DAY 1: FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV, ISRAEL

Today marks the beginning of an extraordinary pilgrimage as you board your flight to the beautiful land of Israel. Get ready for a truly transformative spiritual experience as you walk in the footsteps of Jesus and explore the rich tapestry of faith and history.

DAY 2: TEL AVIV / NETANYA

Arriving at Ben Gurion Airport, you'll navigate customs and meet our friendly guide. We'll board our comfortable touring vehicle for a scenic drive to your hotel in Netanya. If time allows, we may stop in Jaffa along the way. Enjoy dinner and relax at your hotel for the night.

DAY 3: CAESAREA MARITIMA / MUHRAQA / MT. CARMEL / HAIFA / TIBERIAS

We begin our day at the ancient ruins of Caesarea Maritima, where Herod's palace stands. Then, we'll visit Deir Al-Muhraqa, the site of Elijah's confrontation with the Prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Our next stop will be the peaceful Stella Maris Monastery on Mt. Carmel followed by Haifa City. Our day wraps up in Tiberias, where you can relax and enjoy dinner at your hotel.

DAY 4: CANA / NAZARETH / MT. TABOR / TIBERIAS

We will start at Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle of turning water into wine. Then, we'll visit Nazareth, including The Basilica of the Annunciation and St. Joseph's

Church, before ascending Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration. We'll return to Tiberias for dinner and a restful night.

DAY 5: MOUNT OF BEATITUDES / TABGHA / CAPERNAUM / SEA OF GALILEE / BETHLEHEM

Today we begin at the tranquil Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. We'll visit Tabgha, the site of the "Feeding of the 5,000," and the Church of Peter's Primacy, where Jesus performed the Miraculous Fishing. Next, we explore Capernaum, where Jesus lived and started His ministry. This afternoon, we'll take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. We'll conclude the day with dinner and overnight accommodations at our hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 6: BETHLEHEM / EIN KAREM

We'll start our day at Shepherd's Field, a site of great significance. Then, we'll visit the Church of the Nativity, where Jesus was born, followed by a trip to Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist. There, we'll explore the Church of the Visitation, known for the 'Magnificat.' After a fulfilling day, we'll enjoy dinner and stay overnight at our hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 7: BETHANY / JORDAN RIVER / JERICHO / QUMRAN / DEAD SEA

After breakfast, we'll head to Bethany to visit the church dedicated to Lazarus and then continue to the serene Jordan River for

the opportunity to renew our baptismal vows. We'll stop in Jericho to visit the world's oldest city followed by the Mount of Temptation, where Jesus fasted, and Qumran, home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Finally, we'll enjoy floating in the mineral-rich Dead Sea before returning to our hotel in Bethlehem for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 8: JERUSALEM: PALM SUNDAY ROUTE

Today, we explore Jerusalem, starting at the Mount of Olives and the Pater Noster. We'll walk the Palm Sunday route to Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over the city. In the Garden of Gethsemane, we'll reflect at The Rock of Agony followed by the Church of All Nations. We'll then visit the Chapel of the Ascension, and in the afternoon, head to Mount Zion to explore the Upper Room, concluding at St. Peter in Gallicantu. We'll

return to our hotel in Bethlehem for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 9: JERUSALEM: VIA DOLOROSA

We start with a reflective walk along the Via Dolorosa, meditating at each Station of the Cross before reaching the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, where Jesus was crucified and buried. Next we'll visit St. Anne's Church and pass the Ecce Homo site. Our journey concludes at the Wailing Wall, the holiest site in Judaism. The afternoon is free for personal exploration, followed by a farewell dinner at a local restaurant and overnight accommodations at our Bethlehem hotel.

DAY 10: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

This morning, we'll transfer to the airport to catch our flight home, carrying with us the rich experiences and memories from our uplifting journey.

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Extra food/beverage: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: Tips for tour guides, drivers, and wait staff for included meals.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 07/25/25 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Days Prior to Departure	Fee
100 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

Days Prior to Departure	Penalty
100 + days	Lose deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost
