DAY 1: FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV

Begin your extraordinary pilgrimage as you board your flight to the Holy Land, preparing for a transformative spiritual journey in the footsteps of Jesus.

DAY 2: TEL AVIV | NETANYA

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport, go through customs, meet your tour guide, and transfer to your hotel in Netanya for dinner with your fellow pilgrims.

DAY 3: CAESAREA | MT. CARMEL | HAIFA | TIBERIAS

Begin at Caesarea Maritima to view the remains of Herod's palace. Celebrate Mass at Deir Al-Muhraqa Carmelite Monastery, where Elijah confronted the Prophets of Baal and Asherah (1 Kgs. 18). Continue to Stella Maris Monastery on Mt. Carmel and Haifa before traveling to Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight.

DAY 4: CANA | NAZARETH | MOUNT PRECIPICE | MT. TABOR | TIBERIAS

Celebrate Mass at Cana's Wedding Church, where couples may renew their vows. Continue to Nazareth to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, St. Joseph's Church, Mary's Well, and the old market. Take in views from Mount Precipice before visiting the Church of the Transfiguration on Mount Tabor. Return to Tiberias for dinner.

DAY 5: SEA OF GALILEE | CAESAREA PHILIPPI | MAGDALA

Begin with a scenic boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, then visit Kibbutz Ginosar to see an ancient boat from Jesus' time. Continue

to Caesarea Philippi at the foot of Mount Hermon and Magdala, birthplace of Mary Magdalene, to explore its ancient synagogue and remarkable carved menorah. Celebrate Mass before returning to Tiberias for dinner.

DAY 6: MT. OF BEATITUDES | TABGHA | CAPERNAUM | CHORAZIN | ZIPPORI | JERUSALEM

Visit the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount, and Tabgha, site of the Feeding of the 5,000. Continue to the Church of the Primacy of Peter and Capernaum, where Jesus lived and ministered. Explore Chorazin and the ancient mosaics of Zippori before traveling to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 7: BETHLEHEM

Begin in Bethlehem at Shepherds' Field, then visit the Church of the Nativity, marking the birthplace of Jesus. Celebrate Mass and visit the Milk Grotto before returning to Jerusalem for dinner.

DAY 8: JERUSALEM

Begin on the Mt. of Olives at the Church of the Pater Noster, where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer. Walk the Palm Sunday route to Dominus Flevit and continue through the Garden of Gethsemane to the Rock of Agony. Celebrate Mass at the Church of All Nations and visit the Chapel of the Ascension. On Mount Zion, see the Upper Room, King David's Tomb, and the Church of the Dormition before ending at St. Peter in Gallicantu.

DAY 9: JERUSALEM

Retrace the final steps of Jesus along the Via Dolorosa, praying the Stations of the Cross through the Old City. Celebrate Mass at the

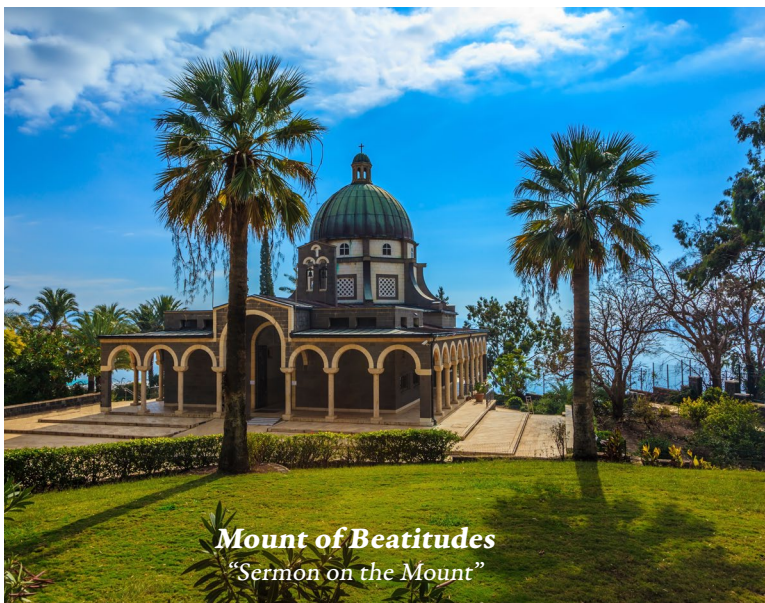

The Tomb of Jesus
Church of the Holy Sepulchre

Church of the Holy Sepulchre, then visit St. Anne's Church, Ecce Homo, and the Western Wall. Walk through the ancient tunnel beneath the streets before enjoying free time for prayer, shopping, or exploring the holy sites.

DAY 10: BETHANY | JORDAN RIVER | JERICHO

Begin in Bethany, home of Lazarus, Martha, and Mary, and visit the Church of Lazarus. Continue to the Jordan River to renew your baptismal vows, then travel through the Jordan Valley to Jericho, one of the world's oldest cities. Visit the Mt. of Temptation, where Jesus fasted and was tempted. Celebrate Mass in Bethany or Jericho before returning to Jerusalem.

DAY 11: MASADA | QUMRAN | DEAD SEA

Visit Masada and ride the cable car to the ancient ruins of Herod's fortress. Continue to Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered, followed by time to swim or float in the waters of the Dead Sea. Return to Jerusalem for dinner.

DAY 12: EIN KAREM | JERUSALEM

Travel to Ein Karem, birthplace of St. John the Baptist, and visit the Church of the Visitation, where Mary proclaimed the Magnificat. Return to Jerusalem to visit the Israel Museum, including the Second Temple-era model of Jerusalem and the Shrine of the Book. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 13: JERUSALEM | CITY OF DAVID | POOL OF SILOAM | EMMAUS

Explore the City of David, including the Southern Excavations, Davidson Center, and original steps leading to the Temple. Visit the Pool of Siloam, where Jesus healed the man born blind, then travel to Emmaus, where the Risen Lord walked with His disciples. Pray at Emmaus Church before returning to Jerusalem.

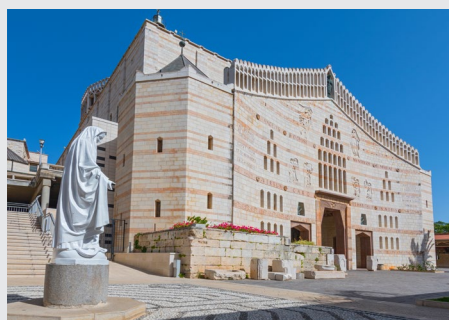
DAY 14: RETURN HOME

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy-class, round-trip airfare is based on rates available at the time of reservation. Rates and schedules are subject to change without notice. Once issued, airline tickets are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be applied toward future travel.

Private Transportation: All land transportation described in the itinerary will be provided by deluxe motor coach. Some motor coaches may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotel Accommodations: Accommodations will be provided at first-class hotels based on double occupancy (two people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator is responsible for providing a roommate.

Included Meals: Breakfast and dinner are provided daily unless otherwise stated in the itinerary.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) checked bag and one (1) carry-on. Travelers are responsible for confirming current baggage allowances, weight limits, dimensions, and applicable fees directly with the airline.

Airport Fees: Airport taxes, portage, fuel surcharges, and security fees are included.

Medical Coverage: Medical coverage is provided for the duration of the trip. Coverage details, limits, exclusions, and claims procedures are governed solely by the insurance policy documents provided by the insurer.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance at the time of registration.

Passport/Visa Expenses: Passports, visas, and any additional travel documents required for the trip are not included. Passports must remain valid for at least six months beyond the scheduled return date. Travelers are solely responsible for obtaining and carrying all required passports, visas, vaccination documentation, and other entry requirements imposed by destination countries.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not included in the meal plan, excess or additional baggage, and other personal expenses.

Non-Itinerary Fees: Any sightseeing, services, admission fees, or personal expenses not specifically listed as included in the itinerary.

Non-Included Meals: Travelers are responsible for meals not specified as included in the itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: Gratuities for tour guides, drivers, hotel staff, wait staff, and other service personnel are not included unless otherwise stated.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air Policy: Group airfare differs from individually purchased airline tickets and is subject to the terms and conditions of the applicable airline. Registration and full payment must be received by the stated payment deadline. Registrations received after the deadline may be subject to different airfare, ticketing arrangements, airlines, or additional fees. Group flight arrangements are generally confirmed 60–90 days prior to departure.

Point of Departure: If your preferred departure city is not listed in the brochure, indicate your requested airport on the registration form. Nativity Pilgrimage will provide the best available airfare and flight schedule to connect you with the group. Additional fees may apply.

Land-Only Option: Travelers who wish to arrange their own airfare should select the land-only option on the registration form. Unless otherwise specified, the land-only price is \$800 less than the full tour price (\$350 less for Mexico). Travelers booking their own airfare may select their preferred airline, seats, and travel schedule; use airline miles or points; provide frequent-flyer information; and make special requests directly with the airline. No changes may be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the designated hotels unless the traveler is able to meet the group during a scheduled airport transfer. Land-only travelers are otherwise responsible for their own transportation to and from the hotel.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

Travel/Scheduling Changes: Flight schedules, aircraft type, routing, departure airports, and carriers are subject to change by the airline without notice.

Seat Assignments: Seat assignments for group airfare are determined by the airline, not Nativity Pilgrimage. Seat upgrades may be requested by registered travelers but are subject to availability and pricing. Quoted upgrade rates are subject to change until payment is received, and some upgrades may not be available until group tickets are issued.

Single Rooms: Tour pricing is based on double occupancy. Single rooms are available at an additional cost as specified on the registration form. Availability is limited and will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Upon receiving an upgrade or seat-location request, Nativity Pilgrimage will contact the airline on the traveler's behalf. Requests cannot be guaranteed and remain subject to airline availability and pricing.

Special Requests: Nativity Pilgrimage will make reasonable efforts to communicate requests for wheelchair assistance, special meals, or other accommodations to the appropriate airline or service provider. Fulfillment of such requests cannot be guaranteed and may be subject to availability and additional fees.

TRAVELER CONDUCT POLICY

Nativity Pilgrimage reserves the right to remove any traveler whose behavior is disruptive, unsafe, unlawful, abusive, or interferes with the safety or enjoyment of other participants. No refund will be provided for any unused portion of the trip resulting from such removal.

HEALTH/FITNESS REQUIREMENTS

Travelers are responsible for determining whether they are physically and medically capable of participating in the trip. Travelers requiring special assistance or accommodations must notify Nativity Pilgrimage at the time of registration.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Registration: A non-refundable \$300 deposit per person is required at the time of registration. Reservations will not be processed without the required deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due Thursday, Dec. 24, 2026 (100 days before departure, or on the nearest business day). Registrations received after the deadline are considered late and are subject to availability and an additional \$100 fee. If payment is not made in full at least 50 days prior to departure, all payments become non-refundable.

Payment Methods: Nativity Pilgrimage accepts major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. A 3% processing fee applies to each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers whose accounts are not paid in full by the payment deadline will be subject to the following late fees:

100–61 days prior to departure: \$150

60–30 days prior to departure: \$300

30 days or less prior to departure: Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any increase in airfare resulting from late payment, subject to availability. Failure or refusal to pay any outstanding balance or applicable fees may be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Cancellation penalties are based on the date Nativity Pilgrimage receives written notice of cancellation:

100 days or more prior to departure: Loss of \$300 deposit

99–50 days prior to departure: 50% of total trip cost

49 days or less prior to departure: 100% of total trip cost

FORCE MAJEURE

Nativity Pilgrimage shall not be liable for delays, cancellations, itinerary changes, losses, damages, or additional expenses resulting from acts of God, natural disasters, pandemics, government actions, border closures, airline disruptions, labor disputes, terrorism, civil unrest, or other events beyond its reasonable control.

TRAVEL INSURANCE OPTIONS

Medical Coverage: Every traveler with Nativity Pilgrimage receives complimentary medical insurance for the duration of the trip. Coverage details, limits, exclusions, and claims procedures are governed solely by the insurance policy documents provided by the insurer.

Trip Cancellation Insurance: We strongly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance, available at an additional cost, to help protect your travel investment should unforeseen circumstances require you to cancel. Coverage is available through Trawick International, or you may purchase coverage from an insurance provider of your choice.

If purchasing Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage through Trawick International, it must be purchased within 14 days of registration.

TRAVELER CONSENT

Travelers consent to receive trip-related communications electronically, including invoices, itineraries, updates, and travel documents. Travelers also grant Nativity Pilgrimage permission to use photographs and video taken during the tour for promotional purposes unless written notice is provided prior to departure.

RESPONSIBILITY

Nativity Pilgrimage, Inc. and its agents assume no liability or responsibility in connection with the trip for personal injury, loss of or damage to property, accidents, delays, changes in schedule or itinerary, incidental damages, or other irregular circumstances. This includes, but is not limited to, any default, act, or omission by third-party service providers or facilities providing services related to or included in any portion of the tour.

Airlines, cruise lines, and other transportation companies whose services are included in the tour are not responsible for any act, omission, or event occurring while passengers are not aboard their respective means of transportation. The transportation contract issued by each carrier constitutes the sole contract between that carrier and the purchaser and/or passenger. Nativity Pilgrimage, Inc. assumes no liability or responsibility in connection with such contracts.

Nativity Pilgrimage, Inc. is not responsible for losses or additional expenses resulting from delays or changes in air or other services, illness, weather conditions, strikes, war, quarantines, or other causes beyond its control. Any such losses or expenses shall be the responsibility of the traveler, as tour rates cover only the arrangements and services specified for the stated travel period.

Nativity Pilgrimage reserves the right to substitute hotels listed in the itinerary with accommodations of similar quality and to cancel any tour prior to departure. Refund conditions vary by trip. No refund will be issued for any portion of the tour that has already been used or completed unless prior arrangements were made before departure from the United States. Prices and itineraries are subject to change without notice if booking conditions are not met.

Any dispute arising from this agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas and resolved exclusively in the courts located in Harris County, Texas.
