YOUR DAILY itinerary

DAY 1: DEPART FOR TEL AVIV

Begin your pilgrimage with an overnight flight to Israel, preparing for an inspiring journey through the sacred lands of Scripture.

DAY 2: TEL AVIV / NETANYA

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport, meet your guide, and transfer by motor coach to Netanya. Time permitting, celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Church in Jaffa before dinner and overnight.

DAY 3: CAESAREA / MUHRAQA / MOUNT CARMEL / HAIFA / MEGIDDO / TIBERIAS

Visit Caesarea Maritima and the ruins associated with King Herod. Continue to Deir Al-Muhraqa Monastery for Mass, then visit Stella Maris Monastery on Mount Carmel and enjoy time in Haifa. After lunch, drive by Har Megiddo and visit Nain, where Jesus raised the widow's son. Check into your hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 4: CANA / NAZARETH / MOUNT TABOR / TIBERIAS

Celebrate Mass at the Wedding Church in Cana, where couples may renew their vows. Visit Nazareth, including the Basilica of the Annunciation, St. Joseph's Church, Mary's Well, and the Old Market. Return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5: CHORAZIN / BETHSAIDA / TEL DAN / CAESAREA PHILIPPI / GOLAN HEIGHTS

This morning we will visit the ruins of Chorazin, followed by Bethsaida, two of the three cities Jesus rebuked in the New Testament. Afterward, we will drive to Tel Dan and hike to the Temple of Jeroboam and "Abraham's Gate." Our next stop is Caesarea Philippi. We will continue to Druze and Mt. Bental for a breathtaking view of Syria. We'll have lunch and then drive through Golan Heights to Kursi, where Jesus cast evil spirits out of a man into pigs. We will end our day at Tel Hazor National Park. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 6: GALILEE / JERUSALEM

Visit the Mount of Beatitudes, Tabgha, the Church of Peter's Primacy, and Capernaum. Celebrate Mass aboard a boat on the Sea of Galilee before continuing to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 7: BETHLEHEM / EIN KAREM

Celebrate Mass at Shepherds' Field, then visit the Church of the Nativity. Continue to Ein Karem to see the birthplace of St. John the Baptist and the Church of the Visitation. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Travel Note ☆☆☆

This pilgrimage itinerary may include early mornings, full sightseeing days, extended travel times, multiple modes of transportation, and moderate physical activity. Please review the full itinerary for full details.



DAY 8: JERUSALEM – PALM SUNDAY ROUTE

Begin on the Mount of Olives with visits to Pater Noster and Dominus Flevit. Pray in the Garden of Gethsemane and celebrate Mass at the Church of All Nations. Continue to the Chapel of the Ascension, the Upper Room, and St. Peter in Gallicantu. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 9: JERUSALEM – VIA DOLOROSA

Walk the Via Dolorosa, praying to the Stations of the Cross, and celebrate Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Visit St. Anne's Church, Ecce Homo, and the Western Wall, with free time before dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 10: JORDAN VALLEY / JERICHO / DEAD SEA / JERUSALEM

Renew your baptismal vows at the Jordan River, travel through the Jordan Valley to Jericho, and view the Mount of Temptation. Weather permitting, enjoy time at the Dead Sea before returning to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 11: ST. JERUSALEM / ST. CATHERINE

Cross into Egypt and continue to St. Catherine in Sinai. Dinner and overnight in St. Catherine.

DAY 12: ST. CATHERINE / CAIRO

This morning, you may choose to participate in an optional early morning climb of Mount Sinai. Visit St. Catherine's Monastery at the foot of Mount Sinai, then continue to Cairo for dinner and overnight.

DAY 13: CAIRO / EGYPTIAN MUSEUM / PYRAMIDS / SPHINX

Visit the Egyptian Museum, then explore the Great Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx. In the evening, enjoy a dinner cruise on the Nile before overnight in Cairo.

DAY 14: COPTIC CAIRO

Begin the day with an exploration of Coptic Cairo, featuring significant sites such as the Coptic Museum, the renowned Hanging Church, the Greek Church of St. George, and Abu Serga Church, traditionally believed to be a resting place of the Holy Family during their time in Egypt. After a full day of exploration, return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 15: RETURN HOME

Transfer to the airport for your return flight home, carrying unforgettable memories and spiritual blessings from the Holy Land, Sinai, and Egypt.

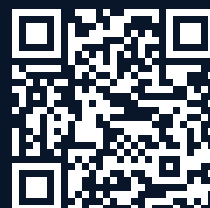

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airline carriers for up-to-date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 7/02/2027, 100 days before departure. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	PENALTY
100 + days	Loss of deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.
