### DAY 1: FLIGHT TO MILAN

Today, your pilgrimage begins by boarding your international flight to Milan! Rest assured, all the necessary preparations for your trip have been made so you can relax, enjoy your flight, and focus on the spiritual journey ahead.

### DAY 2: ARRIVE IN MILAN

Arrive in Milan and meet our tour manager and driver. We will leave the airport and have some free time for breakfast/lunch. After breakfast/lunch, we will travel to the hotel to check-in and rest of the day for rest or visit the stores and browse the Forza boutiques. Stroll through the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele arcade with its luxury outlets to shop and also admire the chic goods on display. We Have a lovely dinner before your cozy overnight stay at the hotel!

### DAY 3: MILAN

After breakfast, we proceed to visit the Duomo, "the most magnificent Gothic building in Northern Italy". Tour the Basilica di Sant'Ambrogio, celebrate Mass, and visit the Tomb of St. Ambrose. We will go to the Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie. Stop at Castel Sforzesco to see history and style combined with Milanese flair. Nearby is the famous La Scala Opera House with its ornate stage that glistens under crystal chandeliers. Dinner and overnight accommodation will be at your hotel in Milan.

### DAY 4: VENICE

After breakfast, we're excited to journey to Padua to

celebrate mass at the Basilica of St. Anthony. We'll end the day by continuing to Venice and visit "The Queen of Adriatic." We will explore the stunning Santa Maria della Salute Basilica and Ponte de Rialto and checking into our hotel for a delightful dinner and a restful night in Venice.

### DAY 5: VENICE / FLORENCE

After breakfast, our adventure begins at the breathtaking Basilica of St. Mark, famous for its exquisite mosaics and sacred relics. We'll then stroll through the vibrant Piazza di San Marco and the majestic Palace of the Doge. The afternoon is yours to enjoy, maybe even indulge in a gondola ride! We'll wrap up the day with a delicious dinner and a cozy overnight stay in Florence.

### DAY 6: FLORENCE

After breakfast, we explore the stunning Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, featuring Western Europe's largest dome! We'll admire the exquisite Baptistry of San Giovanni and the Accademia art gallery, showcasing masterpieces by Botticelli and Michelangelo's iconic "David." We'll wrap up the day with a delicious dinner and a cozy overnight stay in Florence.

### DAY 7: FLORENCE / ASSISI

Our day will culminate at the Church of the Holy Cross, the Santa Croce, the resting place of legends like Michelangelo, Galileo, and Machiavelli. A walking portion through the Piazza Signorina, Palazzo Vecchio, Uffizi, Ponte Vecchio, and Republic Square. #### **DAY 8: ASSISI / SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO**

Join us for a remarkable tour of Assisi. We'll start at St. Francis' tomb in the Basilica of St. Francis, where you'll see the crucifix and the chapel where he spent most of his time. We'll also visit the Church of St. Clare and St. Mary of the Angels Basilica, home of the Porziuncola, the tiny church in the woods where St. Francis began the Franciscan movement. Feel free to stroll through charming medieval streets and enjoy lunch. The journey continues at the Santuario Della Spogliazione, where we will visit the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis. We'll end the day by continuing to San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

#### **DAY 9: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO / MONTE SANT' ANGELO / ROME**

After breakfast at your hotel, we'll celebrate Mass at St. Padre Pio's tomb and explore the inspiring sanctuary, including the church where he received the stigmata and the confessional where he changed lives. You'll have the chance to pray before his incorrupt body. Next, we'll journey along the beautiful Gargano Peninsula to the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel, a significant pilgrimage shrine. After some time to reflect, we'll head to Rome for dinner and comfortable overnight accommodation at your hotel.

#### **DAY 10: ROME**

We begin our day with the Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square with Pope Leo XIV. Next, we explore St. Peter's

Basilica, the largest church in Christendom, built over the tomb of St. Peter. Inside, don't miss Michelangelo's Pieta, a beautiful marble depiction of the Virgin Mary and Christ. Then, we visit the Vatican Museums, which display centuries of religious art and icons collected by the Papacy. Explore the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, and the iconic Sistine Chapel with Michelangelo's Last Judgment. We conclude at the tomb of Saint John Paul II, a truly inspiring moment! We'll have a delightful dinner followed by a cozy overnight stay at your hotel.

#### **DAY 11: ROME: VATICAN CITY**

We'll start our day at the Basilica of St. Mary Major, home to a significant relic from the Manger of Jesus. Next, we'll visit the Basilica of St. John Lateran, the oldest major basilica in Rome, and reflect at the Holy Stairs across the street, with the option of climbing the steps on your knees in honor of Christ's Passion. We'll then head to the Church of St. Paul Outside the Walls, where St. Paul rests. In the afternoon, we'll tour Ancient Rome, concluding at the iconic Colosseum. Afterward, we'll enjoy dinner and unwind at our hotel, cherishing the day's experiences.

#### **DAY 12: RETURN FLIGHT HOME**

After a delightful breakfast, we'll head to the airport for your return flight, carrying with us the incredible memories and unforgettable experiences we've shared together!

# TERMS & CONDITIONS

## Your Package Includes

**Air Transportation:** Economy class and round-trip fares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Fares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

**Land Transportation:** All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

**Hotels:** Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativty Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

**Meal Plan:** The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

**Baggage:** Nativty Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

**Airport Fees:** Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

**Medical Insurance:** Coverage for the duration of your trip.

## Your Package Does Not Include

**Cancellation Protection Plan:** We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

**Passport Expenses:** Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

## General Travel Information

**Group Air:** Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

**Departure Cities:** If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

**Land-Only Option:** If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

## Important Nativty Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

**Single Room:** Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

**Seat Upgrades:** Once Nativty Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

**Seat Location Requests:** Once Nativty Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

**Other Special Requests:** Once Nativty Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

## Booking Conditions

**Deposit:** A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

**Payment Deadline:** Full payment is due 7/11/2026 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

**Payment Methods:** We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

## Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

| Days Prior to Departure        | Fee                     |
|--------------------------------|-------------------------|
| 100 - 61 days                  | \$150                   |
| 60 - 30 days                   | \$300                   |
| 30 days - day before departure | subject to cancellation |

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

## Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativty Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

| Days Prior to Departure | Penalty           |
|-------------------------|-------------------|
| 100 + days              | Lose deposit      |
| 99 - 50 days            | 50% of trip cost  |
| 49 days or less         | 100% of trip cost |
