DAY 1: FLIGHT TO VENICE

Today, your pilgrimage begins by boarding your international flight to Venice! Rest assured, all the necessary preparations for your trip have been made so you can relax, enjoy your flight, and focus on the spiritual journey ahead.

DAY 2: ARRIVE VENICE

Arrive in Venice and meet our tour manager and driver. Proceed to our hotel for check-in and rest. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 3: VENICE

After breakfast, we'll dive into the enchanting charm of Venice, "The Queen of the Adriatic." Our adventure begins at the breathtaking Basilica of St. Mark, famous for its exquisite mosaics and sacred relics. We'll then stroll through the vibrant Piazza di San Marco and the majestic Palace of the Doge. The afternoon is yours to enjoy, maybe even indulge in a gondola ride! We'll wrap up the day with a delicious dinner and a cozy overnight stay in Venice.

DAY 4: DAY TRIP TO PADOVA

Depart for Padova, where we visit the Basilica of St. Anthony of Padua and celebrate Mass. Continue to Venice. Return to Venice for dinner and a restful night.

DAY 5: VENICE - PLITVICE LAKES

Today you will take the bus to Croatia. We will stop for

lunch in Trieste. We will arrive at Plitvice Lakes. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 6: PLITVICE LAKES – SPLIT

We will experience Plitvice Lakes, one of nature's most beautiful masterpieces. We will have lunch before continuing to Split in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 7: SPLIT – DUBROVNIK

We will enjoy a city tour of Split, the second largest city in Croatia. Split's historic Old Town was built around the Palace of the Roman Emperor Diocletian, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. During the tour, you will have the opportunity to see remnants of Split's Roman heritage, such as the Temple of Jupiter, the Peristyle of Diocletian's Palace, and the Cathedral of St. Dalmatius. The Temple of Jupiter was built around the 3rd century and is dedicated to the god of the sky and the god of thunder. Finally, we will visit the Cathedral of St. Dalmatius, which is surrounded by 24 columns. The oldest monuments at this holy site are those depicting the life of Christ, which are found on the church's entrance doors. We celebrate Mass at a local church before continuing to Dubrovnik for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8: DUBROVNIK – MEDJUGORJE

Dubrovnik is known as the Pearl of the Adriatic and is a popular destination in the Mediterranean Sea,

especially after the filming of Game of Thrones. It is best known for its distinctive Old Town surrounded by the Dubrovnik Walls. Upon arrival, we will enjoy a walking tour of the Old Town starting at the Church of St. Blaise, dedicated to Dubrovnik's patron saint. We will then continue to the Gothic and Renaissance Rector's Palace, home to the Dubrovnik History Department Museum. Afterward, we will stroll past the iconic Clock Tower and Orlando's Column. To the left of this column, you will see the Sponza Palace, Dubrovnik's most important cultural institution. Next, we will visit the Cathedral of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, followed by the Dominican and Franciscan Monasteries. At the Franciscan Monastery, you will have the opportunity to visit the Old Pharmacy, one of the oldest pharmacies in Europe, founded in 1317. This afternoon, we will travel to Medjugorje for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9: MEDJUGORJE

The most beautiful features of Medjugorje are its simplicity and peace. While in Medjugorje, you will have the opportunity to deepen your faith and share in the spiritual journey of pilgrims from around the world. A local guide will accompany your group throughout your stay in the village. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 10: MEDJUGORJE

We will climb Apparition Hill in the morning and take a moment to reflect and contemplate the messages of Mother Mary. Our Lady appeared in Medjugorje under the title of Queen of Peace and is giving messages on how to achieve peace and joy in your heart. In her messages, Our Lady recommends five stones: fasting on Wednesdays and Fridays with bread and water, Holy Mass, daily Bible reading, monthly confession, and praying the rosary from the heart. Cross Mountain, the Blue Crosses, and the beautiful countryside of Medjugorje are places that will help you understand the beauty of Medjugorje and Our Lady's messages. You will also find many testimonies about life-changing experiences in Medjugorje. In the afternoon, we will celebrate Holy Eucharist in the Parish Church of St. James.

DAY 11: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

After a delightful breakfast, we'll head to the airport for your return flight, carrying with us the incredible memories and unforgettable experiences we've shared together!

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Extra food/beverage: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: Tips for tour guides, drivers, and wait staff for included meals.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 1/17/2026 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Days Prior to Departure	Fee
100 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

Days Prior to Departure	Penalty
100 + days	Lose deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost
