DAY 1 – DEPARTURE TO PARIS

(May 10th, 2027) Your pilgrimage begins today, boarding your flight to France. Relax, enjoy your flight, and focus on the spiritual journey ahead.

DAY 2 – ARRIVE IN PARIS

(May 11th, 2027) Upon arrival in Paris, you will meet your professional tour guide, board the motorcoach, and transfer to the hotel. Enjoy a welcome dinner and overnight accommodations at your Paris hotel.

DAY 3 – PARIS

(May 12th, 2027) Our day begins in Paris at Notre Dame Cathedral followed by the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal at Rue de Bac, where Our Lady appeared to St. Catherine Laboure in 1830. We will also visit the Shrine of St. Vincent de Paul, where his body is displayed, and the Sacre Coeur Basilica in Montmartre. Mass will be celebrated. Tonight, we enjoy dinner and a night of song & sharing before a restful overnight at your hotel.

DAY 4 – LISIEUX

(May 13th, 2027) Today, we travel to Lisieux, home of St. Therese, the "Little Flower of Jesus." We will visit Saint Therese's family home, the Carmelite convent where she reached the heights of sanctity, and her final resting place in the Carmel chapel. We will also visit the magnificent Basilica of St. Therese. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel.

DAY 5 – LISIEUX / CHARTRES / NEVERS

(May 14th, 2027) Today, we will travel to Chartres to see the magnificent Our Lady of Chartres Cathedral, known for its labyrinth and incredible 12th & 13th-century stained-glass windows. This UNESCO World Heritage site is described as "the high point of French Gothic art". Mass will be celebrated. We will continue to Nevers for dinner and a restful overnight stay at your hotel.

DAY 6 – NEVERS / PARAY-LE-MONIAL / LYON

(May 15th, 2027) Our day begins by walking in the footsteps of St. Bernadette, who spent her life as a nun with the Sisters of Charity, following her vision of the Virgin Mary in Lourdes. We will pray beside St. Bernadette, drawing inspiration from her life and the message

of Our Lady. Mass will be celebrated. We will continue to Paray-le-Monial, where St. Margaret Mary Alacoque received the revelations of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the 17th century. Here, we will visit the chapel and venerate her sacred relics. Finally, we will continue to Lyon for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 7 – LYON / ARS (PENTECOST)

(May 16th, 2027) Today, we begin at Lyon's magnificent Basilica of Notre-Dame de Fourvière, a beloved Marian shrine built as a testament to the faith and gratitude of the people of Lyon. We will then visit the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist, renowned for its remarkable astronomical clock and beautiful stained-glass windows. Mass will be celebrated. Next, we travel to Ars to visit the Shrine of St. John Vianney, the patron saint of parish priests. We will watch a brief documentary about his extraordinary life, visit the humble church where he faithfully served and preached, and pray before his incorrupt body in the Basilica. Finally, we return to Lyon for dinner, a special evening of Song & Sharing, and an overnight stay at our hotel.

DAY 8 – LYON / LOURDES

(May 17th, 2027) Today, we will fly to Toulouse and board our motorcoach for Lourdes, one of the world's greatest pilgrimage shrines. Here, Our Lady appeared to Bernadette in 1858 and announced herself as "The Immaculate Conception" near the Grotto of Massabielle. Mass will be celebrated. After dinner at our hotel, we will participate in the candlelight procession and the Rosary. Overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 9 – LOURDES

(May 18th, 2027) Our day begins at the Grotto of Massabielle, where we walk in the footsteps of St. Bernadette, visit Boly Mill, her birthplace, and watch a video about the story of Lourdes. Mass will be celebrated. Enjoy free time in the afternoon for prayer, a 'water blessing', a visit to the museum of chronicled miracles, confession, or shopping. Our Farewell Dinner will be at a local restaurant, where we will savor French cuisine and new friendships as your pilgrimage comes to an end. Return to the hotel for overnight.

DAY 10 – RETURN HOME

(May 19th, 2027) We will transfer to the airport for our return flight home.

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YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Private Transfers: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotel Accommodations: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Included Meals: The meal plan offers a daily breakfast buffet. Other included meals are listed in your itinerary. Wine will be served with all included dinners.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with their airline carrier for up-to-date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, portage, fuel surcharges and security fees

Medical Coverage: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip. Coverage details, limits, exclusions, and claims procedures are governed solely by the insurance policy documents provided by the insurer.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport/Visa Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date. Travelers are solely responsible for obtaining and carrying all required passports, visas, vaccination documentation, and other entry requirements imposed by destination countries.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air Policy: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Point of Departure: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the land-only option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

Travel/Scheduling Changes: Flight schedules, aircraft type, routing, departure airports, and carriers are subject to change by the airline without notice.

Seat Assignments: The airline carrier selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

TRAVELER CONDUCT POLICY

Nativity Pilgrimage reserves the right to remove any traveler whose behavior is disruptive, unsafe, unlawful, abusive, or interferes with the enjoyment or safety of other participants. No refund shall be provided for unused portions of the trip.

HEALTH/FITNESS REQUIREMENTS

Travelers are responsible for determining that they are physically and medically capable of participating. Travelers requiring special accommodations must notify Nativity Pilgrimage at the time of registration.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Registration: An \$300 non-refundable deposit per person is required at the time of registration. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 01/29/2027 (100 days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive late fees if they are not paid in full:

- 100-61 days prior to departure: \$150
- 60-30 days prior to departure: \$300
- 30 days or less prior to departure: Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Cancellation penalties are assessed based on the date written notice of cancellation is received:

- 100 days or more prior to departure: \$300 deposit
- 99-50 days prior to departure: 50% of total trip cost
- 49 days or less prior to departure: 100% of total trip cost

FORCE MAJEURE

Nativity Pilgrimage shall not be liable for delays, cancellations, changes, losses, or damages resulting from acts of God, natural disasters, pandemics, government actions, border closures, airline disruptions, labor disputes, terrorism, civil unrest, or other events beyond its reasonable control.

TRAVEL INSURANCE OPTIONS

Medical Coverage: Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip. Coverage details, limits, exclusions, and claims procedures are governed solely by the insurance policy documents provided by the insurer.

Trip Cancellation Insurance: We also strongly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance (available at an additional cost) to safeguard your travel investment in case unforeseen circumstances require you to cancel. Important: If you plan to purchase Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage, it must be purchased within 14 days of registration.
