DAY 1 – DEPART FOR LONDON

Today kicks off an amazing journey as we fly to England! Get ready to relax and enjoy the exciting adventures that await us on this unforgettable pilgrimage.

DAY 2 – ARRIVAL IN LONDON

Upon arrival in London, we will meet our tour guide and driver and begin our spiritual journey at St. Alban's Cathedral, which honors St. Alban, the protomartyr of England, who was martyred in the early 4th century during Roman persecution. Afterward, we will celebrate Mass at St. Etheldreda's Church or St. Patrick's in Soho. We will then head to our hotel for the evening, check in, and unwind before dinner.

DAY 3 – LONDON

After breakfast, our day begins with visits to Westminster Cathedral, the Catholic Cathedral of the Archdiocese of Westminster and Tyburn Convent. Mass will be celebrated. Afterward, we will take a guided panoramic tour of London that includes the Tower of London, where Saints Thomas More & John Fisher were held captive in 1535. Next, we will visit St. Paul's Cathedral. Tonight, we'll enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before heading back to our hotel for the evening.

DAY 4 – AYLESFORD & CANTERBURY

After breakfast, we will depart from London, with a possible visit to Haverstock Hill (time permitting). We will also see the Dominican Rosary Shrine, a historic Catholic church and Diocesan Shrine to Mary, served by the Dominican Friars, as well as the Aylesford Priory and the Shrine of St. Simon Stock.

We'll continue to Ramsgate, the seaside port town in eastern Kent, England, where we will visit the Shrine of St Augustine of Canterbury and celebrate Mass. Finally, we will check into our hotel and relax before dinner and a nice evening in Canterbury.

DAY 5 – CAMBRIDGE TO WALSINGHAM

After breakfast, we depart Canterbury for the historic University city of Cambridge, where our tour will include the renowned King's College and the magnificent Ely Anglican Cathedral. We then continue to Walsingham, visiting the Slipper Chapel, the Anglican Shrine, and celebrating Mass at the Catholic Shrine. The day concludes with dinner at our hotel and an overnight stay in the Lincolnshire area.

DAY 6 – YORK

This morning, we leave Lincolnshire and travel to York, where we visit sites associated with St. Margaret Clitherow, who converted to Roman Catholicism and faced persecution for harbouring Catholic Priests in the late 1500's. We celebrate Mass at the Bar Convent, view the relic of St. Margaret Clitherow's hand, and enjoy a walk across the picturesque bridge over the River Ouse. Dinner is served at a local restaurant, followed by an overnight stay in York.

DAY 7 – YORK

Today, we enjoy a walking tour of York, including a visit to the iconic York Minster. We celebrate Mass either in the historic Shambles or at St. Wilfrid's Parish before departing in the late afternoon. Dinner and overnight accommodations await in the South Yorkshire or Nottingham area.

DAY 8 – BIRMINGHAM TO OXFORD

Our journey continues to Birmingham, where we visit the Oratory, including Newman’s library and rooms, and celebrate Mass. We then explore Mosley Bog—the woodland that inspired J.R.R. Tolkien—before traveling on to Oxford. In Oxford, we visit Littlemore, associated with St. John Henry Newman, as well as Tolkien and C.S. Lewis. Dinner is provided at our hotel, where we will spend the night.

DAY 9 – OXFORD

We continue our exploration of Oxford with a guided walking tour featuring Magdalen College, followed by a Mass celebration at the Oxford Oratory. The day concludes with a festive farewell dinner in Oxford and another overnight stay in this historic university city.

DAY 10 – LONDON

Today, we travel to Beaconsfield for a visit connected to G.K. Chesterton, including the churchyard and the two houses associated with his life. We celebrate Mass at St. Theresa’s Parish Church in Beaconsfield before returning to London for an evening at leisure. Overnight in London.

DAY 11 – RETURN HOME

We conclude our pilgrimage with a transfer to the airport for our return flight home.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 100 Days before departure (03/06/2026). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.

Important: If you plan to purchase Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage, it must be purchased at the time of registration.
