### **DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN MEXICO CITY | WELCOME MASS**

Arrive in Mexico City, one of the oldest capitals in the Americas. Upon arrival, you will meet your local guide and transfer to your hotel. In the afternoon, celebrate a Welcome Mass at the Church of the Holy Family, a sanctuary that preserves the remains of Blessed Miguel Agustín Pro. His courageous witness and final words “Viva Cristo Rey,” remains a powerful testimony of faith and devotion. Enjoy a welcome dinner and overnight stay at your hotel.

### **DAY 2: SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE | TEPEYAC HILL**

Today is devoted to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the world’s most visited Marian pilgrimage site. In 1531, the Virgin Mary appeared to Saint Juan Diego, leaving her miraculous image on his tilma, now housed in the Basilica. Patroness of Mexico and Empress of the Americas, she symbolizes faith and unity. Attend Holy Mass and tour the sanctuary complex, including the New and Old Basilicas, the Chapel of the Hill (Cerrito), and the Chapel of the Well (Pocito), with time for personal prayer. Overnight in Mexico City.

### **DAY 3: MEXICO CITY HISTORIC TOUR**

Explore Mexico City’s Historic Center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site blending indigenous and colonial traditions. Attend Mass at the Metropolitan Cathedral, built atop the Aztec Templo Mayor, then enjoy a walking tour of the Zócalo, Metropolitan Sagrario, and Santo Domingo Church. In the afternoon, take a panoramic drive along Reforma Avenue past the Palace of Fine Arts and historic districts, followed by dinner on your own. Overnight in Mexico City.

### **DAY 4: MEXICO CITY | QUERÉTARO | SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE**

Depart Mexico City for Querétaro, a key center of Franciscan evangelization. Celebrate Mass at the 17th-century Convent of the Holy Cross, noted for its missionary legacy and miraculous cross-shaped thorn tree. After a brief panoramic tour of the historic center, continue to San Miguel de Allende, a UNESCO-listed city celebrated for its colonial architecture and Catholic heritage. Overnight in San Miguel de Allende.

### **DAY 5: SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE | ATOTONILCO | GUANAJUATO**

Begin the day with Holy Mass at the Parish of Saint Michael the Archangel, the iconic symbol of San Miguel de Allende. After a walking tour of the historic center, travel to Atotonilco to visit the Sanctuary of Jesus of Nazareth, often referred to as the “Sistine Chapel of Mexico” due to its impressive biblical murals depicting the Passion of Christ. Continue on to the historic mining city of Guanajuato. Overnight in Guanajuato.

### **DAY 6: HISTORIC GUANAJUATO**

Explore Guanajuato, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its colorful colonial architecture and history. Attend Mass at a historic church, then visit the Historic Center, Plaza de la Paz, the University of Guanajuato (exterior), the Alley of the Kiss, and the Pípila Monument for panoramic city views. Overnight in Guanajuato.

### **DAY 7: GUANAJUATO | CHRIST THE KING | SAN JUAN DE LOS LAGOS**

Visit the traditional Hidalgo and Gavira markets for a glimpse of daily Mexican life, then continue to Cerro del Cubilete—Mexico’s geographic center—home to the Sanctuary of Christ the King and a symbol of the Cristero martyrs. Celebrate Mass, pass through Dolores Hidalgo, birthplace of Mexican Independence, and continue to San Juan de los Lagos for an overnight stay.

### **DAY 8: SAINT TORIBIO ROMO | SAHUAYO | GUADALAJARA**

Celebrate Holy Mass at the Sanctuary of Saint Toribio Romo, a Cristero martyr widely venerated as the protector of migrants. Continue to Sahuayo, birthplace of Saint José Sánchez del Río, a young martyr who gave his life for Christ the King. The journey continues to Guadalajara, capital of the state of Jalisco. Overnight in Guadalajara.

### **DAY 9: ZAPOPAN | TEQUILA | LAKE CHAPALA**

Celebrate Holy Mass at the Basilica of Our Lady of Zapopan, home to one of Mexico’s oldest and most beloved Marian images, affectionately known as La Generala. Visit the town of Tequila,

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

**Air Transportation:** Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

**Land Transportation:** All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

**Hotels:** Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

**Meal Plan:** The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

**Baggage:** Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

**Airport Fees:** Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

**Medical Insurance:** Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

## YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

**Cancellation Insurance:** We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

**Passport Expenses:** This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

**Personal Expenses:** Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

**Non-itinerary fees:** Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

**Non-included meals:** You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

**Tips/Gratuities:** This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

## GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

**Group Air:** Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

**Departure Cities:** If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

**Land-Only Option:** If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

## IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

**Single Room:** Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

**Seat Upgrades:** Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

**Other Special Requests:** Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

## BOOKING CONDITIONS

**Deposit:** A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

**Payment Deadline:** Full payment is due 07/10/2026 100 Days before departure. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

**Payment Methods:** We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

## LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	FEE

60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

## CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

100 + days	Lose deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.

**Important:** If you plan to purchase Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage, it must be purchased at the time of registration.
