# YOUR DAILY itinerary

## DAY 1: DEPART USA | ROME

Begin your pilgrimage with an overnight flight to Rome, preparing for a journey of faith, culture, and unforgettable beauty through Italy.

## DAY 2: ROME | ORVIETO | ASSISI

Arrive in Rome and meet your professional English-speaking guide. Travel to Orvieto to celebrate Mass at the magnificent Duomo, built to honor the Eucharistic Miracle of Orvieto. After time for lunch and exploration, continue to Assisi for a welcome dinner and overnight.

## DAY 3: ASSISI

Tour the Basilica of St. Francis and celebrate Mass. Visit the Church of St. Clare, San Damiano, and the Santuario della Spogliazione, where Blessed Carlo Acutis is entombed. Enjoy free time to explore Assisi's charming hilltop streets at your leisure.

## DAY 4: CASCIA | LANCIANO | SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

Depart for Cascia to visit the Monastery and Shrine of St. Rita, including her incorrupt body and sacred relics. Continue to Lanciano, site of the Eucharistic Miracle, and celebrate Mass at the Sanctuary. Travel onward to San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 5: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO | SORRENTO

Visit the sacred sites associated with St. Padre Pio, including his tomb, cell, confessional, the old church where he received the stigmata, and the Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie. Celebrate Mass before departing for Sorrento for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 6: AMALFI COAST | SORRENTO

Travel to Salerno and board a boat to experience the breathtaking Amalfi Coast, one of the world's most celebrated coastal landscapes. View Positano, Praiano, and Amalfi, including the Cathedral of St. Andrew. Return to Sorrento for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 7: SORRENTO CULINARY EXPERIENCE

Visit a buffalo mozzarella cheese factory, followed by a wine and food tasting lunch at a local agriturismo. Enjoy a relaxed afternoon in Sorrento, with time to savor regional specialties such as Delizia al Limone and Sfogliatelle. Dinner and overnight in Sorrento.

## DAY 8: POMPEII | MONTECASSINO | ROME

Explore the ancient ruins of Pompeii, preserved by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius. Visit the Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary of Pompeii, home to revered Passion relics. Continue to Montecassino, the historic Benedictine abbey founded by St. Benedict, before arriving in Rome.

## DAY 9: PAPAL AUDIENCE | CHRISTIAN ROME | VATICAN MUSEUMS

Attend the Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square. After lunch, tour Christian Rome, including the Holy Stairs, St. John Lateran, and St. Mary Major, where Mass will be celebrated. Later, enjoy a private visit to the Vatican Museums, including the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, and Sistine Chapel.

## DAY 10: ST. PETER'S BASILICA | ROME

Today we tour St. Peter's Basilica, built on the site where St. Peter the Apostle was martyred. Here, you'll have the opportunity to view Michelangelo's Pieta sculpture, and pray at the tombs of Pope Benedict XVI and St. John Paul II. Afterward, we go to Piazza Navona, followed by a walking tour through Baroque Rome, including the Trevi Fountain and Spanish Steps. Afternoon is at your leisure. Dinner on your own. Overnight in Rome.

## DAY 11: ROME

Enjoy a hands-on pizza-making experience with lunch included, followed by a visit to the Pantheon. The afternoon is free to explore Rome independently, with options including the Trevi Fountain, Spanish Steps, Piazza Navona, and Piazza Venezia. Gather this evening for a special farewell dinner.

## DAY 12: RETURN HOME

Transfer to the airport for your return flight home, carrying lasting memories, spiritual blessings, and the beauty of Italy's sacred traditions.

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**YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES**

**Air Transportation:** Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

**Land Transportation:** All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

**Hotels:** Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

**Meal Plan:** The meal plan offers daily breakfast & 8 dinners with wine and 1 wine & cheese tasting.

**Baggage:** Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

**Airport Fees:** Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

**Medical Insurance:** Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

**YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE**

**Cancellation Insurance:** We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

**Passport Expenses:** This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

**Personal Expenses:** Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

**Tips/Gratuities:** This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

**Non-itinerary fees:** Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

**Non-included meals:** You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

**GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION**

**Group Air:** Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

**Departure Cities:** If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

**Land-Only Option:** If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only' option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

**IMPORTANT POLICIES**

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

**Single Room:** Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

**Seat Upgrades:** Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

**Other Special Requests:** Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

**BOOKING CONDITIONS**

**Deposit:** A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

**Payment Deadline:** Full payment is due Friday, November 20, 2026. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

**Payment Methods:** We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

**LATE PAYMENT POLICY**

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

**CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY**

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

| PRIOR TO DEPARTURE | PENALTY           |
|--------------------|-------------------|
| 100 + days         | Lose deposit      |
| 99 - 50 days       | 50% of trip cost  |
| 49 days or less    | 100% of trip cost |

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.
