# YOUR DAILY ITINERARY

## DAY 1: DEPARTURE – OVERNIGHT TO DUBLIN

Your journey begins in comfort as you board your overnight flight to Dublin. Settle in, relax, and anticipate the extraordinary days ahead as your pilgrimage unfolds.

## DAY 2: ARRIVAL IN DUBLIN

Arrive in Dublin, where you are welcomed by your private guide and driver. Begin with a panoramic introduction to Ireland's vibrant capital, including a visit to the magnificent St. Patrick's Cathedral. Afterward, retire to your hotel to unwind and enjoy a thoughtfully prepared dinner.

## DAY 3: DUBLIN AT LEISURE

Enjoy a leisurely morning and a full day to experience Dublin at your own pace. Explore world-class museums,

## DAY 6: ARMAGH & BELFAST

Travel north into Northern Ireland, pausing in Armagh, the historic ecclesiastical capital. Visit St. Patrick's Cathedral and celebrate Mass in this sacred setting. Continue to Belfast for a guided city tour, taking in landmarks such as City Hall, the Titanic Quarter, St. Anne's Cathedral, and Stormont. Dinner and overnight in Belfast or surrounding area.

## DAY 7: ACROSS THE IRISH SEA – EDINBURGH

Depart Belfast and cross the Irish Sea by ferry to Scotland. Continue to Edinburgh, a city of timeless elegance. Celebrate Mass at St. Patrick's Church before exploring the iconic Edinburgh Castle, perched dramatically above the city skyline. Dinner and overnight in Edinburgh or surrounding area.

browse the elegant shops along O'Connell Street, or immerse yourself in the charm of traditional pubs with live Irish music. This evening, reconvene with your fellow travelers for dinner. Dinner and overnight in Dublin or surrounding area.

## DAY 4: WICKLOW & GLENDALOUGH – KILKENNY

Travel through the breathtaking Wicklow Mountains to Glendalough, a serene valley steeped in monastic history. Wander among the evocative sixth-century ruins and ancient churches before continuing to the medieval city of Kilkenny. Discover architectural gems including St. Canice's Cathedral and the atmospheric Black Abbey. Dinner and overnight in Kilkenny or surrounding area.

## DAY 5: KNOCK – A PLACE OF PILGRIMAGE

Journey west to Knock, one of the world's most revered Marian shrines. Visit the Basilica and enjoy time for quiet reflection in this deeply spiritual setting. The evening offers an opportunity to gather with your group over

## DAY 8: YORK – A JOURNEY THROUGH HISTORY

Begin with a visit to the awe-inspiring York Minster, followed by a stroll through the historic Shambles. Continue to Birmingham to visit the Oratory of St. John Henry Newman, including his personal library and rooms, and celebrate Mass. Later, enjoy a visit to Moseley Bog, the tranquil woodland that inspired J.R.R. Tolkien. Dinner and overnight in Birmingham or surrounding area.

## DAY 10: OXFORD & LONDON

Travel to Oxford, where centuries of academic and spiritual tradition converge. Visit Littlemore, associated with St. John Henry Newman, and explore the city on a

guided walking tour, including Magdalen College. Celebrate Mass at the Oxford Oratory before continuing to London. Dinner and overnight in London or surrounding area.

## DAY 11: LONDON – A GRAND FINALE

Begin your day with visits to Westminster Cathedral and Tyburn Convent, followed by the celebration of Mass. A panoramic tour of London reveals iconic landmarks, including the Tower of London—once the prison of Saints Thomas More and John Fisher—and St. Paul's Cathedral. This evening, enjoy a memorable farewell dinner in one of London's distinguished restaurants, marking the conclusion of your journey in style. Overnight in London or surrounding area.

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

**Air Transportation:** Economy class and round-trip fares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

**Land Transportation:** All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

**Hotels:** Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

**Meal Plan:** The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

**Baggage:** Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

**Airport Fees:** Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

**Medical Insurance:** Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

## YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

**Cancellation Insurance:** We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

**Passport Expenses:** This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

**Personal Expenses:** Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

**Non-itinerary fees:** Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

**Non-included meals:** You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

**Tips/Gratuities:** This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

## GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

**Group Air:** Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

**Departure Cities:** If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

**Land-Only Option:** If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

## IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

**Single Room:** Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

**Seat Upgrades:** Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

**Other Special Requests:** Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

## BOOKING CONDITIONS

**Deposit:** A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

**Payment Deadline:** Full payment is due Thursday, July 2, 2026. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

**Payment Methods:** We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

## LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

100 - 61 days from departure	\$150
60 - 30 days from departure	\$300
30 days - day from departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

## CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

100 + days from departure	Lose deposit
99 - 50 days from departure	50% of trip cost
49 days or less from departure	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.

## PROTECT YOUR TRIP

**Medical Insurance:** Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip.
