DAY 1: DEPARTURE

Your exciting journey begins today as you board your flight to Israel, with all arrangements in place for your arrival.

DAY 2: TEL AVIV, ISRAEL

Arriving in Tel Aviv, you'll immediately feel the spiritual energy of the Holy Land. After clearing passport control, a Tradition Tours team member will escort you to your vehicle. You'll transfer to your hotel, check in, and enjoy a welcome dinner.

DAY 3: JUDEA, JEZREEL VALLEY, & GALILEE

After breakfast, prepare for an exhilarating day as you head north to Caesarea, the former Roman capital, where you'll explore its ancient aqueduct and amphitheater. Next, visit Mount Carmel, known for the confrontation between Elijah and the prophets of Baal, and take in stunning views of the Jezreel Valley. After lunch in the Carmel area, continue to Tel Megiddo, the site of Armageddon, before concluding the day in Acre, a city rich in history. Here, you'll experience ancient wine presses and a 1st-century farm before returning to your hotel in Tiberias for dinner.

DAY 4: TIBERIAS, CAPERNAUM, YARDENIT, & **SEA OF GALILEE**

Start your day by sailing across the Sea of Galilee in a boat similar to those used in Jesus' time. In Capernaum, visit the remains of a 2nd-century synagogue, followed by a trip to Tabgha, where the Miracle of the Fish and Loaves occurred. Enjoy breathtaking views from the Mount of Beatitudes, then stop by Kursi, the site of

the miracle of the swine. After a delicious lunch of St. Peter's fish, you'll visit the Jordan River, where John the Baptist baptized Jesus, renewing your baptismal vows at Yardenit before heading back to your hotel for dinner.

DAY 5: NAZARETH | BETH SHEAN | JERICHO | **JERUSALEM**

After breakfast and checkout, head to Cana to visit the Wedding Church, where Jesus performed his first miracle. Continue to Magdalena to explore archaeological excavations linked to Mary Magdalene, then to Nazareth Village, where you can see a 2000-yearold wine press. Next, visit Beit Shean to explore its Roman and Byzantine ruins, including the ancient theater. After a late lunch in Jericho, catch a glimpse of the cliff-hanging Monastery of St. George before arriving in Jerusalem, where you'll check into your hotel, enjoy dinner, and rest for the night.

DAY 6: JERUSALEM – THE OLD CITY | MOUNT ZION | MOUNT OF OLIVES

Today, we tour the Old City of Jerusalem, starting at the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of the city and to reflect on Jesus' ascension. We'll walk down the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed before his crucifixion. Entering the Old City through the Lion's Gate, we'll visit St. Anne's Church and the pool of Bethesda, then stroll along Via Dolorosa, the path Jesus took while carrying his Cross. After lunch, we'll explore King David's tomb and the Upper Room, before visiting the house of Caiaphas. Our day







concludes at the Friends of Sion Museum, highlighting the connection between Jewish and Christian communities, followed by dinner and overnight accommodations at the hotel.

DAY 7: JERUSALEM | BETHLEHEM

After breakfast, we'll explore the Jewish Quarter, visiting Judaism's holiest site, the Western Wall, and learning about the Temple's construction during King Herod's reign. Next, we'll go to the Garden Tomb before traveling to Bethlehem, where highlights include the Church of Nativity and the Shepherds' Field, along with the chance to wander through local alleys and markets for personal reflection and group prayer. We'll return to the hotel for dinner and a restful night.

DAY 8: QUMRAN | MASADA | THE DEAD SEA

This morning, we journey through the Judean desert to the Dead Sea, stopping at Qumran, the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Then it's on to Masada, where we'll take a cable car to explore the ancient fortress. After experiencing the unique sensation of floating in the mineral-rich Dead Sea and applying its healing mud, we'll head back to the hotel for dinner and a relaxing night.

DAY 9: JERUSALEM | EIN KAREM

Enjoy a free morning to explore Jerusalem at your leisure, with suggestions from your spiritual director if desired. After lunch, we'll visit Ein Karem, the birthplace of John the Baptist, home to the Spanish Style Church and Mary's Well, where Mary met Elizabeth. Spend your final afternoon in Jerusalem before returning to the hotel for a farewell dinner.

DAY 10: DEPARTURE

After breakfast, we'll head to Ben Gurion International Airport to begin our journey home.

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Porterage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT NATIVITY PILGRIMAGE POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 08/07/26 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments (accounting@nativitypilgrimage.com), and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

For cancellations less than 50 days of departure, if airline tickets have been issued, the airline's refund and cancellation policies will apply to the airfare portion.
