DAY 1: FLIGHT TO DUBROVNIK

Your pilgrimage begins today, when you board your flight to Dubrovnik, Croatia, where your spiritual journey begins!

DAY 2: ARRIVE IN DUBROVNIK

Upon arrival in Dubrovnik, we will meet our tour director, who will accompany us throughout our pilgrimage. We will then transfer to our hotel for dinner and a restful night's sleep at our hotel in Dubrovnik.

DAY 3: DUBROVNIK

After breakfast, we will enjoy a walking tour of Dubrovnik's Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage site known as "The Jewel of the Adriatic." First, we will visit St. Blaise Church, honoring the city's patron saint. The original church was destroyed by a fire in 1706, with only a small silver statue of St. Blaise surviving. Here, we will receive the Blessing of the Throat with special candles available. After we celebrate Mass, we'll head over to the Cathedral of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary. There, we'll explore the Treasury, which houses an impressive collection of 182 relics. Among these are reliquaries containing the head and arm of St. Blaise, a relic of St. John II, and a fragment of the true Cross, thought to have been brought to Dubrovnik by Queen Margaret of England. This afternoon, we'll visit the 14th-century Franciscan Church and Monastery and walk the Old City Walls,

where we will enjoy spectacular views, including the Dominican Church and monastery and Sponza Palace (exterior views). Enjoy some time at leisure exploring the timeless streets peppered with small family-owned shops and restaurants. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel in Dubrovnik.

DAY 4: DUBROVNIK / MEDJUGORJE

This morning, we will drive to the quaint village of Medjugorje, one of the most visited Catholic sanctuaries in the world. We will celebrate Mass in the chapel at the Franciscan Convent. After lunch, we will take a walking tour of Medjugorje, including St. James Church and its surroundings. At 6 p.m., we'll join villagers and fellow pilgrims at St. James Church to commemorate Our Lady appearing to the Visionaries. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel.

DAY 5: APPARITION HILL

This morning, we will visit Podbro, also known as Apparition Hill, the site of Our Lady's apparition. There's a blue cross at the base of the hill marking the spot where Our Lady appeared to the children as they hid from communist police in the early days of the alleged apparitions. As we climb Apparition Hill, we will recite the rosary, pausing five times for each decade of the rosary. The top of the hill is where the first alleged apparition occurred on June 24, 1981. We'll take

time for prayer and reflection before returning to our hotel for breakfast. Mass will be celebrated at St. James Church. Enjoy the afternoon on your own for prayer and confession, and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel.

DAY 6: MT. KRIZEVAC / CENACOLO

This morning, we will have the opportunity to climb Mt. Krizevac, or Cross Mountain. In 1933, local villagers built a 30-foot cross atop the mountain to commemorate Jesus' passion and death on the cross. On the way to the top, we will pray the Stations of the Cross. There will be time for prayer and reflection before returning to our hotel for breakfast. Mass will be celebrated. This afternoon, we will visit the Cenacolo Community, founded by the Sisters of Charity in 1983. This organization helps young people whose lives have taken a wrong turn and are on the road to recovery through faith, prayer, work, and the virtue of charity. We will listen to a few of their testimonies and walk through the neighborhood of the visionaries before returning to our hotel. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel.

DAY 7: STATIONS OF THE CROSS

After breakfast, we will pray the Stations of the Cross through the eyes of Mary,

pausing at each Station, and ending at the Statue of the Risen Christ, all located on the grounds of St. James Church. This statue miraculously seeps droplets of water out of Christ's right knee at all times of the day. Mass will be celebrated. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel in Medjugorje.

DAY 8: KRAVICE WATERFALL

After breakfast and Mass, we will drive to the nearby Kravice Waterfalls, arguably the most beautiful waterfalls in Europe. We will walk the trail leading to these majestic falls, which provide fabulous views as you reflect on God's beauty in nature. Enjoy a swim and relaxation before returning to Medjugorje. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel in Medjugorje.

DAY 9: MEDJUGORJE / CAVTAT

After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will drive to Cavtat, a charming seaside town near Dubrovnik airport. We will enjoy lunch along the promenade and some time at leisure. Mass will be celebrated. Tonight's farewell dinner with wine will be at a local restaurant. Overnight accommodations in Cavtat.

DAY 10: RETURN HOME

We will transfer to the airport this morning to board our return flight home.

Submit a registration form and a \$300 non-refundable deposit with a copy of your passport to Nativity Pilgrimage. Names on the registration form and passport must match exactly, and passports must be current for at least six months after your return date. Full payment must be received 100 days before departure (01/12/26). Please include the trip code 5523 on all communications.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip fares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Tips/Gratuities: Tips for tour guides, drivers, and wait staff for included meals.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: Passports or any additional documents that may be required. Passports must be valid after 6 months of return date.

Personal Items: Laundry, other beverages (wines, liquors, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.) and food that are not on the menus of your included meal package, and any additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing, other services, or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Extra food/beverage: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only' option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due Monday, January 12, 2026 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:
