DAY 1 – FLIGHT / U.S. / TEL AVIV, ISRAEL

Today, you will board your international flight to Tel Aviv, Israel. Rest assured, all necessary preparations for your journey have been made. Just sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight to Tel Aviv. Your spiritual journey awaits!

DAY 2 – TEL AVIV / NETANYA

After arriving at Ben Gurion International Airport, you will meet your Nativity tour guide and transfer to your hotel in Netanya. If there is time, we will stop to celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Church in Jaffa City. Dinner and overnight in Netanya.

DAY 3 – CAESAREA MARITIMA / MUHRAQA / MT. CARMEL / HAIFA / TIBERIAS

After breakfast at your hotel, we will travel to Caesarea Maritima, where Peter the Apostle baptized the Roman centurion Cornelius, the first recorded gentile converted to Christianity. After viewing the remains of King Herod's great city, we will celebrate Mass at Deir Al-Muhraqa Carmelite Monastery, where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal and Asherah (1 Kgs. 18). Next, we'll continue to Stella Maris Monastery on Mt. Carmel, Haifa City, and finally, to our hotel for the evening. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

DAY 4 – CANA / NAZARETH / MT. TABOR / TIBERIAS

After breakfast, we will celebrate Mass at the Wedding Church in Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle by turning water into wine. While we are here, couples can renew their wedding vows and receive an official certificate from the church. Next, we will travel to Nazareth and visit The Basilica of the Annunciation,

St. Joseph's Church, Mary's Well, and the old market. Afterward, we will travel to Mount Tabor and visit the Church of the Transfiguration before returning to your hotel for the evening. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

DAY 5 – MT. OF BEATITUDES / TABGHA / CAPERNAUM / SEA OF GALILEE / BETHLEHEM

After breakfast, we begin our day at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus gave His Sermon on the Mount. Our next stop is Tabgha, known for "The Miracle of the Multiplication," where Jesus fed a crowd of 5,000 with just five loaves of bread and two fish. Afterward, we will visit the Church of Peter's Primacy and continue to Capernaum, where Jesus lived and started his ministry in Galilee. Finally, we end our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, celebrating Mass while on board. Afterward, we will continue to your hotel for the evening. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

DAY 6 – BETHLEHEM / NATIVITY CHURCH / SHEPHERDS' FIELD / EIN KAREM

This morning, after breakfast, we will celebrate Mass at Shepherds' Field, where the angel of God announced the birth of Christ. Next, we will visit the Church of the Nativity, built on Jesus' birth site. It is the oldest major church in the Holy Land. This afternoon, we will travel to Ein Karem, the home of St. John the Baptist. We will see the Church of the Visitation, where the Virgin Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth and proclaimed "The Magnificat." Finally, we will return to our hotel in Bethlehem. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

DAY 7 – BETHANY / JORDAN RIVER / JERICHO / QUMRAN / DEAD SEA

We begin our day in Bethany, the home of Lazarus, whom Jesus miraculously raised from the dead. After visiting The Lazarus Church and tomb, we will continue to the Jordan River to renew our baptismal vows. Afterward, we will drive through the Jordan Valley to Jericho, the world's oldest city. We will see the Mount of Temptation, where Satan tempted Jesus while fasting for forty days and forty nights, followed by Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were uncovered in 1947. On our way back, we will stop for a swim in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea, renowned for its healing properties. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

DAY 8 – JERUSALEM / PALM SUNDAY ROUTE

After breakfast, we start our full-day tour of Jerusalem on the Mount of Olives at The Pater Noster, where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer to his disciples. Next, we will walk the Palm Sunday route, stopping at Dominus Flevit and the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed before being arrested. Next, we will celebrate Mass at the Church of All Nations, visit the Chapel of the

Ascension, and end our day at St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied our Lord three times. Dinner and overnight accommodations in Bethlehem.

DAY 9 – JERUSALEM / VIA DOLOROSA

After breakfast, we begin our day retracing the last steps of Jesus by walking along the Via Dolorosa, or Way of Sorrow. Here, we will stop to pray at the Stations of the Cross, followed by Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Next, we will visit St. Anne's Church, the home of the Virgin Mary, and her parents, Saints Joachim and Anne. We will then pass the Ecce Homo, where Pontius Pilate proclaimed, "Behold the man," before continuing to the Wailing Wall, Judaism's holiest site. The rest of the day is free to visit other Holy Sites, shop, or rest at your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

DAY 10 – FLIGHT / ISRAEL / U.S.

After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport to catch our return flight home, taking with us the memories and experience of walking in Jesus' footsteps.

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip fares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT NATIVITY PILGRIMAGE POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 1/03/2026 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Days Prior to Departure	Fee

30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

HOLY LAND CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Full Refund Policy for Holy Land (War-Related Cancellations Only): If war occurs and the airline cancels flights to the Holy Land, Nativity Pilgrimage will issue a full refund for the land portion if canceled within 50 days of departure.

For cancellations less than 50 days of departure, if airline tickets have been issued, the airline's refund and cancellation policies will apply to the airfare portion.

Multi-Country Pilgrimages (Holy Land + Other Destinations): If the itinerary includes Jordan, Egypt, Rome, Greece, or other destinations, the refund policies of the respective local travel providers will apply to those portions.

Airline Ticket Terms: Once tickets are issued, all airline terms and conditions apply, including penalties, refunds, and rebooking policies.
