DAY 1: FLIGHT TO ISRAEL

(June 8th) Your pilgrimage begins today, when you board your flight to Israel. Sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight. Your spiritual journey awaits!

DAY 2: TEL AVIV / GALILEE

(June 9th) Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport, our professional tour guide will warmly welcome you before you board our luxurious motorcoach bus. Settle in as we embark on a delightful journey, culminating in a welcome dinner and overnight stay at our hotel in Tiberias. (Time permitting, Mass will be celebrated).

DAY 3: CANA / NAZARETH / MT. PRECIPICE / SEA OF GALILEE

(June 10th) After breakfast, we will begin our day in Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle, turning water into wine, and where couples may renew their wedding promises. We continue to the town of Nazareth to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, where Mary was visited by the angel Gabriel (Luke 1:26-38). Mass will be celebrated. We will stop at Mt. Precipice, from where the angry multitudes wanted to throw Jesus after his teaching at the Synagogue in Nazareth. In the afternoon, we will sail on the miraculous waters of the Sea of Galilee (Luke 5:1) and gather for a delightful group dinner on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. We conclude our day with a peaceful overnight stay at our hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 4: MT OF BEATITUDES / CAPERNAUM / PRIMACY OF PETER / VALLEY OF THE DOVES / GALILEE

(June 11th) After breakfast, our day begins with Mass at the Mount of Beatitudes, the location where Jesus proclaimed His great sermon, the "Sermon on the Mount". We will continue to Capernaum, where Jesus lived and started his ministry, including

a visit to the Synagogue where He taught (Mark 1:21-29). We will also visit the Church of the Primacy of Peter, where Jesus appeared to the disciples after His Resurrection and told Peter, "Feed my lambs, feed my sheep" (John 21:9). After a traditional St. Peter's fish lunch, we will spend time walking through the Valley of the Doves, the route Jesus traveled from Nazareth on his way to Capernaum. As the day draws to a close, we will enjoy dinner and a restful overnight at our hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 5: MT. TABOR / JORDAN RIVER / BETHANY / BETHLEHEM

(June 12, Friday) After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will embark on a scenic drive to Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1-50). Mass will be celebrated. Here, you will have time to reflect on Christ's Humanity and Divinity. We continue our journey to the Jordan River, where we will renew our baptismal promises at Qasr el Yahud. This site holds the oldest and most ancient tradition of being the place of Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist in the Jordan River (Matthew 3:13-17). After a savory lunch in Jericho, offering a true taste of the region's culinary delights, we will visit the house of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus in Bethany, as we make our way to Bethlehem. After dinner at our hotel, we will retire for a restful overnight stay in Bethlehem.

DAY 6: BETHLEHEM / SHEPHERD'S FIELD / CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY / CHAPEL OF THE MILK GROTTO

(June 13th) After breakfast, we will visit Shepherd's Field, where the shepherds' eyes were captivated by the Star of the Nativity. Next, we will see the Church of the Nativity, where we will venerate the sacred place of Jesus' birth. Mass will be celebrated. Then, we will walk a short distance to the Chapel of the Milk Grotto, where Mary and Joseph hid from Herod's soldiers so Mary could

nurse baby Jesus. According to tradition, a drop of Mary's milk fell upon the stone, turning the entire cave white. Next, we will have the opportunity to buy quality olive wood products, icons, and jewelry at a local Christian cooperative store that supports Christian families in need. As the day draws to a close, we will gather for dinner at our hotel and enjoy a peaceful overnight stay in Bethlehem.

DAY 7: JERUSALEM / MT. OF OLIVES: DOMINUS FLEVIT / GETHSEMANE / KIDRON VALLEY: SILOAM POOL

(June 14th) After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will go up to Jerusalem to the Mount of Olives and visit Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19:41), as we continue our descent to the Garden of Gethsemane. We will gather to celebrate Mass and can venerate the rock upon

which Jesus agonized the night before his arrest (Luke 22:29-53). Then, we will walk through the Kidron Valley to the Siloam Pool, where Jesus healed the blind man (John 9:1-11). We will settle into our hotel for dinner and a restful overnight stay in Jerusalem.

DAY 8: JERUSALEM / MT. ZION: CHURCH OF DORMITION / UPPER ROOM / ST. PETER IN GALICANTU

Following breakfast, we begin our day on Mt. Zion to visit the Church of Dormition, marking the very site where Mary, the Mother of Jesus, "fell asleep", and the Upper Room, where Jesus appeared to His disciples after His Death and Resurrection (Mark 16:14). Our final stop is St. Peter in Gallicantu, the house of the high priest Caiaphas and where Peter denied our Lord three times (Psalm 88). The rest of the day and dinner are at your leisure, before retreating for a restful overnight stay at our hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 9: JERUSALEM: VIA DOLOROSA / CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE / EMMAUS

(June 16th) This morning, we will retrace the last steps of Jesus, as we pray the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa, making our way to Calvary and the Tomb of Jesus Christ (Luke 23: 50-55). We will gather for Mass inside the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, the most holy place for Christians. After, we return to our hotel for breakfast before driving to Emmaus, the town mentioned in the Gospel of Luke, where Jesus appeared after His resurrection to two of His disciples while they were walking the road to Emmaus. We will return to Jerusalem, where you can enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. As the evening draws near, we will gather for our Farewell Dinner at our hotel. We will then retire for a peaceful overnight stay in Jerusalem, reflecting on the beauty and spirituality of the days spent walking in the footsteps of Jesus.

DAY 10: TRAVEL HOME

(June 17th) Today, we will board our return flight home.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Tips/Gratuities: Tips for tour guides, drivers, and wait staff for included meals.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Porterage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only' option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT NATIVITY PILGRIMAGE POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).



Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 02/27/2026 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments (accounting@nativitypilgrimage.com), and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

NEW HOLY LAND CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Full Refund Policy for Holy Land (War-Related Cancellations Only): If war occurs and the airline cancels flights to the Holy Land, Nativity Pilgrimage will issue a full refund for the land portion if canceled within 50 days of departure.

For cancellations less than 50 days of departure, if airline tickets have been issued, the airline's refund and cancellation policies will apply to the airfare portion.

Multi-Country Pilgrimages (Holy Land + Other Destinations): If the itinerary includes Jordan, Egypt, Rome, Greece, or other destinations, the refund policies of the respective local travel providers will apply to those portions.
