Daily Itinerary

DAY 1: DEPART FOR LISBON

(July 12th) Begin your pilgrimage with an overnight flight to Lisbon, preparing for a meaningful journey through some of Europe's most beloved Catholic shrines.

DAY 2: LISBON / SANTARÉM / FÁTIMA

(July 13th) Arrive in Lisbon and meet your tour guide and driver. Time permitting, stop in Santarém to visit the Church of St. Stephen, known for its Eucharistic Miracle. Continue to Fátima for dinner and overnight.

DAY 3: FÁTIMA

(July 14th) Celebrate Mass at one of Fátima's sacred chapels, then walk the Way of the Cross, concluding at the Chapel of Calvary. Visit Aljustrel, the childhood village of Francisco, Jacinta, and Lúcia, and continue to Valinhos, site of the post-imprisonment apparition. This evening, participate in the Candlelight Procession before dinner and overnight.

DAY 4: FÁTIMA / PORTO / SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

(July 15th) Travel to Porto, Portugal's charming second city. Celebrate Mass at the Cathedral of the Assumption and enjoy a sightseeing tour featuring notable landmarks such as the Stock Exchange Palace and St. Francis Church. Enjoy free time for lunch, shopping, or an optional port wine cellar visit before continuing to Santiago de Compostela.

DAY 5: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

(July 16th) Visit Monte do Gozo, the "Hill of Joy," traditionally the final stop for pilgrims before reaching Santiago. Continue to the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela to visit the tomb of St. James and celebrate Mass. Enjoy time to explore the city before dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 6: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA / ALBA DE TORMES / ÁVILA

(July 17th) Depart for Ávila, with a stop in Alba de Tormes to visit its historic monastery associated with St. Teresa of Ávila. Continue to Ávila, known for its impressive medieval walls, and celebrate Mass at the cathedral before dinner and overnight.

DAY 7: ÁVILA / BURGOS

(July 18th) Enjoy a guided tour of Ávila before continuing to Burgos. Upon arrival, take a walking tour including Castle Hill and the magnificent Burgos Cathedral, a masterpiece of Spanish Gothic architecture. Celebrate Mass, then enjoy dinner and overnight.

DAY 8: BURGOS / LOYOLA / LOURDES

(July 19th) Travel toward Lourdes, stopping in Loyola to visit the Shrine of St. Ignatius and celebrate Mass. Continue into France and arrive in Lourdes for dinner, overnight, and the evening Candlelight Procession.

DAY 9: LOURDES

(July 20th) Begin with Mass at the Grotto of Massabielle, then follow in the footsteps of St. Bernadette with visits to sites connected to her life and the apparitions. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure for prayer, reflection, or personal devotion before dinner and the evening Candlelight Procession.

DAY 10: LOURDES / CARCASSONNE / BARCELONA

(July 21st) Depart for Barcelona, stopping in Carcassonne, the medieval hilltop city known for its fortified walls, watchtowers, and historic citadel, La Cité. After lunch, continue to Barcelona for dinner and overnight.

DAY 11: BARCELONA

(July 22nd) Visit La Sagrada Familia and the Cathedral of St. Eulalia, with Mass celebrated during the day. Enjoy a panoramic city tour featuring Santa Maria del Mar, Plaça de Catalunya, and the Gothic Quarter before dinner and overnight.

DAY 12: MONTSERRAT / BARCELONA

(July 23rd) Travel to Montserrat to celebrate Mass and visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Montserrat, home to the revered Black Madonna. Return to Barcelona for free time along Las Ramblas before gathering for a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 13: RETURN HOME

(July 24th) Transfer to Barcelona Airport for your return flight home, carrying lasting memories and spiritual blessings from your pilgrimage through Portugal, Spain, and France.

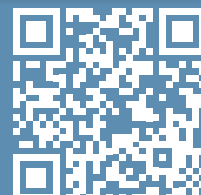

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Private Transfers: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotel Accommodations: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Included Meals: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with their airline carrier for up-to-date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, portage, fuel surcharges and security fees

Medical Coverage: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip. Coverage details, limits, exclusions, and claims procedures are governed solely by the insurance policy documents provided by the insurer.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport /Visa Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date. Travelers are solely responsible for obtaining and carrying all required passports, visas, vaccination documentation, and other entry requirements imposed by destination countries.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air Policy: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Point of Departure: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the land-only option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

Travel/Scheduling Changes: Flight schedules, aircraft type, routing, departure airports, and carriers are subject to change by the airline without notice.

Seat Assignments: The airline carrier selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

TRAVELER CONDUCT POLICY

Nativity Pilgrimage reserves the right to remove any traveler whose behavior is disruptive, unsafe, unlawful, abusive, or interferes with the enjoyment or safety of other participants. No refund shall be provided for unused portions of the trip.

HEALTH/FITNESS REQUIREMENTS

Travelers are responsible for determining that they are physically and medically capable of participating. Travelers requiring special accommodations must notify Nativity Pilgrimage at the time of registration.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Registration: An \$300 non-refundable deposit per person is required at the time of registration. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due April 02, 2027 (100 days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive late fees if they are not paid in full:

- 100-61 days prior to departure: \$150
- 60-30 days prior to departure: \$300
- 30 days or less prior to departure: Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Cancellation penalties are assessed based on the date written notice of cancellation is received:

- 100 days or more prior to departure: \$300 deposit
- 99-50 days prior to departure: 50% of total trip cost
- 49 days or less prior to departure: 100% of total trip cost

FORCE MAJEURE

Nativity Pilgrimage shall not be liable for delays, cancellations, changes, losses, or damages resulting from acts of God, natural disasters, pandemics, government actions, border closures, airline disruptions, labor disputes, terrorism, civil unrest, or other events beyond its reasonable control.

TRAVEL INSURANCE OPTIONS

Medical Coverage: Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip. Coverage details, limits, exclusions, and claims procedures are governed solely by the insurance policy documents provided by the insurer.

Trip Cancellation Insurance: We also strongly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance (available at an additional cost) to safeguard your travel investment in case unforeseen circumstances require you to cancel.
