelo’s Pieta, the stunning marble sculpture depicting the Virgin Mary holding Christ after His crucifixion. Next, we will continue to explore the Vatican Museums, the Tapestry Gallery, the Raphael Rooms, the world-famous Sistine Chapel, and the tomb of Saint John Paul II. Afterward, we will proceed to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of Rome’s four major basilicas which contains a relic from the manger of the infant Jesus. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Rome.

DAY 4 – ROME: BASILICA OF ST. JOHN THE LATERAN / HOLY STAIRS / APPIAN WAY / BASILICA OF ST. PAUL OUTSIDE THE WALLS / CATACOMBS

This morning, you will enjoy an early breakfast before making your way to the oldest of Rome’s four major basilicas: the Basilica of St. John the Lateran. Next, you will cross the street to visit the Holy Stairs. These Holy Stairs are the very steps that led up to Pontius Pilate’s praetorian in Jerusalem, where Jesus walked during his Passion. The Stairs were brought to Rome by Saint Helena in the fourth century. We will continue our journey down the Appian Way, the earliest road of Ancient Rome. We will visit the Domus Obsequialis Chapel, the Baths of Caracalla, the Arch of Drusus, the Tomb of Cecilia Metella, and the catacombs of St. Callixtus. The day concludes with a visit to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. Originally founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th Century, this Basilica is the burial site of Saint Paul the Apostle. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Rome.

DAY 5 – ROME / COLOSSEUM / ROMAN FORUM / BASILICA OF ST. GREGORY THE GREAT

We will begin our walking tour of Rome this morning. Starting at the Piazza Venezia, we will walk to some of Rome’s most famous sights like the Capitoline Hill and the Pantheon. We will visit the Basilica of St. Mary of the Altar of Heaven (Sancta Maria de Aracoeli), the designated Church of Rome’s city council. We will walk past the Mamertine Prison where St. Peter and Paul were held before their executions, before continuing to the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, and the Arch of Constantine. After lunch, we visit The Basilica of St. Clement, the Basilica of St. Gregory the Great, and the Mother Teresa convent. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Rome.

DAY 6 – ROME

This morning you will have free time to explore the city. You will visit Santa Sabina to visit the Master General of the Dominican Order. Then, you will proceed to the Madonna del Rosario, Maria Advocata, and the left hand of St. Catherine of Siena in Monte Mario. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Rome.

DAY 7 – ROME / NARNI / PERUGIA

After breakfast at your hotel, you will depart to Narni. Upon arrival, you will visit the Sanctuary of Blessed Lucy of Narni. Explore the medieval town of Narni, including Narni Underground and the Romanesque churches. After lunch, the rest of the afternoon is free to explore the city on your own. Afterward, you will proceed to Perugia for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 8 – NARNI / PERUGIA

After breakfast at your hotel, we will visit the church and cell of Blessed Colomba of Rieti. Explore the historic center, including Palazzo dei Priori and the Fontana Maggiore. Visit the Perugia Cathedral and the Etruscan Well. Afterward, we will return to Perugia for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 9 – PERUGIA / CITTA' DI CASTELLO

After breakfast, we will visit the church and shrine of St. Margaret of Castello and explore the Pinacoteca Comunale and the historic town center. Afterward, return to Perugia for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 10 – PERUGIA / SIENA

After breakfast, we will visit the Sanctuary of St. Catherine of Siena. Explore the Siena Cathedral and the Palazzo Pubblico. Walk around the Piazza del Campo and learn about the Palio di Siena. The rest of the time is free to explore the city on your own. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Siena.

DAY 11 – SIENA / FLORENCE

After breakfast, we will visit the sites related to Blessed Villana dei Botti and Blessed Mary Bartholomew Bagnesi. Explore the Florence Cathedral (Duomo) and climb the dome with your local guide. In the afternoon visit the Uffizi Gallery or the Accademia Gallery. Wander through the historic center and see Ponte Vecchio. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel in Florence.

DAY 12 – FLORENCE / PRATO

After breakfast, you will depart for Prato. Upon arrival, you will visit the Basilica of St. Catherine de Ricci. Explore the Prato Cathedral and the Emperor's Castle. The rest of the time is free to explore the city on your own. Afterward, we will return to Florence for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 13 – FLORENCE / MILAN

After breakfast, you will depart for Milan. Upon arrival, we will begin by visiting the Duomo, the most magnificent Gothic building in Northern Italy. We will tour the Basilica and Tomb of St. Ambrose and celebrate Mass at the Church Santa Maria delle Grazie. The rest of the day is at your leisure, whether you decide to browse the Forza boutiques or take a stroll through the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele arcade. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be at your hotel in Milan.

DAY 14 – MILAN / USA

After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport for our flight home.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Extra food/beverage: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: Tips for tour guides, drivers, and wait staff for included meals.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 07/25/25 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

| Days Prior to Departure | Fee |

| 100 - 61 days | \$150 |
| 60 - 30 days | \$300 |
| 30 days - day before departure | subject to cancellation |

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

| Days Prior to Departure | Penalty |
|-------------------------|-------------------|
| 100 + days | Lose deposit |
| 99 - 50 days | 50% of trip cost |
| 49 days or less | 100% of trip cost |
