DAY 1: FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV

(Monday, June 16) Your pilgrimage begins today, boarding your flight to Israel. Sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight. Your spiritual journey awaits!

DAY 2: TEL AVIV / JAFFA / TIBERIAS

(Tuesday, June 17) After arriving at Ben Gurion Airport, you will be welcomed by our professional Holy Land team and board our luxury motorcoach bus to Jaffa. Mass will be celebrated. After lunch, we will drive to our hotel on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 3: NAZARETH / CANA / VALLEY OF THE DOVES

(Wednesday, June 18) We begin our day in the town of Nazareth, where the Annunciation took place. We will celebrate Mass and enjoy lunch. Next, we visit Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle of turning water into wine. Couples will have the opportunity to renew their wedding vows. We end our day with a hike in the Valley of the Doves. We will enjoy dinner at a local restaurant on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Overnight will be at your hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 4: MT. TABOR / MT. OF BEATITUDES / SEA OF GALILEE / TIBERIAS


(Thursday, June 19) Today is full of mountaintop experiences beginning with a hike to the top of Mount Tabor, where the Transfiguration occurred. We will celebrate Mass before returning to our hotel to freshen up. After lunch at a local restaurant, we will visit the Mt. of Beatitudes, where Jesus gave His Sermon on the Mount. We conclude our day with a relaxing boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 5: CAESAREA PHILIPPI / CAPERNAUM / TABGHA / PRIMA-CY OF PETER / TIBERIAS

(Friday, June 20) Today, we drive north to the Golan Heights region. We stop to visit Banias, one of the sources of the Jordan River and the site of ancient Caesarea Philippi, where Peter confessed his faith in Christ. We continue to Capernaum, where Jesus lived and started his ministry. After a traditional St. Peter's fish lunch, we will visit Tabgha, the site where the miracle of the multiplication of fish and bread took place. Then, we will visit the Church of Peter's Primacy, the location of the miraculous catch. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 6: JORDAN RIVER / JERICHO / MT. OF TEMPTATION / BETHLEHEM

(Saturday, June 21) After our hotel check-out, we will drive to the Jor-



dan River to renew our baptismal promises at Qasr el Yahud, where Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist (Matthew 3:13-17). We will celebrate Mass and enjoy lunch in Jericho. We will see the Mt. of Temptation before traveling to Bethlehem. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 7: BETHLEHEM: SHEPHERD'S FIELD / CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY

(Sunday, June 22) We begin today by visiting Shepherds' Field, where the shepherds saw the Star of the Nativity. Next, we will continue to the Church of the Nativity, which stands upon the site where Jesus was born. Mass will be celebrated. After lunch, we will have the opportunity to buy quality olive wood products, icons, and jewelry at a Christian cooperative that supports local Christian families in need. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 8: EIN KAREM / UPPER ROOM / ST. PETER IN GALLICANTU / ST. ANNE'S CHURCH / POOLS OF BETHESDA / JERUSALEM

(Monday, June 23) After our hotel check-out, we travel to Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist. We will stop at the Church of the Visitation, where Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth and proclaimed the "Magnificat." Mass will be celebrated. After lunch, we will visit Mt. Zion beginning with the Cenacle Church and Upper Room, where Jesus and His disciples held The Last Supper. Afterward, we will visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied our Lord three times (Psalm 88). We will visit St. Anne's Church, the Virgin Mary's birthplace, and the Pools of Bethesda. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 9: MT. OF OLIVES / PATER NOSTER / DOMINUS FLEVIT / GETHSEMANE

(Tuesday, June 24) We start our day on the Mount of Olives, first visiting the Pater Noster, where Jesus taught the Lord's prayer to his disciples. Our next stop will be Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem, followed by the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus agonized the night before his arrest. Mass will be celebrated. Our lunch will be at the Maronite Guesthouse inside the Old City of Jerusalem. You can visit

other holy sites, shop, or rest at your hotel for the rest of the afternoon. Dinner is on your own. We will suggest places to visit and eat within walking distance of your hotel. Overnight will be at your hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 10: VIA DOLOROSA – CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE / EMMAUS / JERUSALEM

(Wednesday, June 25) Early this morning, we will retrace the last steps of Jesus as we pray the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa. We will make our way to Calvary and the Tomb of Jesus Christ to celebrate Mass at the Church of the Resurrection (Holy Sepulcher). We will return to our hotel for a late breakfast, then travel to Emmaus. We will walk part of the road to Emmaus, one of Jesus' post-Resurrection appearances, and visit Notre Dame Church. We return to Jerusalem, where our Farewell Dinner will be at a local restaurant. Overnight will be at your hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 11: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

(Thursday, June 26) We will transfer to the airport this morning to catch our return flight home.

How to Register

- * Registration Form: fill out completely, names must match passport exactly.
- * Passport: provide a clean copy of your passport picture page with your registration; passports must be current six months after your return departure date.
- * Deposit: a non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$300 is due at registration.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Porterage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Extra food/beverage: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary. Tips/Gratuities: Tips for tour guides, drivers, and wait staff for included meals.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an

additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due (03/13/26) 100 Days before departure. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY
