After this spiritual moment, we'll continue our journey to Czestochowa, where you will enjoy a delightful dinner and a restful overnight stay at your hotel.

DAY 3: CZESTOCHOWA | AUSCHWITZ | Krakow

Today, we'll visit the Jasna Gora Monastery in Czestochowa, known for its resilience in the 17th-century wars and home to the revered Black Madonna. After exploring the historic Pauline Monastery, we will pay our respects at Auschwitz, including St. Maximilian Kolbe's cells. Our day will end in Krakow, where a delicious dinner and cozy overnight stay await.

DAY 4: KRAKOW | DIVINE MERCY SHRINE | WADOWICE

Join us for a journey through Krakow's history, exploring the vibrant Market Square, the 14th Century University, Wawel Royal Castle, and St. Mary's Church. In the afternoon, we'll visit the Divine Mercy Shrine in Łagiewniki, celebrating Mass at the Chapel of Relics, before heading to Wadowice, the birthplace of Pope John Paul II. We'll conclude our day back in Krakow.

DAY 5: WIELICZKA | PRAGUE

In the morning, we'll visit the fascinating Wieliczka Salt Mines, Europe's oldest mine, where we'll explore breathtaking chambers, including the majestic Cathedral—entirely carved from salt! After this memorable experience, we will depart for Prague, the picturesque capital of the Czech Republic. As we arrive, you'll see why this "Golden City" is celebrated as one of Europe's most beautiful capitals. Enjoy a delightful dinner and a peaceful night at your hotel.

DAY 6: PRAGUE

This morning, we'll embark on a sightseeing tour of Prague, passing by Strahon Monastery and the Loreto shrine. We'll visit the Castle area, home to St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George Basilica, and Golden Lane. You'll also see St. Nicholas Church, where Mozart played, and celebrate Mass at the Church of Our Lady of Victory, featuring the Infant Jesus of Prague statue. After strolling across Charles Bridge to the Old Town, you can explore sights like the Astronomical Clock and Our Lady before Tyn before enjoying dinner and a restful night at the hotel.

DAY 7: PRAGUE / MELK / VIENNA

We embark on our journey to Austria, starting in the charming city of Vienna. On the way, we will experience a moment of serenity with Mass at the stunning Melk Abbey, often called the most beautiful abbey in Austria. As we explore its gardens, Emperor's gallery, marble hall, and impressive library, you'll appreciate the artistry that brought this place to life. DAY 8: VIENNA

Get ready to explore the vibrant atmosphere of Vienna! We'll enjoy a walking tour through charming squares and medieval streets, passing iconic sites such as the Vienna Opera House, St Augustine's Church, and St Stephen's Cathedral. Visit Mozart's House, Heroes' Square, and the opulent Hofburg Palace. Don't miss the chance to explore the popular Naschmarkt, and consider an optional visit to Schönbrunn Palace, once home to the Hapsburg Emperors. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant and a comfortable overnight stay at your hotel.

DAY 9: VIENNA / ZAGREB

After a delightful breakfast, we will embark on a scenic drive from Vienna to Zagreb, taking in the breathtaking landscapes along the way. Upon our arrival in the Croatian capital, we will pass by the majestic Cathedral of Zagreb, a beautiful highlight of the city. We will enjoy dinner and then retire for the night at our hotel, ready for the adventures that lie ahead!

DAY 10: ZAGREB / PLITVICE LAKES / DUBROVNIK

Following breakfast, we head toward the stunning city of Dubrovnik. Our journey includes a stop to marvel at the natural wonder of Plitvice Lakes, one of nature's masterpieces. Here, we'll have lunch amidst breathtaking scenery before continuing our journey to our hotel in Dubrovnik, where we will unwind for the evening. After a great day, we'll head to Medjugorje for dinner and a restful night at our hotel.

DAY 12: MEDJUGORJE

Join us for a moving experience as we gather for Mass before heading to Apparition Hill, where Our Lady first appeared in 1981. We will take a moment for personal prayer at the cross marking this special site. Each evening, the community and pilgrims unite to pray the rosary, fostering a sense of unity. Mass includes a Blessing for the Sick and the opportunity to bless personal items. You'll have time for personal devotion and exploration of this sacred place. Enjoy dinner and your overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 13: DEPARTURE

This morning, we will transfer to the airport for our return journey home.

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated. Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage

and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Porterage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Extra food/beverage: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary. **Tips/Gratuities:** Tips for tour guides, drivers, and wait staff for included meals.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure. **Departure Cities:** If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 6/21/2025 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:
