DAY 1: DEPART USA / VENICE

Today: Your pilgrimage begins today as you depart on your overnight flight to Venice. Meals and drinks served aloft.

DAY 2: ARRIVE IN VENICE

Arrive in Venice and meet your guide and driver. Board the bus to begin discovering the Queen of the Adriatic. We will visit the stunning Santa Maria della Salute Basilica and the iconic Rialto Bridge. In the evening, we will gather together for a time of Evening Prayer before checking into our hotel in Mestre for a delightful dinner and a restful night.

DAY 3: VENICE

Begin the day with a visit to St. Mark's Basilica, where Mass will be celebrated, followed by time to explore the magnificent Piazza San Marco. Enjoy an included gondola ride, then spend the afternoon at leisure to discover Venice at your own pace. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Mestre.

DAY 4: VENICE – TURIN

After breakfast, depart by bus for Turin, arriving in the afternoon. Enjoy a panoramic city tour followed by free time to explore at your leisure. Visit the Cathedral of Saint

John the Baptist, home of the revered Holy Shroud, where you will also have a brief talk and time for prayer. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 5: TURIN – FLORENCE

Begin the day with a guided tour of the Basilica of Mary Help of Christians, home of St. John Bosco. Afterward, depart for Florence. Upon arrival, visit the Baptistery of St. John and the Accademia Gallery to admire Michelangelo's David. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 6: FLORENCE - ASSISI

Depart to Assisi. The first stop will be a visit to the San Damiano Chapel, followed by a Time of Reflection and Prayer. Afterwards, the group will enjoy lunch on your own in Assisi, followed by a guided visit to the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi and St. Carlo Acutis. Free time for shopping before returning to the hotel for dinner. Mass in a chapel at the hotel in Assisi.

DAY 7: DAY TRIP TO CASCIA

Enjoy an excursion to Cascia to visit the Sanctuary of Saint Rita, patroness of impossible causes. Explore her basilica, the Monastery of Saint Mary Magdalene, and view her incorrupt body. Join together for



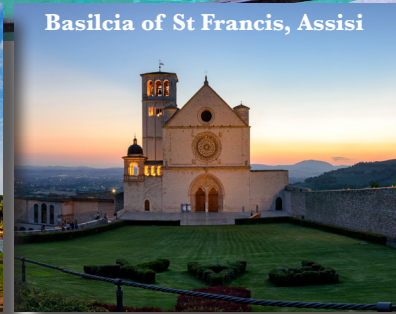

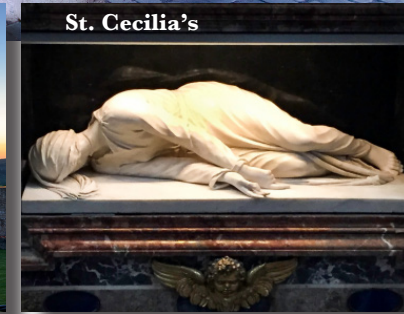

Morning Prayer under the vine, a tradition connected to St. Rita. Lunch at Trattoria Il Grottino da Orlando. Return to Assisi in the afternoon for a countryside wine tasting overlooking the town of Assisi. Overnight at your hotel.

DAY 8: ASSISI – ORVIETO – ROME

Depart for Orvieto to visit the magnificent Cathedral and the Chapel of the Eucharistic Miracle. Mass will be celebrated. Continue to Rome. Visit the Catacombs of St. Callixtus, including the Crypt of St. Cecilia, the martyr and patron saint of music.. Check in to your hotel. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 9: PAPAL AUDIENCE – ST. PETER'S

Begin the day with the Papal Audience, a special opportunity to see and receive the blessing of the Holy Father. Afterward, visit the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica.

Enjoy lunch on your own, then spend the afternoon at leisure to explore Rome at your own pace. There will also be an optional opportunity to participate in the Scavi Tour. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 10: ST. CLEMENT'S HOUSE - COLOSSEUM - SPANISH STEPS – TREVI FOUNTAIN

After breakfast, visit St. Clement's House with a morning prayer. Later, visit the Colosseum. In the evening, enjoy visits to the Spanish Steps, Piazza Navona, and the Trevi Fountain. Farewell dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight at your hotel.

DAY 11: ROME – USA

Transfer to the airport for your return flight home.



HOW TO REGISTER

- * Submit a non-refundable \$300 deposit along with a copy of your registration form and passport, or use the QR code below to register online.
- * Names on the registration form and passport must match exactly.
- * U.S. passports must be current up to six months after the return date.
- * We are not responsible for Visa procurement.
- * Full payment is due 100 days before departure on 05/25/2026.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 5/25/2026 (100 Days before departure.) Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	FEE

60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	PENALTY
100 + days	Lose deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.

PROTECT YOUR TRIP

Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip.

We also strongly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance (available at an additional cost) to safeguard your travel investment in case unforeseen circumstances require you to cancel. Please contact our office for details about trip cancellation insurance options.

Important: If you plan to purchase Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage, it must be purchased at the time of registration.
