The HOLY LAND PILGRIMAGE

DAY 1: DEPART FROM USA TO ISRAEL

Your pilgrimage begins today, boarding your flight to Israel. Sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight. Your spiritual journey awaits!

DAY 2: TEL AVIV / GALILEE

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport, our professional tour guide will warmly welcome you before you board our luxurious motorcoach bus. Settle in as we embark on a delightful journey, culminating in a Welcome dinner and overnight stay at our hotel in Tiberias. (Time permitting, Mass will be celebrated).

DAY 3: CANA / NAZARETH / SEA OF GALILEE

After breakfast, we will begin our day in Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle and where couples may renew their wedding promises. We continue to the town of Nazareth where we will visit the Basilica of the Annunciation. Mass will be celebrated. In the afternoon, we will sail on the miraculous waters of the Sea of Galilee and gather for a delightful group dinner on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. We conclude our day with a peaceful overnight stay at our hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 4: MT OF BEATITUDES / CAPERNAUM / TABGHA / GALILEE

After breakfast, our day begins with Mass at the Mount of Beatitudes, the location of the Sermon on the Mount. We will continue to Capernaum where Jesus lived, started

his ministry, and performed many miracles. After a traditional St. Peter's fish lunch, we will visit the Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fish in Tabgha, commemorating Jesus' miracle of feeding 5,000 men, and the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter, where Jesus appeared to the disciples after the resurrection. As the day draws to a close, we will enjoy dinner and a restful overnight at our hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 5: MT. TABOR / JORDAN RIVER / VALLEY OF THE SHADOW OF DEATH /

After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will embark on a scenic drive to Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration. Mass will be celebrated. We continue our journey to the Jordan River where we will renew our baptismal promises at Qasr el Yahud. This site holds the oldest and most ancient tradition for being the place of Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist in the Jordan River (Matthew 3:13-17). After a savory lunch in Jericho, offering a true taste of the region's culinary delights, we will visit the Valley of the Shadow of Death (Psalm 23:4) as we make our way to the not-so-little town of Bethlehem. After dinner at our hotel, we will retire for a restful overnight stay in Bethlehem.

DAY 6: BETHLEHEM / EIN KAREM

After breakfast, we will visit the Church of the Nativity where we will venerate the sacred place of Jesus' birth. Mass will be celebrated. Then, we will walk a short distance to the Chapel of the Milk Grotto, where Mary and Joseph hid from Herod's soldiers so Mary could nurse baby Jesus. According to tradition, a drop of Mary's milk fell upon the stone, turning the entire cave white. We will have the opportunity to buy quality olive wood products, icons and jewelry at a local Christian cooperative store that

supports Christian families in need. In the afternoon, we will take a scenic drive to the village of Ein Karem where we will venerate the birthplace of St. John the Baptist and visit the Church of Visitation where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth and proclaimed the 'Magnificat'. As the day draws to a close, we will gather for dinner at our hotel and enjoy a peaceful overnight stay in Bethlehem.

DAY 7: MT. OF OLIVES / DOMINUS FLEVIT / GETHSEMANE / UPPER ROOM

Following breakfast and hotel check out, we will go up to Jerusalem to the Mount of Olives and visit Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem, as we continue our descent to the Garden of Gethsemane. We will gather to celebrate Mass and can venerate the rock upon which Jesus agonized the night before his arrest. We conclude our day on Mt. Zion with a visit to the Upper Room, where Jesus appeared to His disciples after His Death and Resurrection. We will settle into our hotel for dinner and a restful overnight stay in Jerusalem.

DAY 8: ST. ANNE'S / PATER NOSTER / ST. PETER IN GALlicantu

Following breakfast, our day begins at St. Anne's Church, the birthplace of the Virgin Mary, and a visit to the Pools of Bethesda. Then, we will stop to pray at Pater Noster, the place where Jesus taught the Lord's prayer to his disciples. Our final stop is St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied our Lord three times (Psalm 88). Mass will be celebrated. Enjoy the rest of the day and dinner at your leisure, before retreating for a restful overnight stay at our hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 9: JERUSALEM - VIA DOLOROSA

This morning, we will retrace the last steps of Jesus, as we pray the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa, making our way to Calvary and the Tomb of Jesus Christ. We will gather for Mass at the Tomb inside the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the most holy place for Christians. We will return to our hotel for breakfast. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. As the evening draws near, we will gather for our Farewell Dinner at the rooftop restaurant at our hotel. We will then retire for a peaceful overnight stay in Jerusalem, reflecting on the beauty and spirituality of the days spent walking in the footsteps of Jesus.

DAY 10: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

This morning, we will transfer to the airport and board our return flight home..

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

Baggage: Most airlines limit all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT NATIVITY PILGRIMAGE POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 06/11/2027 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments (accounting@nativitypilgrimage.com), and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

War-Related Cancellations (Holy Land Only): In the event of war or armed conflict affecting the Holy Land only, resulting in airline flight cancellations or official government travel restrictions, Nativity Pilgrimage will issue a full refund of the land portion for the Holy Land.

This refund applies exclusively to services provided within the Holy Land and does not apply to airfare or to any other destinations included in the itinerary.

Multi-Country Pilgrimages: For itineraries that include destinations outside the Holy Land (such as Jordan, Egypt, Rome, Greece, or other countries), the refund policies of the respective local service providers and suppliers will apply to those portions of the trip.
