DAY 1: FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV

Begin your pilgrimage with an overnight flight to Tel Aviv, Israel, preparing for a meaningful journey through the land of Scripture and the places where Christ walked.

DAY 2: TEL AVIV / TIBERIAS

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport and meet your professional tour guide before traveling to Tiberias. Time permitting, celebrate Mass at historic St. Peter's Church in Jaffa. Continue to your hotel for dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

DAY 3: CANA / NAZARETH / MOUNT TABOR

Visit the Wedding Church in Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle, and where couples may renew their wedding vows. Continue to Nazareth to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, St. Joseph's Church, Mary's Well, and the old market. Travel to Mount Tabor, site of the Transfiguration, where Mass will be celebrated before returning for dinner and overnight.

DAY 4: MOUNT OF BEATITUDES / TABGHA / CAPERNAUM / SEA OF GALILEE

Begin at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Continue to Tabgha, the site of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fish, and visit the Church of Peter's Primacy. Explore Capernaum, central to Jesus' Galilean ministry, then enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, where Mass will be celebrated on board. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

DAY 5: HAIFA / MOUNT CARMEL / CAESAREA MARITIMA / BETHLEHEM

Visit Mount Carmel, home to the Carmelite tradition, then travel along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea Maritima, where St. Peter baptized Cornelius and St. Paul was imprisoned. See the Roman aqueduct, theater, and remains of Herod's palace overlooking the sea. Mass will be celebrated before continuing to Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

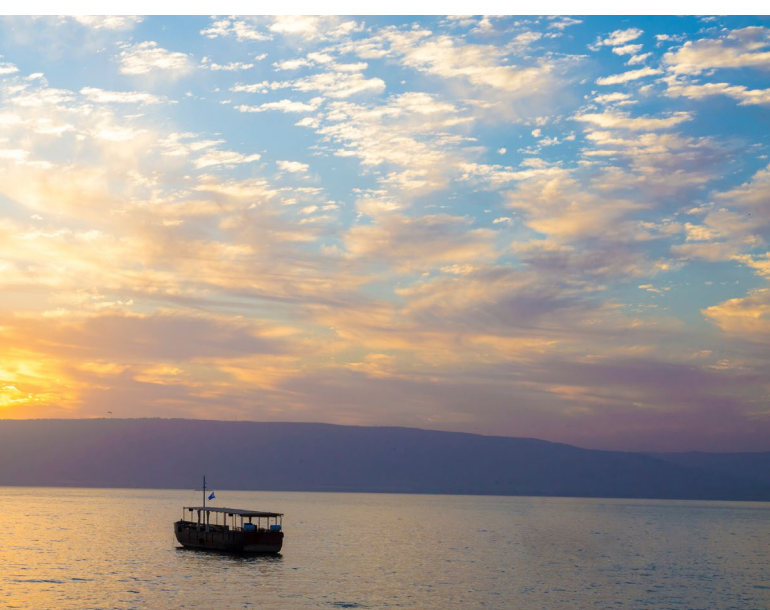

This pilgrimage may include early mornings, full sightseeing days, extended travel times, multiple modes of transportation, and moderate physical activity. Please review the full itinerary for complete details.



DAY 6: BETHLEHEM / EIN KAREM

Visit Shepherds' Field, then continue to the Church of the Nativity, built over the traditional site of Christ's birth. In the afternoon, travel to Ein Karem, birthplace of St. John the Baptist, and visit the Church of the Visitation, where Mary proclaimed the Magnificat. Mass will be celebrated before returning to Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 7: BETHANY / JORDAN RIVER / JERICHO / QUMRAN / DEAD SEA

Begin in Bethany with a visit to the Church of Lazarus. Continue to the Jordan River to renew your baptismal vows, then travel through the Jordan Valley to Jericho, where you will view the Mount of Temptation. Visit Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scrolls, where Mass will be celebrated, then enjoy time at the Dead Sea before returning to Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8: JERUSALEM — PALM SUNDAY ROAD

Begin on the Mount of Olives with a visit to Pater Noster, where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer. Walk the Palm Sunday route, stopping at Dominus Flevit, then pray in the Garden of Gethsemane and visit the Church of All Nations. Continue to the Chapel of the Ascension, the Upper Room on Mount Zion, and St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 9: JERUSALEM — VIA DOLOROSA

Walk the Via Dolorosa while praying the Stations of the Cross, retracing the final steps of Christ. Continue to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the site of His crucifixion, burial, and resurrection. Visit St. Anne's Church, Ecce Homo, and the Western Wall. Mass will be celebrated during the day, followed by free time and a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 10: RETURN HOME

Transfer to the airport for your return flight home, carrying lasting memories, renewed faith, and spiritual blessings from your pilgrimage through the Holy Land.

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YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Private Transfers: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotel Accommodations: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Included Meals: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with their airline carrier for up-to-date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, portage, fuel surcharges and security fees

Medical Coverage: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip. Coverage details, limits, exclusions, and claims procedures are governed solely by the insurance policy documents provided by the insurer.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport/Visa Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date. Travelers are solely responsible for obtaining and carrying all required passports, visas, vaccination documentation, and other entry requirements imposed by destination countries.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air Policy: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Point of Departure: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the land-only option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

Travel/Scheduling Changes: Flight schedules, aircraft type, routing, departure airports, and carriers are subject to change by the airline without notice.

Seat Assignments: The airline carrier selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

TRAVELER CONDUCT POLICY

Nativity Pilgrimage reserves the right to remove any traveler whose behavior is disruptive, unsafe, unlawful, abusive, or interferes with the enjoyment or safety of other participants. No refund shall be provided for unused portions of the trip.

HEALTH/FITNESS REQUIREMENTS

Travelers are responsible for determining that they are physically and medically capable of participating. Travelers requiring special accommodations must notify Nativity Pilgrimage at the time of registration.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Registration: An \$300 non-refundable deposit per person is required at the time of registration. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due July 19, 2027 (100 days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive late fees if they are not paid in full:

- 100-61 days prior to departure: \$150
- 60-30 days prior to departure: \$300
- 30 days or less prior to departure: Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Cancellation penalties are assessed based on the date written notice of cancellation is received:

- 100 days or more prior to departure: \$300 deposit
- 99-50 days prior to departure: 50% of total trip cost
- 49 days or less prior to departure: 100% of total trip cost

FORCE MAJEURE

Nativity Pilgrimage shall not be liable for delays, cancellations, changes, losses, or damages resulting from acts of God, natural disasters, pandemics, government actions, border closures, airline disruptions, labor disputes, terrorism, civil unrest, or other events beyond its reasonable control.

TRAVEL INSURANCE OPTIONS

Medical Coverage: Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip. Coverage details, limits, exclusions, and claims procedures are governed solely by the insurance policy documents provided by the insurer.

Trip Cancellation Insurance: We also strongly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance (available at an additional cost) to safeguard your travel investment in case unforeseen circumstances require you to cancel. Important: If you plan to purchase Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage, it must be purchased within 14 days of registration.

The IATA carriers, steamship firms and other transportation companies, whose services are featured in these tours, are not to be held responsible or accountable for any act, omission or event during the time the passengers are not on board their respective conveyance.
