DAY 1: U.S. TO LISBON

Today starts your international journey as you board an overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal. Relax and enjoy the flight, focusing on the spiritual journey ahead.

DAY 2: LISBON / SANTAREM / FATIMA

Upon arriving in Lisbon, our Nativity Pilgrimage tour guide will greet us and outline our journey. Our first stop is Santarem, home to the Church of St. Stephen, renowned for its 8th-century Eucharistic Miracle, providing a peaceful space for reflection. After this meaningful visit, we'll head to Fatima for a delightful dinner and a restful night at our hotel, preparing for the days ahead.

DAY 3: FATIMA

We will start our day with a mass at the Chapel of Apparitions, followed by a visit to the Basilica and the tombs of Francisco and Jacinta Marto. Our pilgrimage includes Aljustrel, their childhood home, and Valinhos, another sacred site. We will conclude with the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra, followed by dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 4: FATIMA / AVILA

This morning, we begin our journey to Ávila, known as the City of Kings and Saints, and the birthplace of St. Teresa of Jesus. We'll first visit the historic Carmelite Convent, followed by Mass at the impressive Ávila Cathedral. Then, enjoy a guided tour of the city's medieval heritage and fortifications. The day will end with dinner and an overnight stay at our hotel.

DAY 5: AVILA / BURGOS

We are excited to visit the enchanting city of Burgos, known for its stunning Gothic Cathedral, the final resting place of several Spanish monarchs. Our day will start with a guided tour exploring the cathedral's intricate designs and history, followed by a special Mass to enhance our spiritual connection. We'll end the evening with a delightful dinner and a restful overnight stay at our hotel.

DAY 6: BURGOS / LOYOLA / LOURDES

This morning, we begin our journey to Loyola, the birthplace of St. Ignatius, founder of The Jesuit Order. We will visit the architectural marvel of the Basilica of Loyola and then head to Lourdes,

a historic pilgrimage site. In the evening, we'll join a candlelight procession, a cherished tradition. Our day will end with a delicious dinner featuring local cuisine before we retire to our comfortable hotel.

DAY 7: LOURDES

Our Lourdes tour begins at Bernadette's house, highlighting her life and significance. We'll visit the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception and the Miraculous Spring, known for its healing properties, and reflect at the Shrine of Bernadette. The day also includes a trip to the 12th-century Castle for breathtaking views and local history. We'll conclude with a meditative walk through the Stations of the Cross, followed by dinner and an overnight stay at your hotel.

DAY 8: LOURDES / KRAKOW

Transfer to Toulouse airport to catch your flight to Krakow. Upon your arrival in Krakow, you'll be warmly greeted by our friendly local guide who will assist you in transferring to your hotel for a smooth check-in. Enjoy a delightful dinner and unwind for the night at your cozy accommodations.

DAY 9: KRAKOW

Prepare for an inspiring day in Krakow! Visit stunning sites like Wawel Cathedral, St. Mary's

Church, and the vibrant Old Town Market Square. You'll also see the International Shrine of Spirituality inaugurated by Pope John Paul II. After a fulfilling day, return to your hotel for dinner and a restful night.

DAY 10: KRAKOW | CZESTOCHOWA | AUSCHWITZ

Today's itinerary includes a visit to Czestochowa to see the Black Madonna Shrine and attend mass at the Chapel. We'll then head to Auschwitz to reflect on St. Maximilian Kolbe before returning to Krakow for dinner and a restful night at your hotel.

DAY 11: KRAKOW | LAGIEWINIKI | WIELICZKA

Join us for an inspiring day at the Divine Mercy Shrine in Lagiewniki to honor Saint Faustina. We'll celebrate mass at the Chapel of Relics before touring the Wieliczka Salt Mines, known for its beautiful salt-carved chapels and chambers. After a remarkable day, enjoy dinner and relaxation at your hotel.

DAY 11: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

As our unforgettable pilgrimage comes to a close, we'll transfer to the airport for your return flight home.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Your Package Does Not Include

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required. Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Extra food/beverage: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: Tips for tour guides, drivers, and wait staff for included meals.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Booking Conditions

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due (6/27/2026) 100 Days before departure. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

100 days - 61 days prior to departure.....\$150

60 days - 30 days prior to departure.....\$300

30 days - day before departure.....Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

49 Days	100% of trip cost
