### **DAY 1: FLIGHT TO ROME**

### **DAY 2: WELCOME TO ROME**

Welcome to beautiful Rome! We're thrilled to meet our guide and driver as we board our touring vehicle for a panoramic tour of the "Eternal City." Drive past St. Peter's Basilica. Stop for a visit at St. Andrew Church, near the Trevi Fountain. Go to Piazza Navona to see the churches of St. Agnes, St. Louis, St. Augustine, and Pantheon.

### **DAY 3: ANCIENT ROME**

After breakfast at your hotel, we'll start our walking tour of ancient Rome at Piazza Venezia. We'll visit iconic sites like Capitoline Hill, and the Basilica of St. Mary of the Altar of Heaven, as well as the historic Mamertine Prison. We'll stroll along Via dei Fori Imperiali to see the Colosseum, Roman Forum, and Arch of Constantine. After a nice lunch, we'll explore the Basilica of St. Clement before enjoying dinner and a restful night at your hotel.

### **DAY 4: ROME**

Spend the morning at the North American College for Sunday Mass and the view

from their rooftop. Walk down to St. Peter's Square. Free time for lunch and shopping then gather again at the St. Peter's Oblisk. Go to Gesu with adjoining Ignatian Rooms, Santi Apostoli, and Chiesa Nuova. Continue to Trastevere, explore independently. Dinner and overnight at your hotel."

### **DAY 5: ROME**

Get ready for an exciting morning of history and spirituality! Start with breakfast before visiting the Basilica of St. John the Lateran, the Baptistry, Rome's oldest basilica. Next, explore the Holy Stairs, where Jesus ascended to trial. Then visit the church of the Holy Cross. Finally, visit the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, the burial place of Saint Paul the Apostle and the Catacombs of St. Calixtus. End your day with a cozy dinner and relaxing hotel stay.

### **DAY 6: THE VATICAN**

We'll explore St. Peter's Basilica to see Michelangelo's Pieta and visit the Vatican Museums, including the Sistine Chapel. We'll honor Saint John Paul II at his tomb and visit the Basilica of St. Mary Major, which holds a relic from Jesus' manger. We may then have a Scavi Tour (subject to confirmation). Enjoy some shopping time. Dinner and relax at your hotel after a day filled with beauty and spirituality.

Join us for an unforgettable experience at the Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square every Wednesday! Afterward, depart for Assisi. Upon arrival, we visit Santa Maria degli Angeli Church. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

### **DAY 8: ASSISI**

Embark on an inspiring journey to the birthplace of St. Francis! Begin at the stunning St. Francis Basilica, where you can visit his tomb and admire beautiful frescoes depicting his life. Next, explore the Santuario Della Spogliazione, the resting place of Blessed Carlo Acutis, and enjoy a walking tour through the charming streets, including St. Francis' childhood home. Conclude at the Church honoring St. Clare, the foundress of the Poor Clare Sisters. You'll also have free time to reflect,

shop, or enjoy lunch. Farewell dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight at your hotel. (Today, we'll have an hour of Eucharistic Adoration in Assisi at one of the churches.)

### **DAY 9: DAY TRIP TO FLORENCE**

Depart for Florence. We'll explore Florence, the capital of Tuscany. We'll start at the Church of Santa Croce, where Michelangelo and Galileo are buried, then visit Piazza Signoria, Palazzo Vecchio, and the Uffizi Gallery. Next, we'll see the impressive dome of Santa Maria del Fiore and visit L'Accademia to view works by Botticelli, Ghirlandaio, and Michelangelo's "David." Enjoy some free time before returning to the hotel in Rome for dinner and overnight.

### YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

**Air Transportation:** Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

**Land Transportation:** All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

**Hotels:** Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

**Baggage:** Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

### **IMPORTANT POLICIES**

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.
