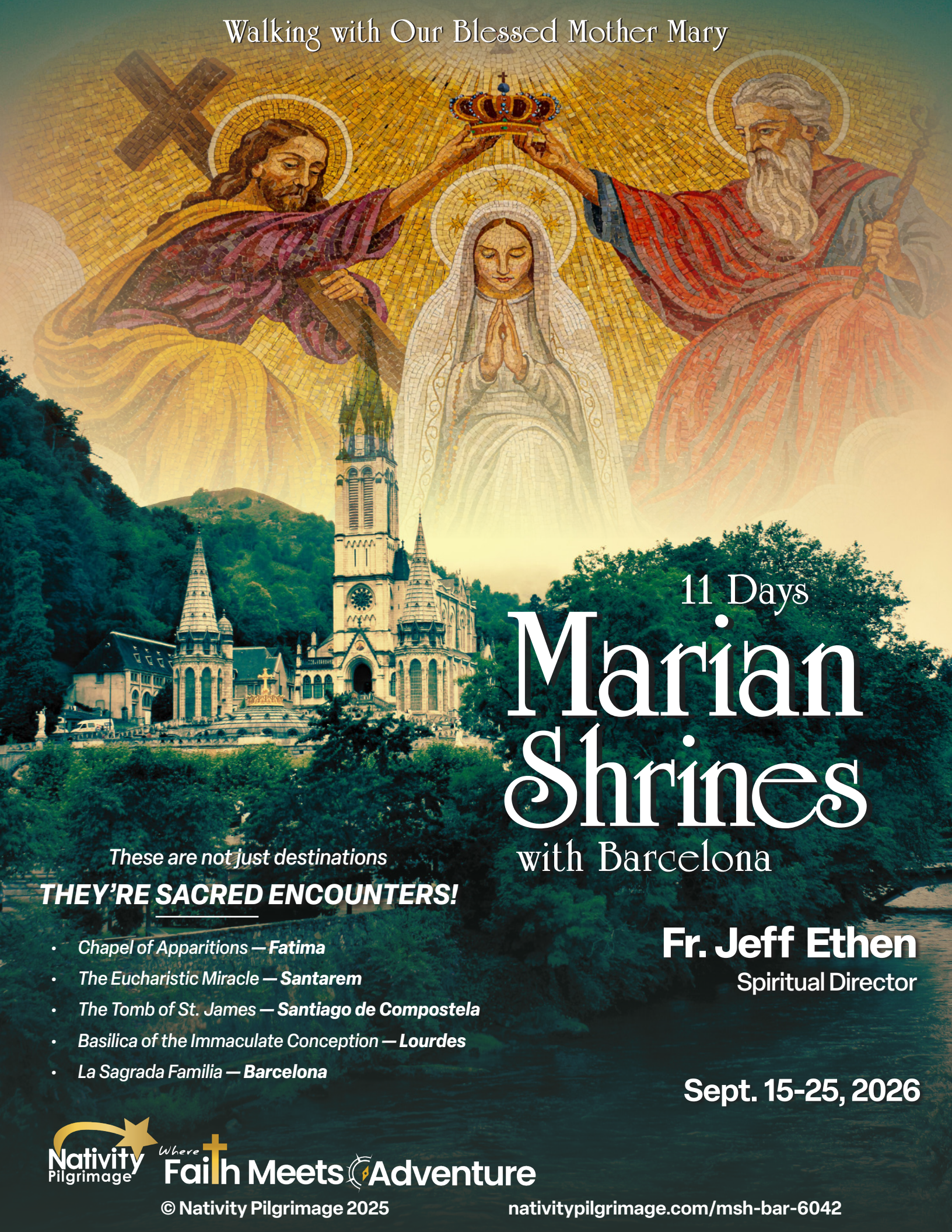

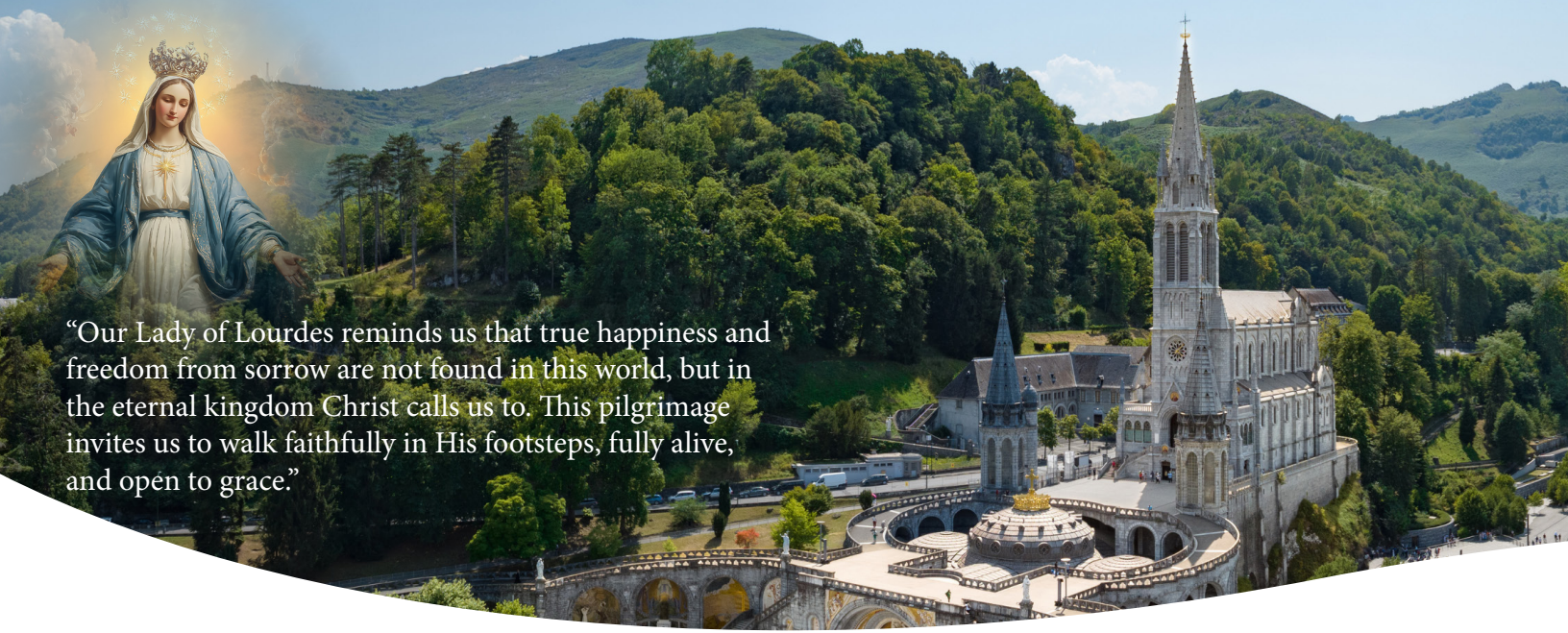

DAY 1: FLIGHT TO LISBON, PORTUGAL

Your pilgrimage begins with your international overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal. Everything is arranged for a smooth experience. Relax and enjoy the amenities as you embark on your spiritual journey.

DAY 2: LISBON / SANTAREM / FATIMA

Upon your arrival in Lisbon, you will meet your Nativity Pilgrimage tour guide, who will accompany you to our first stop. We will visit the historic Church of St. Stephen in Santarém, Portugal, renowned for its 8th-century eucharistic miracle. After this visit, we will head to Fatima, check into our hotel for the evening, and relax before dinner.

DAY 3: FATIMA

We will start our day with a solemn Mass at the Chapel of Apparitions. Following that, we will visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Fatima to learn about Saints Francisco and Jacinta Marto. Afterward, we will explore the hamlet of Aljustrel, where the shepherd children grew up, and Valinhos, another significant apparition site. We will conclude the day with prayer and reflection at the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra, before returning to the hotel for dinner and a relaxing evening.

DAY 4: PORTO TO SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

After enjoying breakfast at your hotel, you'll celebrate Mass before departing for Porto, a city renowned for its

amazing wine. So, it's only natural that we enjoy a guided tour and tasting at one of the city's local wine factories. In the afternoon, we will travel to Santiago de Compostela, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Upon arrival, we will check into your hotel to relax before dinner.

DAY 5: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

After breakfast, we will explore Santiago de Compostela, starting at the magnificent Cathedral, the sacred Tomb of St. James, and the beautiful Convents of San Francisco and Santa Clara. After a day of discovery, we'll return to our hotel to relax before dinner.

DAY 6: BURGOS

After breakfast, we will travel to Burgos, the final resting place of many Spanish monarchs. We'll start with a Mass at the stunning Burgos Cathedral, a prime example of Gothic architecture. Afterward, we'll enjoy a delicious dinner at a local restaurant, savoring regional flavors, before checking into our hotel for the evening.

DAY 7: LOYOLA TO LOURDES

Today will be an inspiring journey as we visit Loyola, the birthplace of St. Ignatius, founder of the Jesuit Order. We'll start at the beautiful Basilica of Loyola to learn about St. Ignatius's life and legacy. Then, we'll continue to Lourdes, check into our hotel, and enjoy a delicious dinner. There's also an optional candlelight procession after dinner for a peaceful spiritual moment.

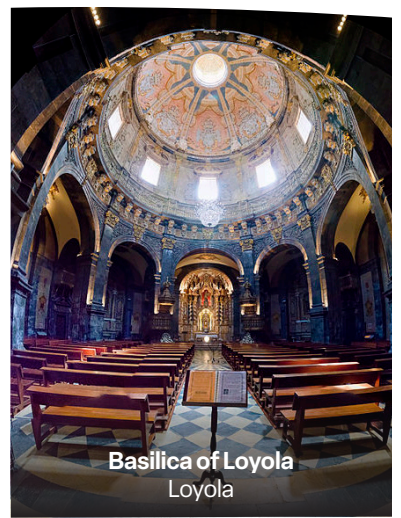

DAY 8: LOURDES

After breakfast, we begin a guided tour of Lourdes, including St. Bernadette's house, the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, and the Miraculous Spring, renowned for its healing properties. We'll also visit the XII-century Castle for panoramic views and insight into the town's medieval history. Enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure. Tonight's dinner will be at your hotel.

DAY 9: CARCASSONNE TO BARCELONA

This morning, we're off to Barcelona! We'll stop first in Carcassonne, a hilltop town in southern France's Languedoc region, famous for its medieval citadel, La Cité, with numerous watchtowers and double-walled fortifications. After lunch, we'll continue to Barcelona. We'll arrive at our hotel and settle in before dinner.

DAY 10: BARCELONA

This morning, we will embark on a captivating tour of Barcelona's historic Gothic Quarter, where narrow medieval streets are lined with quaint shops and inviting cafes. Visit the stunning Church of Santa Maria Del Mar, an exemplary showcase of Catalan Gothic architecture. Discover Antoni Gaudí's masterpiece, La Sagrada Familia, followed by the

Cathedral of St. Eulalia, renowned for its exquisite cloisters. After a leisurely lunch on the vibrant Las Ramblas, conclude the day with a delightful dinner at a nearby restaurant before returning to your hotel.

DAY 11: DEPARTURE

This morning, we will arrange transportation to the airport to ensure you arrive on time for your flight. Please be ready to depart at the scheduled time for a smooth journey.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only' option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No

reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 6/07/2026 (100 Days before departure.) Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	FEE
100 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	PENALTY
100 + days	Lose deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.

PROTECT YOUR TRIP

Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip.

We also strongly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance (available at an additional cost) to safeguard your travel investment in case unforeseen circumstances require you to cancel. Please contact our office for details about trip cancellation insurance options.

Important: If you plan to purchase Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage, it must be purchased at the time of registration.
