DAY 1 – FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV, ISRAEL

Today, you will board your international flight to Tel Aviv, Israel.

DAY 2 – ARRIVE IN TEL AVIV / JAFFA

Welcome to the Holy Land! After completing passport control and collecting your luggage, check in to your chosen hotel in Tel Aviv to settle in and refresh. Depending on your arrival time, you may join your guide for a tour of Old Jaffa. Stroll through the charming cobblestone streets and explore the art galleries and boutique stores. Learn about Jaffa’s significance in the Bible, particularly the vision of Peter in the House of Simon the Tanner (Acts 9). You will spend the night in Tel Aviv.

DAY 3 – TEL AVIV / CAESAREA / MUHRAQA / MT. CARMEL

Start your day at Israel’s Independence Hall in Tel Aviv, where David Ben-Gurion declared independence in 1948. Visit Caesarea Maritima, founded by King Herod, and explore Herod’s Palace, where the Apostle Paul was imprisoned. After lunch, head to Muhraqa on Mount Carmel, commemorating Elijah’s victory over the prophets of Baal, and enjoy stunning views of northern Israel before spending the night in Tiberias.

DAY 4 – CAPERNAUM / MT. OF BEATITUDES / TABGHA / MAGDALA / SEA OF GALILEE

Start your day in Capernaum, known as “the Town of Jesus,” visiting the ancient synagogue and St. Peter’s house. Next, visit the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount, and then Tabgha, the site of the feeding of the 5,000. At Kibbutz Ginosar, see a 2,000-year-old boat linked to the story of Jesus walking on water. After lunch, enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, then explore Magdala and its synagogue before spending the night in Tiberias.

DAY 5 – CAESAREA PHILIPPI / GOLAN HEIGHTS

Begin your journey at Tel Dan, an archaeological site by the Dan stream, where you can explore the ancient cultic center linked to the Golden Calf (1 Kings 12) and the Canaanite and Israelite gateways. Next, visit Caesarea-Philippi (Baniyas), where Jesus appointed Peter as his disciple (Matthew 16). Ascend to the Golan Heights, possibly following Paul’s route to Damascus (Acts 9). Enjoy a traditional Druze lunch and visit the 1973 “Valley of Tears” battle site. End your day with wine tasting or a panoramic view of the Golan Heights from Mount Bental before overnighing in Tiberias.

DAY 6 – CANA / NAZARETH / ARMAGEDDON

Start your journey in Galilee with a visit to Cana, where Jesus turned water into wine (John 2). Then, explore Nazareth’s Basilica of the Annunciation and St. Joseph Church. After lunch, head to Megiddo Archaeological Park, significant for its biblical connections and well-preserved ruins. Conclude your day with an overnight stay in Jerusalem.

DAY 7 – JERUSALEM / VIA DOLOROSA

Touring Jerusalem as a Christian is a deeply enriching experience. Start at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, marking Jesus’ crucifixion, burial, and resurrection. Next, walk the Via Dolorosa, the route Jesus took to his crucifixion. Visit the Western Wall, then explore the Jewish Quarter and Mount Zion, where you can see the Room of the Last Supper and Dormition Abbey. Head to the Mount of Olives for a stunning view of the city and the Chapel of the Ascension. Conclude your day at the Garden of Gethsemane, a peaceful site for reflection. Overnight accommodations are available in Jerusalem.

DAY 8 – CITY OF DAVID / GARDEN TOMB

Start your day at the City of David, the historical heart of Jerusalem. Explore archaeological finds related to David’s palace and hike to the Gihon Spring. Visit the Pool of Siloam, where Jesus healed a blind man, and then explore the Southern Wall Archaeological Park, including the Southern Steps that Jesus walked. After lunch, head to the Garden Tomb for a guided reflection on the death and resurrection of Jesus. The peaceful garden offers a perfect spot for prayer before returning to your accommodations in Jerusalem for the night.

DAY 9 – BETHLEHEM / ISRAEL MUSEUM

This day tour is designed for Saturdays (Sabbath), when many Jerusalem sites are closed. Begin at the Church of the Nativity, the birthplace of Jesus, where you can admire the Grotto’s medieval art and architecture. Next, visit the Shepherd’s Field, the site of the angel’s announcement to the shepherds, and explore the tent-shaped chapel and nearby livestock caves. After a lunch break and some souvenir shopping, return to Jerusalem to visit the Israel Museum, highlighting the Shrine of the Book, Judaica, and archaeological wings, and the Second Temple Model of Jerusalem. Spend the night in Jerusalem.

DAY 10 – MASADA / JORDAN RIVER BAPTISM SITE

Descend through the stunning Judean Desert to the Jordan River Baptism site, where the Israelites crossed into the Promised Land and Jesus was baptized. After exploring this site and possibly participating in a baptism, head to Masada. Take a cable car to the summit to learn about its historical significance and the Jewish resistance against Roman conquest. Following lunch, you can swim in the Dead Sea or hike in Ein Gedi Nature Reserve. On your return, your guide will point out the location of the Dead Sea Scrolls and their early Christian significance. Overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 11 – EMMAUS / DAVID AND GOLIATH’S BATTLE SITE

Discover the enchanting beauty and rich biblical history of the Shephela, often called “biblical Tuscany.” Start in Emmaus, where Jesus appeared to his disciples (Luke 24), then visit Elah Valley, the site of David and Goliath’s battle (1 Samuel 17). Collect pebbles from the brook and enjoy the view from Tel Azekah. Savor local wines and have a light lunch at a winery before concluding your day at Beth-Shemesh, known for the Ark of the Covenant’s return (1 Samuel 6). Explore a 2,700-year-old water reservoir before your evening airport transfer. Farewell!

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Medical Insurance: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due May 4, 2026. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	FEE
100 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	PENALTY
100 + days	Lose deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.
